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1. Introduction to Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

Welcome to the User Manual of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, the most efficient and user-friendly Outlook PST recovery software, which repairs brutally corrupted, inaccessible, or deleted PST files, and extracts every single data item like emails, appointments, tasks, journals, contacts, sent items, or calendar, etc. The software is equipped with dynamic features and holds a rich graphical interface, which is necessary for rendering an outstanding user experience.

1.1 Using this Manual

This User Manual is intended to guide users on using Kernel for Outlook PST Repair. We suggest that first time users should read this User Manual completely and carefully before proceeding to use the software. However, if you are an experienced user, you can use the Table of Contents to find out information pertaining to the tasks that you need to perform by using Kernel for Outlook PST Repair. You can use the Table of Contents to navigate through different sections of this User Manual. The Table of Contents enlists all the sections contained within this user manual in chronological order.

1.2 About Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

Kernel for Outlook PST Repair is an advanced and professional PST repairing tool that is designed to provide an effortless PST file recovery solution when the PST file gets corrupted, damaged, or accidentally deleted. It is blended with various advanced functionalities and options that help in recovering the corrupt PST files from the scenarios like:

- Registry Errors
- Hard Drive failure
- Abrupt system shutdown
- Outlook crashes
- Virus attacks

Kernel for Outlook PST Repair offers a varied range of saving options to save recovered PST data files. In addition, you can migrate the entire mailboxes of MS Outlook to the most popular email servers, Web-based email applications, and cloud services.

The Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software efficiently recovers and retrieves all the necessary data files such as Notes, scheduled tasks, appointments, Calendar entries, Journal, Drafts, Deleted Items folders, etc. It is empowered with QFSCI algorithms, which strictly helps in preserving the properties, formatting, and email metadata, like To, Subject, CC, BCC, From, of the recovered email items.

Latest Enhancements to Saving Options:

Kernel for Outlook PST Repair has been upgraded to support a variety of saving options. After the recovery of PST data files, you can open and view the recovered Outlook PST files on MS Outlook, Outlook Express, Adobe Reader, and many other applications as it supports a variety of other file formats. Furthermore, the software is configured

with some latest storage facility, which further allows easy transfer of the repaired PST items to productive Web-based email software's and email servers.

Despite this, the following list divides the saving alternatives on the basis of applications and the quantity of files processed.

- **Single File Options** - PST file (MS Outlook), DBX file (Outlook Express), and MBOX file.
- **Multiple File Options** –MSG File, EML file, TXT file, RTF file, HTML file, MHTML file, and PDF file.
- **Email Servers** - GroupWise, IBM Domino (Lotus Domino), Microsoft Exchange Server, and Office 365.
- **Web-Based Email Clients** - Gmail, Google Apps, Yahoo, AOL, Hotmail.com, Live.com, Outlook.com, iCloud, and company IMAP account.

1.3 Salient Features

Salient features of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software include:

- Adeptly repairs PST data files along with its data items like deleted emails, folders, appointments, tasks, notes, calendar, journals, drafts, emails, etc.
- Proficiently recover emails from encrypted as well as password-protected PST files
- Recovers the permanently deleted or accidentally deleted emails of PST files
- Preserves email metadata, such as To, From, Subject, Time, CC, BCC, Date etc.
- Provides advanced save facility that enables the migration of recovered PST files on email servers like IBM Domino, MS Exchange Server, Novell GroupWise, and company IMAP account
- Facilitates the storage of recovered PST files to OWA or Office 365 cloud-based application
- Efficiently converts the recovered PST files to Apple mail supported MBOX format
- Integrated with an option of saving the recovered PST email items to the well-known Web-based email applications like Gmail, AOL, Yahoo, iCloud, Hotmail, Google Apps, Live Mail, and Outlook
- Proficiently recover attachments, zipped attachments, and images from corrupt PST files
- Embedded with Find functionality for easing the PST email search operations
- Provides multiple saving options, which includes various file formats like PST, MBOX, TXT, RTF, HTML, MSG, MHTML, DBX, IMAP, PDF, and EML
- Integrated with Save and Load Snapshot options, which helps in capturing the PST file recovery process and subsequently helps in loading the same process further in the future
- Offers advanced email filter options for refined segregation of email items on the basis of date-range option
- Completely restores the formatting, properties, and structure of PST data files
- Merged with an option to generate File Analysis Reports that unambiguously capture the graphical reports on total item types, Mail flow density by date or senders, and interaction between users

- Allows easy previewing of recovered PST data files and saving in various different saving options PST, MSG, DBX, and EML
- Embedded with preview technology
- Offers the 30-day money-back guarantee
- Available in the free trial version

2. Getting Started

Now that you have understood the features and potential of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, you are ready to get a hands-on experience of the software. To initiate the PST file recovery process, at first you need to download and then install the software. But, before downloading and installing the software, it is strictly advised to scan the installation pre-requisites for ensuring that the system is appropriately configured to run the software.

2.1 Installation Pre-requisites

The various pre-requisites for installing and running Kernel for Outlook PST Repair can be broadly classified into two major categories – Hardware requirements and Software requirements.

2.1.1. Hardware Requirements:

The hardware requirements for installing the software are as follows:

- Pentium Class Processor
- Minimum 512 MB RAM
- 20 MB for Software installation
- Disk Space - Enough space to store the repaired files

2.1.2 Software Requirements:

The software requirements for installing the software are as follows:


Supported MS Windows Operating System: Windows XP, Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 8.1, Windows 10, Windows 95/NT, Windows XP, Windows Server 2000, Windows Server 2003, Windows Server 2008, Windows Server 2008 R2, and Windows Server 2012

Supported MS Outlook Versions: MS Outlook 97,98, MS Outlook 2000, MS Outlook 2002, MS Outlook 2003, MS Outlook 2007, MS Outlook 2010, MS Outlook 2013 and MS Outlook 2016

2.2 Downloading Kernel for Outlook PST Repair for the First Time

After checking your computer with the prescribed system requirements for Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, you can download and install the software on your computer. If you want to try using Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software

before buying it, you can download the evaluation version from the following link:

 The free trial version of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair tool permits you to recover data from an infected or damaged PST file but restricts you from saving more than 25 email items of each folder.

2.3 Install Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

After downloading the installer file for Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, you can install the software by running the file. To install Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, perform the following steps:

- Double-click the Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software installer file.
- Follow the on-screen instructions. The Setup Installation Completion screen will be displayed.
- Click Finish to launch the software. The main window of the software appears.

2.4 Start Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

To start Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software, Click Start > All Programs > Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

Alternatively, you can launch Kernel for Outlook PST Repair by double-clicking the shortcut icon available on the desktop and Quick Launch icon.


2.5 Uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

You may need to uninstall and re-install Kernel for Outlook PST Repair. To uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software,

1. Click Start > All Programs > Kernel for Outlook PST Repair > Uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair

A warning message will be displayed.

2. Click Yes to uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair.

 Before proceeding to uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software, you must ensure that the software is not running.

You can alternatively uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair from the Control Panel by performing the following steps:

1. Click Start > Control Panel, and then double-click Add or Remove Programs icon.
2. Select Kernel for Outlook PST Repair and click Remove.

A warning message will be displayed.

3. Click Yes to uninstall Kernel for Outlook PST Repair.

3 Software Interface

Now that Kernel for Outlook PST Repair has been installed on your computer, you can start using the software after getting acquainted with the software interface.

3.1 Menu-bar

The menu bar of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair comprises of four menus– File, View, Find, and Help.

3.1.1 File Menu

The File menu of the software appears as:

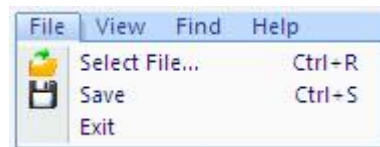


Figure 3.1 File Menu

Option	Description
Select File	Opens “Source File Selection” dialog so that you can select or search source PST file
Save	Opens “Select Output Type” dialog so that you can select required saving option
Exit	Click to exit from the application

The View menu of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software appears, as shown in following figure:

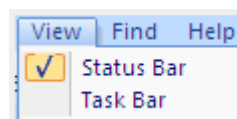


Figure 3.2 View Menu

Find menu expands over Find Message bar to assist the user:

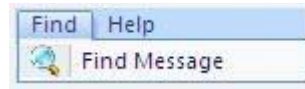


Figure 3.3: Find Menu

The Help menu of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software appears, as shown in the following figure:

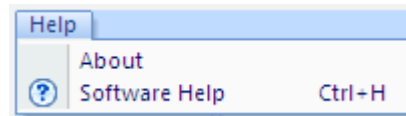


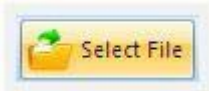
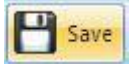



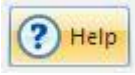
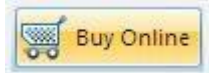
Figure 3.4 Help Menu

3.2 Tool-bar

The toolbar is located just below the menu-bar of the software interface. It offers a convenient and interactive method for performing varied functions that are otherwise performed by using the Menu Bar. The following buttons are highlighted in the toolbar, and each button has their respective functionalities:

Button	Button Description
	Opens "Source File Selection" dialog to browse or locate source corrupt PST file
	Opens "Select Output Type" dialog, which helps in selecting the required saving options
	Saves a snapshot of the PST recovery instance to the desired location.
	Loads a previously saved snapshot from the specified location
	Allows easy searching of required emails from selected PST file
	Displays User's Help Manual for Kernel for Outlook PST Repair
	Navigates to the online purchase portal of the software

3.3 Button Used

Kernel for Outlook PST Repair comprises various buttons in both Left and Right pane. Below we have mentioned the buttons in detail.

3.3.1 Left-Pane

Left Pane of Kernel for Outlook PST enhances the viewing experience of the PST file recovery process as it renders the preview of recovered PST email items in a tree-like hierarchical structure. You can navigate through various folders and files that were extracted after stringent PST file recovery process. The retrieved files and folders are displayed like this in the Left Pane as shown in the screenshot given below:

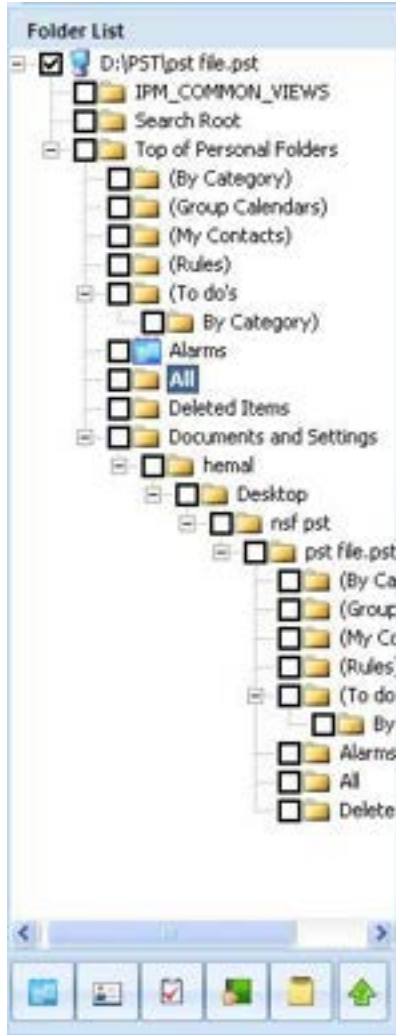


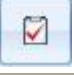






Figure 3.5: Left-Pane

In addition to this, there are some additional buttons placed at the bottom in the Left Pane, which is mentioned below in the following table:

	Contacts	Shows Contacts and related information in Right Pane
	Tasks	Shows Tasks in the Right Pane
	Journal	Shows Journals in the Right Pane
	Notes	Shows Notes in the Right Pane
	Up	Displays the Folder Path pane in the Left Pane
	Down	Hides the Folder Path pane in the Left Pane

3.3.2 Right-Pane

Right Pane of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair displays every single email item in the folder or file selected from the Left Pane. The Right Pane is again divided into three different panes (as shown in the image below):

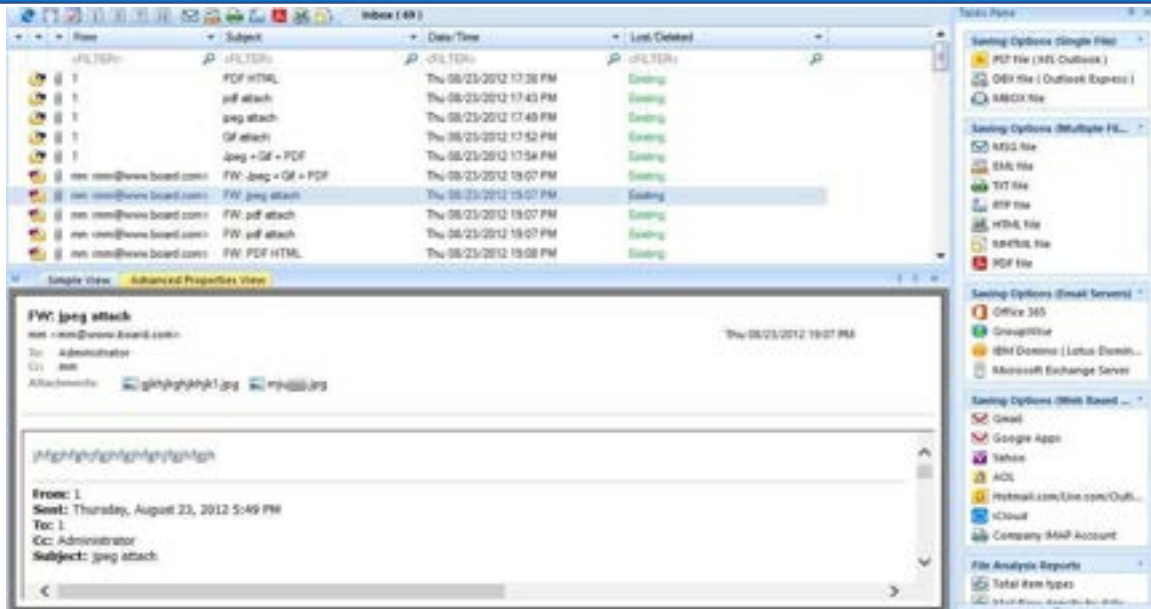






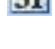









Figure 3.6: Right-Pane

	Save list information to html file	Allows you to save the list information in HTML format
	Stop current process	Stops the current process
	Show/hide calendar view	Shows or hides the calendar view in Display Pane
	Show one day	Shows the calendar entries for a particular day
	Show working days	Shows the calendar entries for five days
	Show weekdays	Shows the calendar entries for the entire week
	Show month days	Shows the calendar entries for the entire month
	Save in MSG	Saves the listed email items in MSG format

	Save in EML	Saves the listed email items in EML format
	Save in TXT	Saves the listed email items in TXT format
	Save in RTF	Saves the listed email items in RTF format
	Save in PDF	Saves the listed email items in PDF format
	Save in HTML	Saves the listed email items in HTML format
	Save in MHTML	Saves the listed email items in MHTML format

Preview Pane - Shows the preview of contents of email items selected in Display Pane.

Task Pane – Displays the varied range of Save Options along with the display of the File Analysis Reports section. The Task Pane is further sub-divided into five different sections that are mentioned in the following bullet points:

- **Saving Options (Single File)** – PST file, DBX file, and MBOX file
- **Saving Options (Multiple Files)** – MSG file, EML file, TXT file, RTF file, HTML file, MHTML file, and PDF
- **Saving Options (Email Servers)** – Office 365, GroupWise, IBM Domino (Lotus Domino), and Microsoft Exchange
- **Saving Options (Web-Based Email Apps)** – Gmail, Google Apps, Yahoo, AOL, Hotmail.com, Live.com, Outlook.com, iCloud, and Company IMAP Account
- **File Analysis Reports** – Total item types, Mail flow density by date, Mail flow density by senders, and Interaction between users

4. Using Kernel for Outlook PST Repair Software

Kernel for Outlook PST Repair performs the flawless recovery of inaccessible or damaged PST files and saves the recovered data files to the various different locations like Web-based email apps, Email servers or in the latest available file formats, including PST, DBX, and EML. You can view these recovered email items on the MS Outlook as well as Outlook Express applications along with the variety of other applications.

4.1 Quick Scan

Using Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, you can efficiently repair PST data files and extracts the email data items from inaccessible PST files. The software creates a new PST file with the extracted data from corrupt PST file and saves the same at a user-defined location. Mentioned below are the steps to repair PST file using the Kernel for Outlook PST Repair software:

1. Click **Start > All Programs > Kernel for Outlook PST Repair > Kernel for Outlook PST Repair** to launch the software. The main window of the software appears:

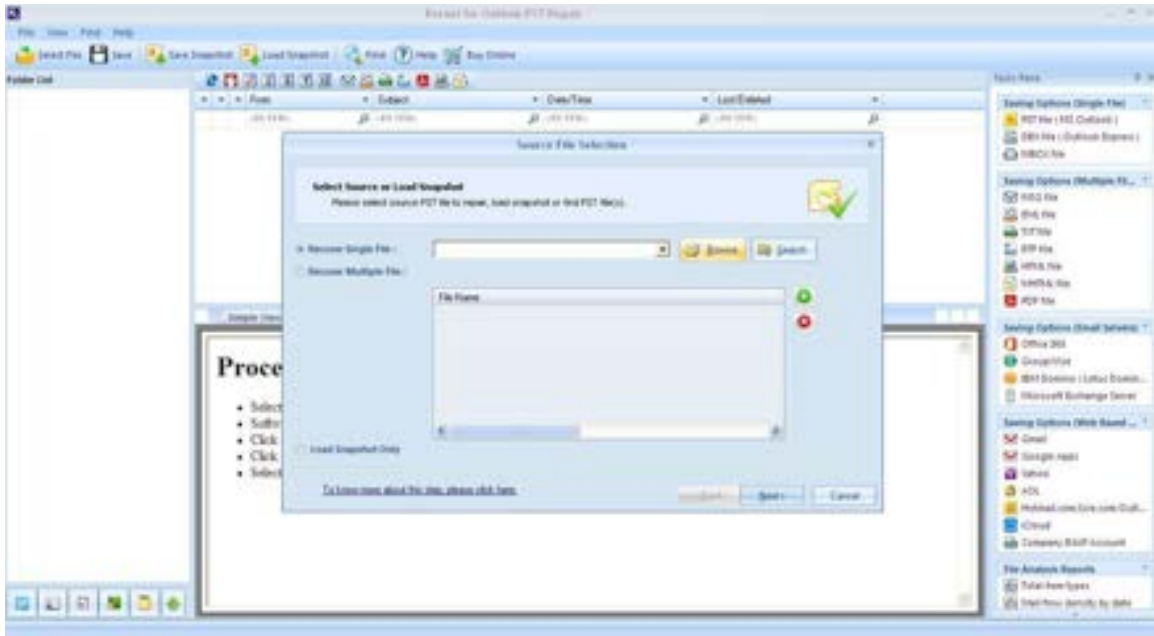


Figure 4.1: Main Screen of Kernel for Outlook PST Software

2. Click the **Browse** button to select the PST file, if you already know the location of PST file. However, if you do not know the exact location of PST file, click the **Search** button, and “Search PST file(s)” dialog box appears.

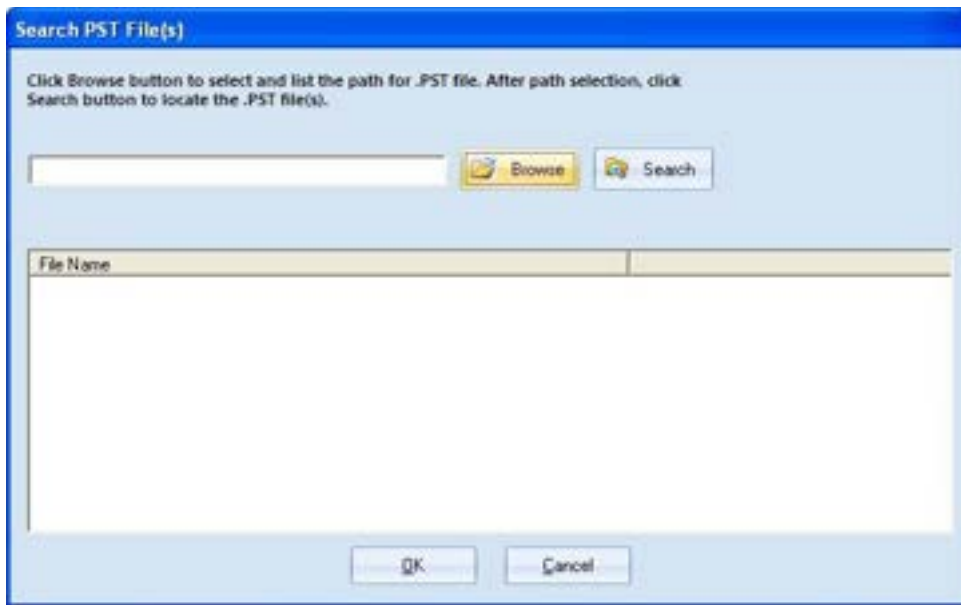


Figure 4.2: Search PST File (s)

- 3. Click the **Browse** button to select the folder where you want to search for the PST file. After selecting the required drive, click the **Search** button.

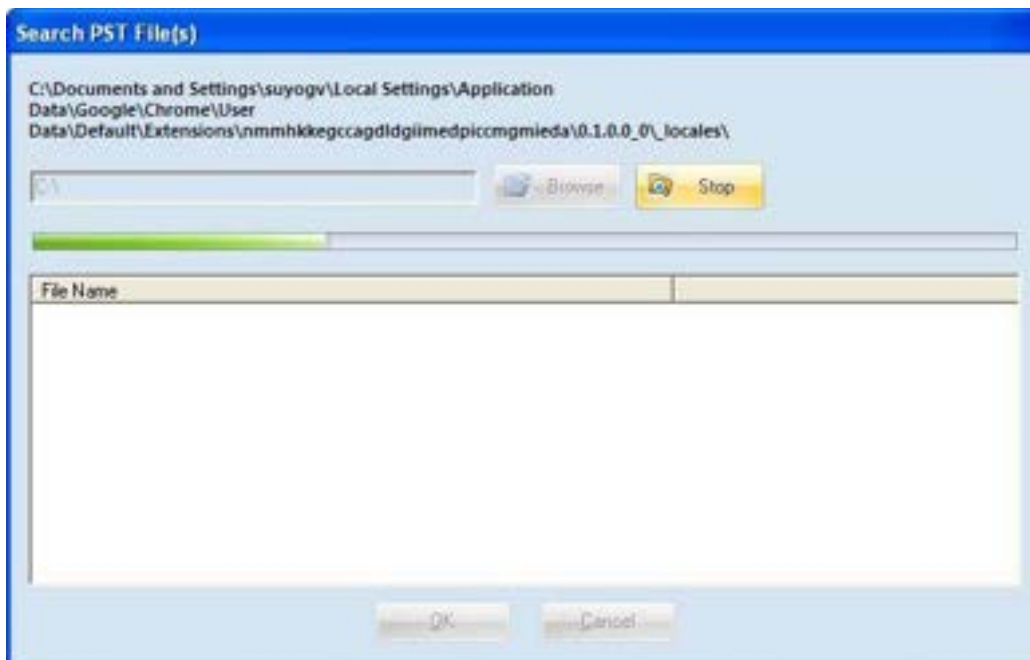


Figure 4.3: Scanning Drive for PST Files

- 4. Software will enlist the PST files found in the selected drive:

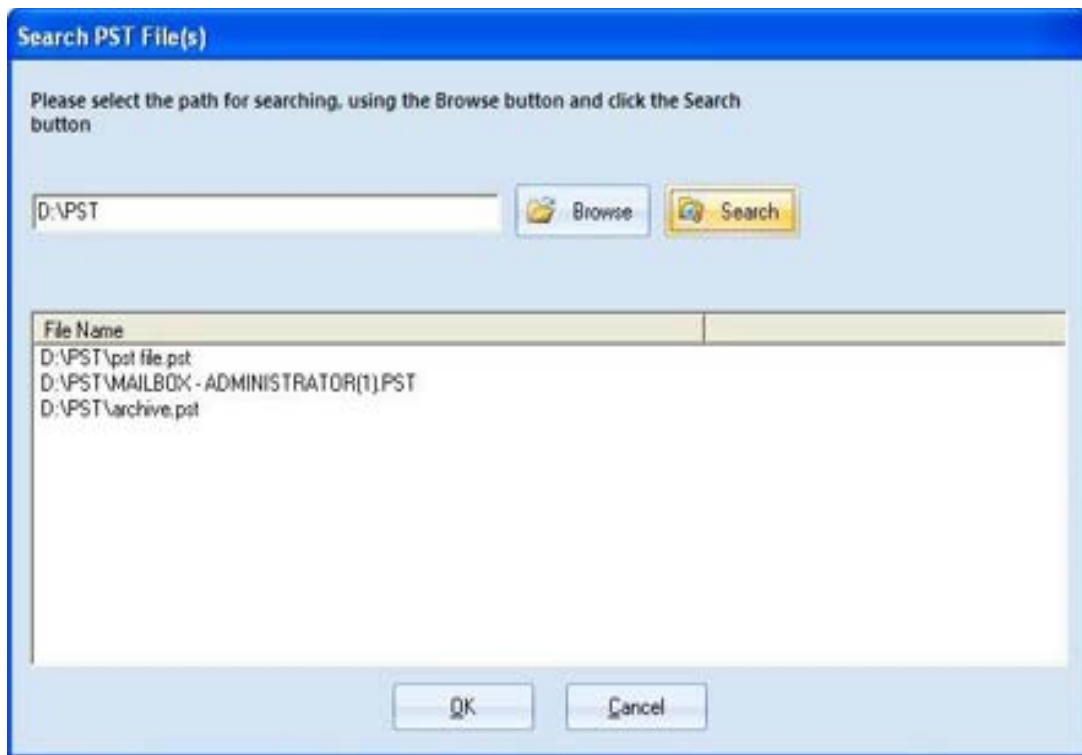


Figure 4.4: Available PST files enlisted

5. Select the required file and click the **OK** button.
6. The selected PST file will get enlisted in the "Source File Selection" dialog. Apart from this, you can add multiple PST files, and then subsequently select **Repair Multiple File(s)** option for repairing multiple PST files:

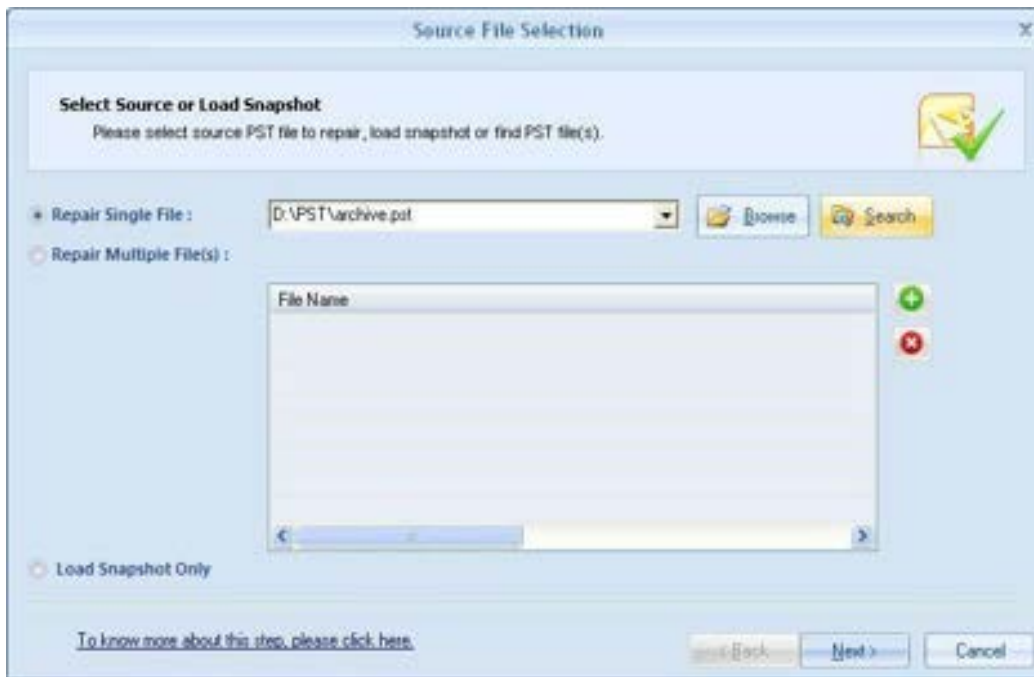



Figure 4.5: Select corrupted source PST file dialog

 **Note:** Alternatively, to load a previously saved snapshot, select Load Snapshot Only checkbox and click Next to load the snapshot.

7. Click the **Next** button, the “**Select Recovery Mode**” window is displayed. The “**Select Recovery Mode**” window displays all the available options of repairing and saving the PST data files.

- 8. Click **Finish** to start the scanning/repair process.

- 9. After the scanning process gets completed, the recovered email items will get enlisted in the Left Pane. Select any folder to view the contents in Right Pane.

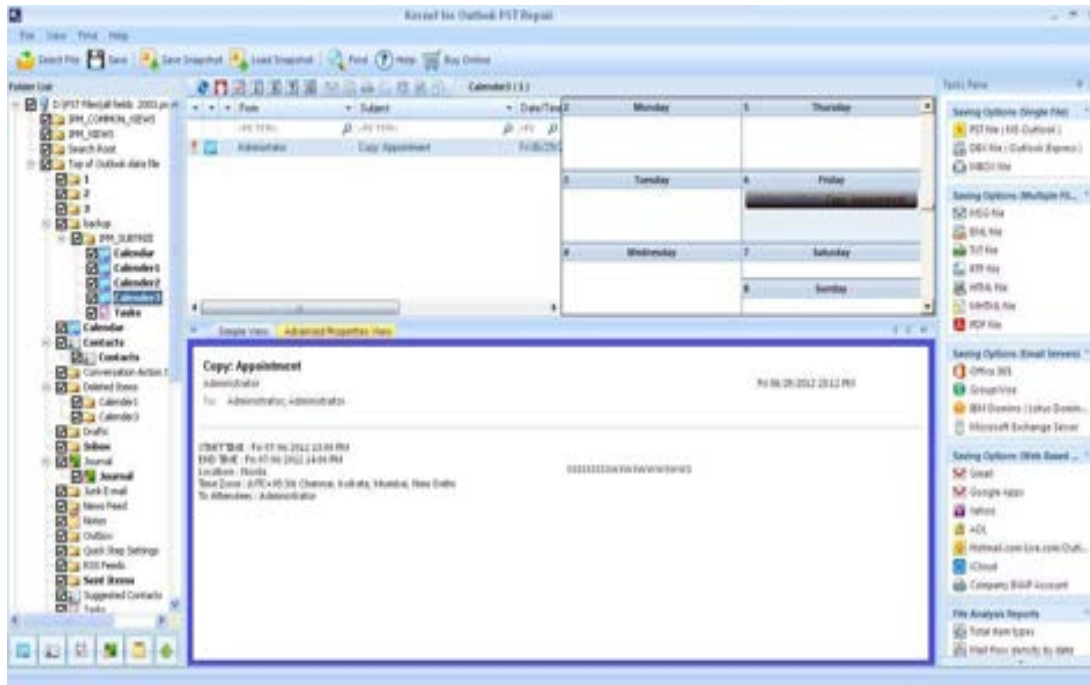


Figure 4.8: Preview Window

10. Select the folder from the Left Pane and click the **Save** button to proceed with the saving process of the recovered emails. By clicking the **Save** button, the "Select Output Type" dialog box appears on the screen.

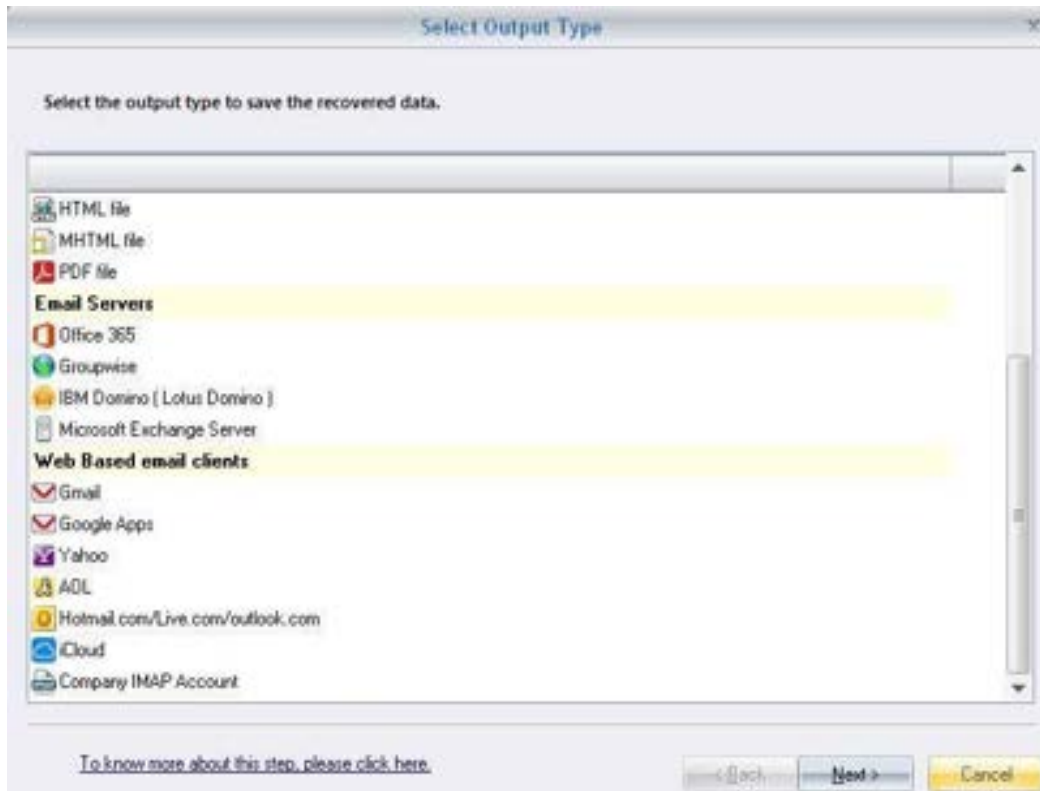


Figure 4.9: Select Output Type

11. Select the required format or location in which you wish to save and view the recovered data. Click the **Next** button to continue.
12. Select the desired location where you wish to save the newly created database file. The software will start saving the recovered data at the desired location.

- 13. After the recovered items get saved, the software displays the following message.

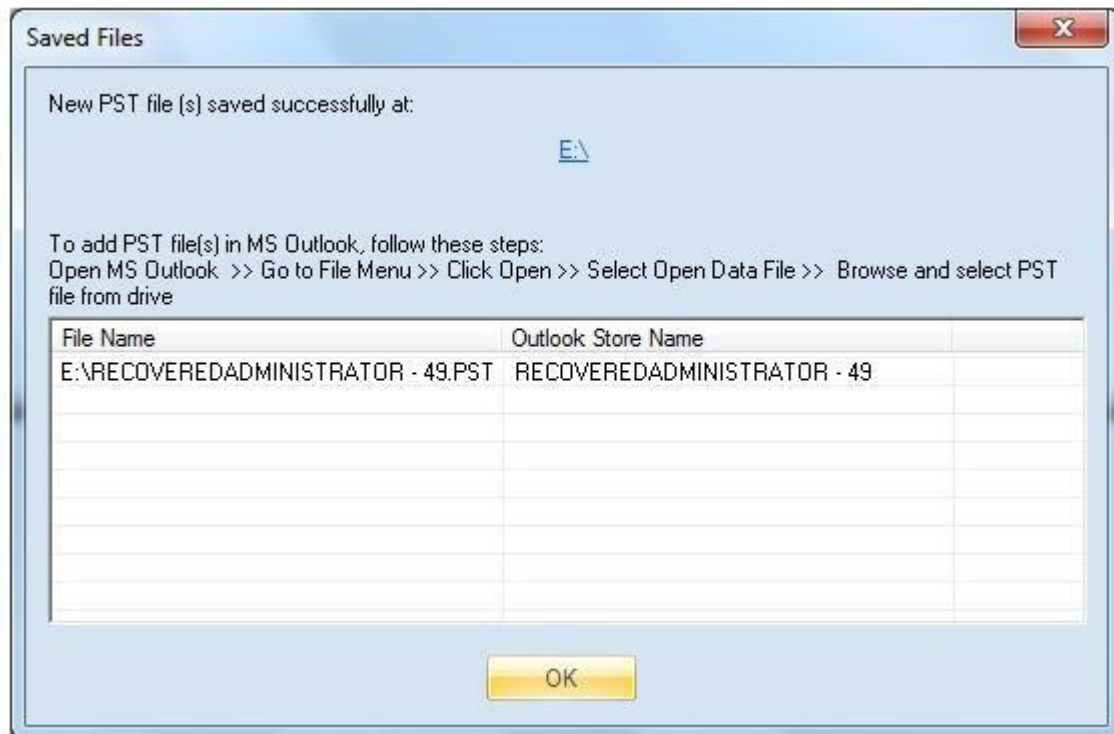


Figure 4.11: Saved Files

5. Saving Options

Finally, you have extracted the email data items from inaccessible and corrupted PST files, now you must save the recovered data files. Kernel for Outlook PST Repair offers the following distinct saving options to save and access the recovered PST files:

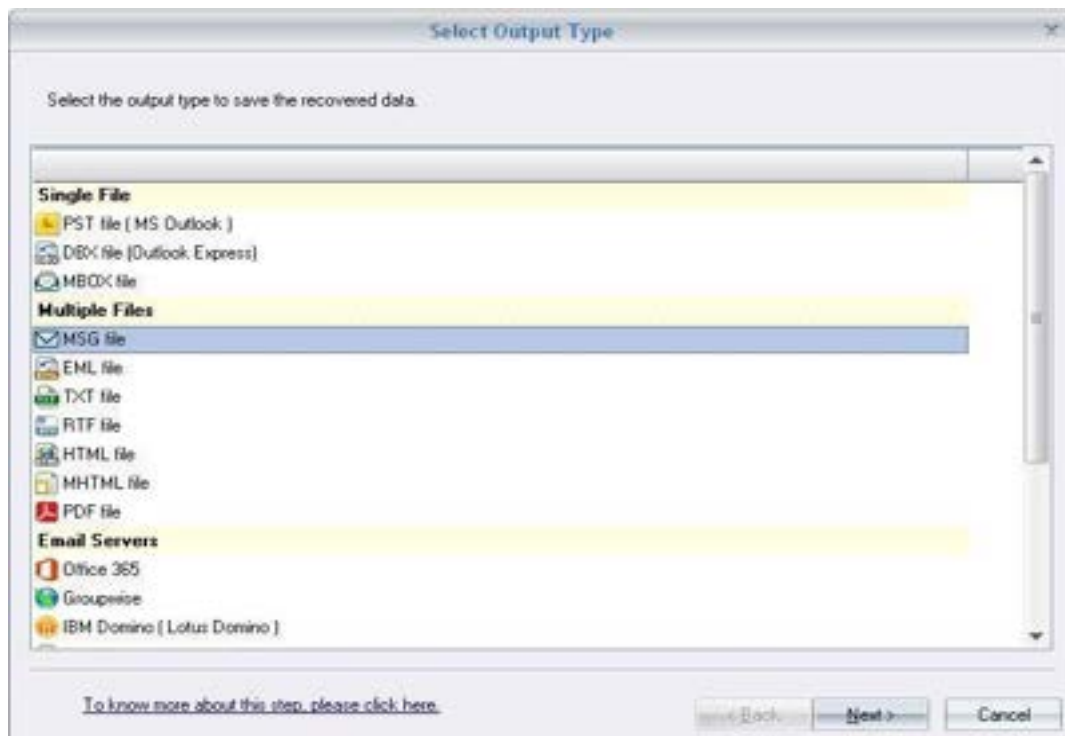


Figure 5: Saving Options Window

- **PST File (MS Outlook):** This option allows you to save recovered email data in MS Outlook.
- **DBX File (Outlook Express):** This option lets you to save recovered email data in format supported by Outlook Express.
- **MBOX File:** This option permits you to save the recovered email data in MBOX file format

The software also allows user to save the recovered individual email items in EML, MSG, TXT, RTF, PDF, HTML and MHTML formats. Apart from this, you can migrate the recovered email items to the popular email servers and Web based email applications. In addition, you can initiate this migration facility by clicking the **Email Servers** or **Web Based email clients** sections, which are present in the task pane.

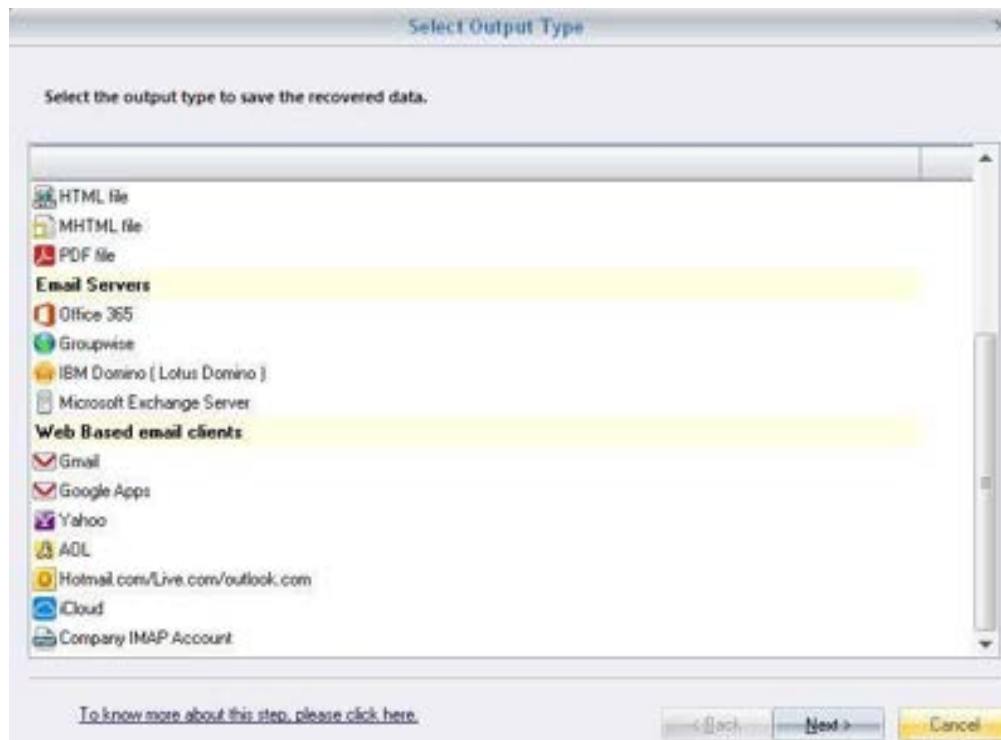


Figure 5.0: Saving Options Window (Contd..)

5.1 Save In PST

In order to access data with MS Outlook, you can save the recovered email items in PST, MSG, and EML format. Select the **PST file (MS Outlook)** option to save the recovered data in PST file format. The step-by-step procedure for saving the recovered data in PST file format is depicted in the following instructions given below:

1. After the definite recovery of PST email items, select the **PST file (MS Outlook)** option and click the **Next** button in the “**Select Output Type**” dialog box.

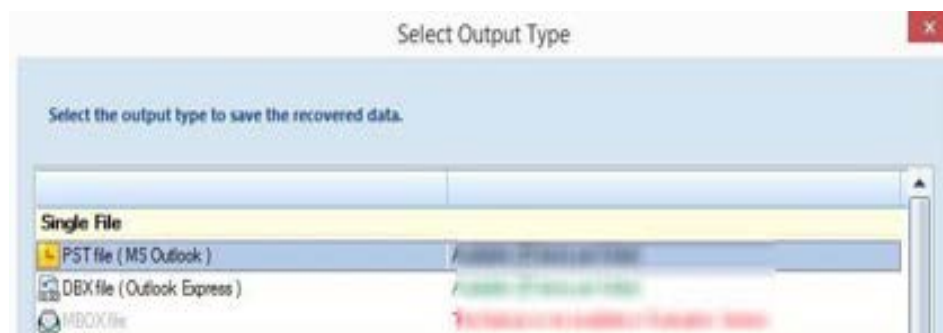


Figure 5.1: Select Output Type dialog

2. The selection of **PST file (MS Outlook)** option displays the “**Select Filter (s)**” dialog. Select the desired filter options, and then click the **Next** button to proceed.

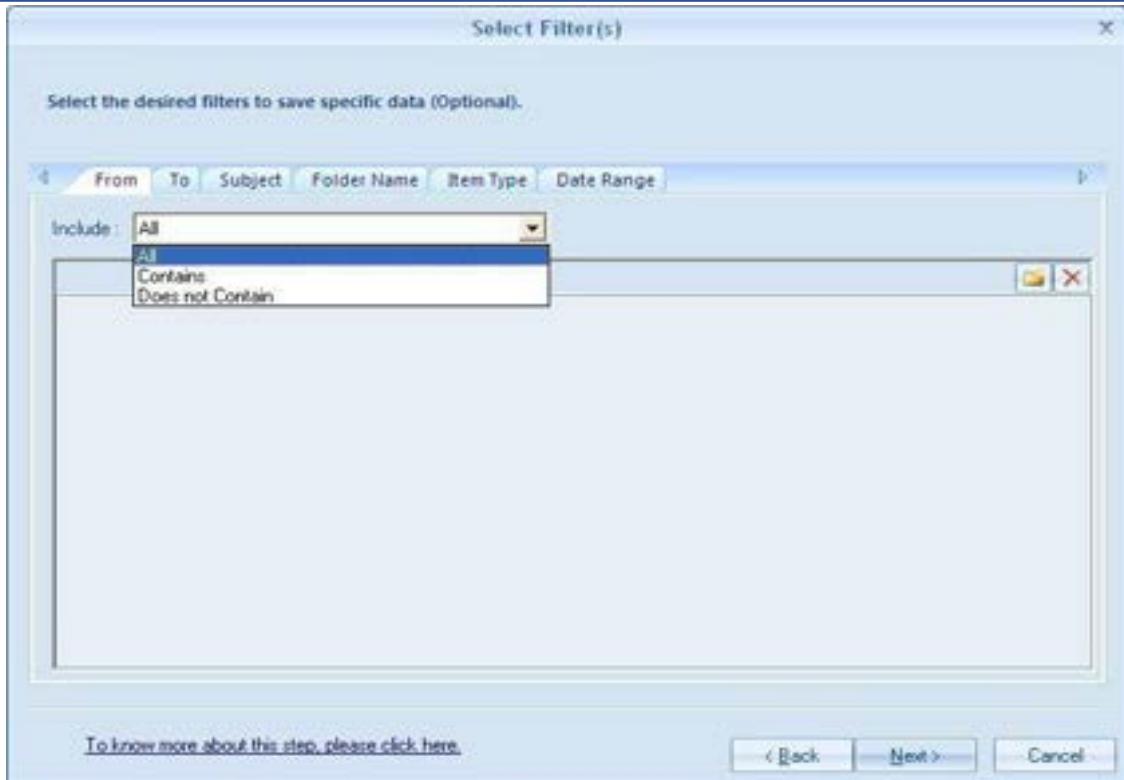


Figure 5.2: Select Filter Dialog


3. After configuring the desired filter options, the "Manage Recovered PST" dialog box appears.

Here you can split the large sized PST file using the various split options:

Split Options	Functions
Do not split file	Select this option if you want to create a single PST file
Split file after 1 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 1 GB files
Split file after 1.5 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 1.5 GB files
Split file after 2 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 2 GB files
Split file after 2.5 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 2.5 GB files
Split file after 3 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 3 GB files
Split file after 3.5 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 3.5 GB files
Split file after 4 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 4 GB files
Split file after 5 gb	Select this option to split the pst into equal 5 GB files

 **Note:** There is an option of adding a prefix to the Store Name, if you enable this option and type the required prefix in the Store name prefix text box, then the recovered Store name will appear with the provided prefix in Outlook

- After clicking the **Next** button in the “**Managed Recovered PST**” dialog, the “**Select Destination Path**” dialog is displayed.

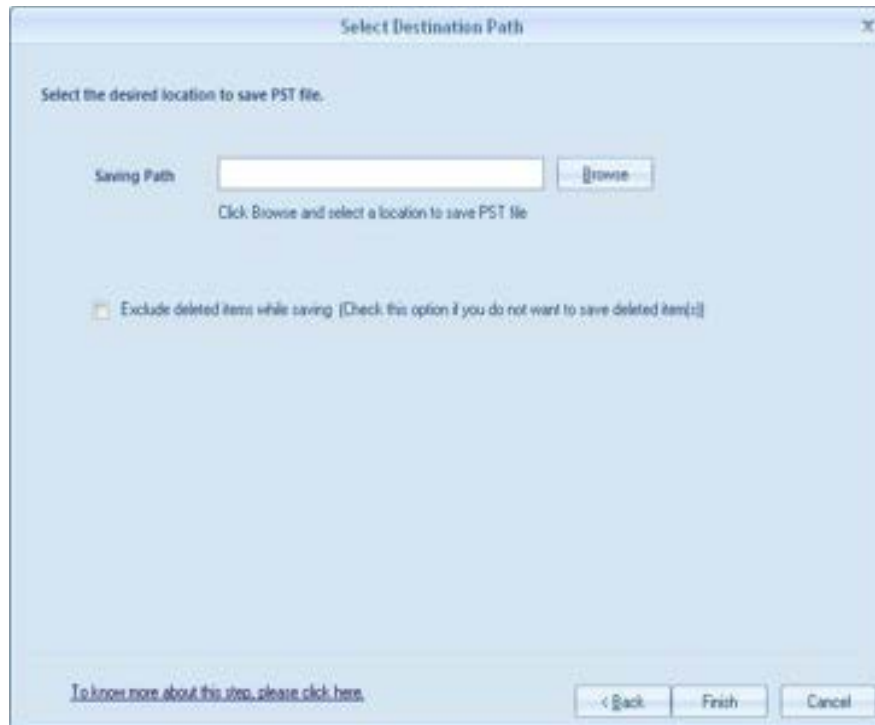


Figure 5.4: Select Destination Path

5. Click the **Browse** button, the "**Browse for Folder**" dialog appears.
6. Select the desired location to save the recovered data, and then click the **OK** button.

Note: Select the "Exclude deleted items while saving" checkbox, to exclude saving deleted items that are recovered from repaired PST file.

- 7. Click the **Finish** button to initiate the saving process.

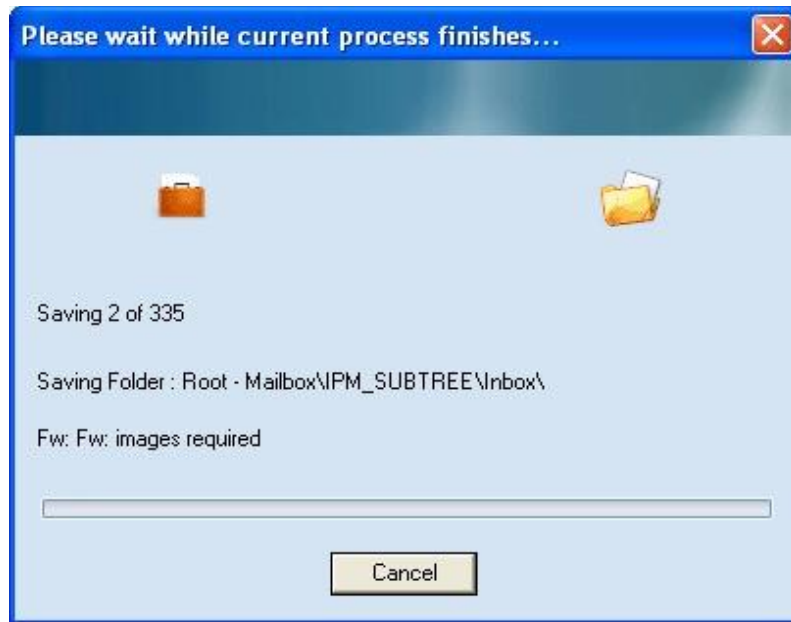


Figure 5.6: Saving Process

- 8. After the saving process gets accomplished, the software displays the following success message:

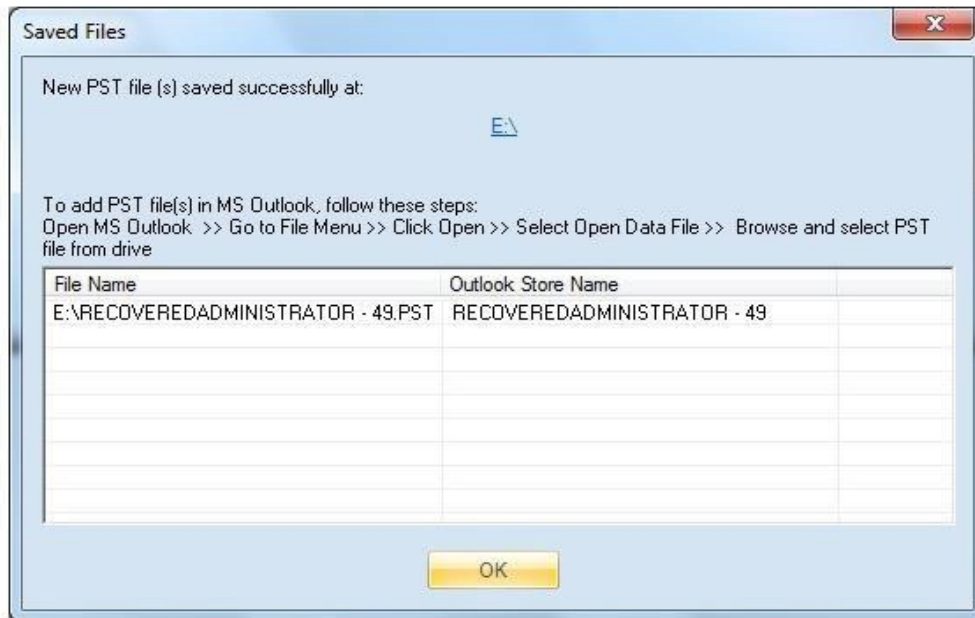


Figure 5.7: Saved Files dialog

To access the newly created PST file, you can click on the link given in the dialog box.

5.2 Save In MSG

Select the **MSG file** option to save all items in individual MSG files. In order to save the recovered data in the MSG file format, you can follow the instructions given below:

1. After the successful recovery of data files, email items are enlisted in the Left Pane, click the **Save** button in the Toolbar for initiating the saving process.
2. By clicking the **Save** button, the “**Select Output Type**” dialog is displayed. Select the **MSG file** option, and then click the **Next** button.

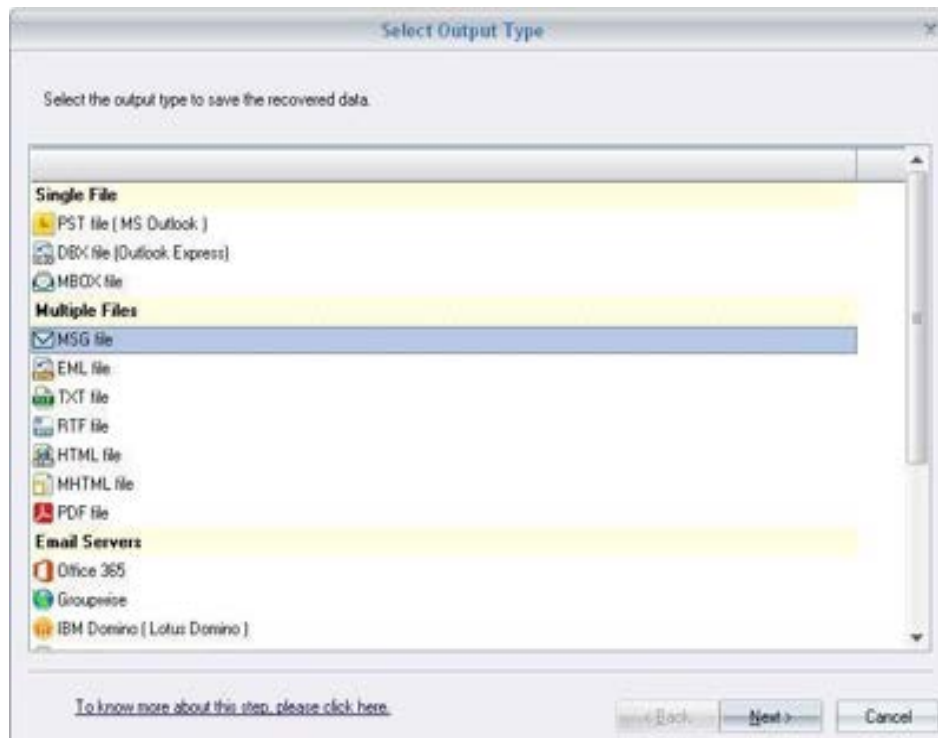


Figure 5.8: Select Output Type dialog

3. Click on the "**Next**" button and define the respective filter criterion, the '**Select Destination Path**' window follows asking for saving path.

- 4. Click the **Browse** button to locate the place for saving the MSG file that subsequently displays the **Browse For Folder** dialog box.

- 5. Click the **OK** button in the "**Browse for Folder**" dialog for assigning the folder to save the MSG files.
- 6. Click the **Finish** button to initiate the saving process.

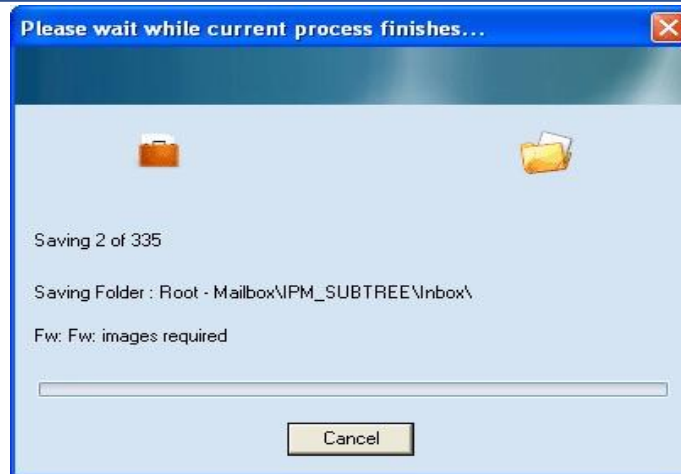


Figure 5.11: Saving Process

7. After the saving process gets completed, the software displays the following success message.

To access the newly created MSG file, you can click on the link given in the dialog.

5.3 Save in EML

Select the **EML file** option to save the recovered data in individual EML files. The following process depicts the step-by-step process of saving the recovered items in EML file format:

1. After the recovered data is enlisted in the Left Pane, click the **Save** button, which displays the "Select Output type" dialog box.
2. To save the recovered data in EML file format, select the **EML file** option.

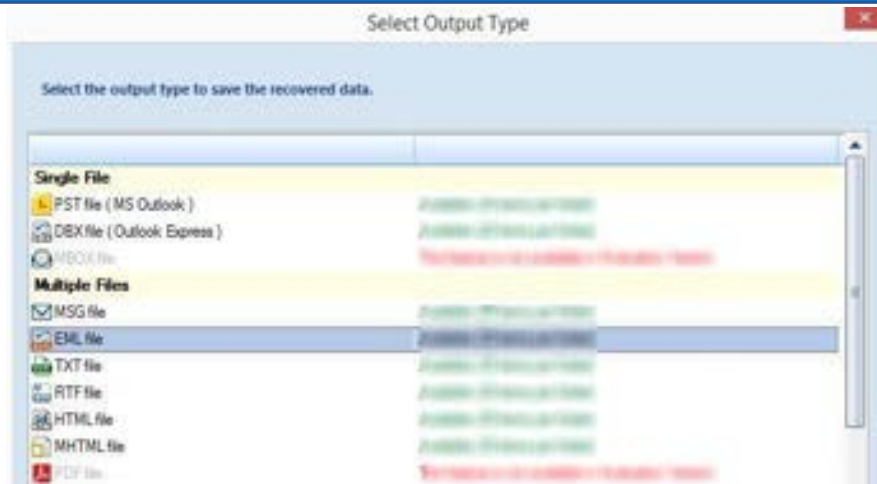


Figure 5.13: Select Output Type dialog

3. After selecting the **EML file** option, click the **Next** button, and then proceed by applying the desired filter options which then displays the “**Select Destination Path**” dialog.

4. In the “**Select Destination Path**” dialog, after you click the **Browse** button, the “**Browse For Folder**” dialog gets displayed. Set the desired saving location for saving the recovered EML file.

6. File Analysis Reports

The Kernel for Outlook PST software has been integrated with the facility to showcase the graphical File Analysis Reports showing the logs of four different parameters. These reports can be generated after adding and repairing the PST files. To view the reports, click the required report name in the bottom of the Task Pane, after repairing the PST file. The reports can be generated on the basis of the following attributes:

- Total item types
- Mail flow density by date
- Mail flow density by senders
- Interaction between users

6.1 Total Item types

The "Total item types" bar-graph shows a categorized view of all message classes. Users can view the count of each class in the graphical view or the tabular view.

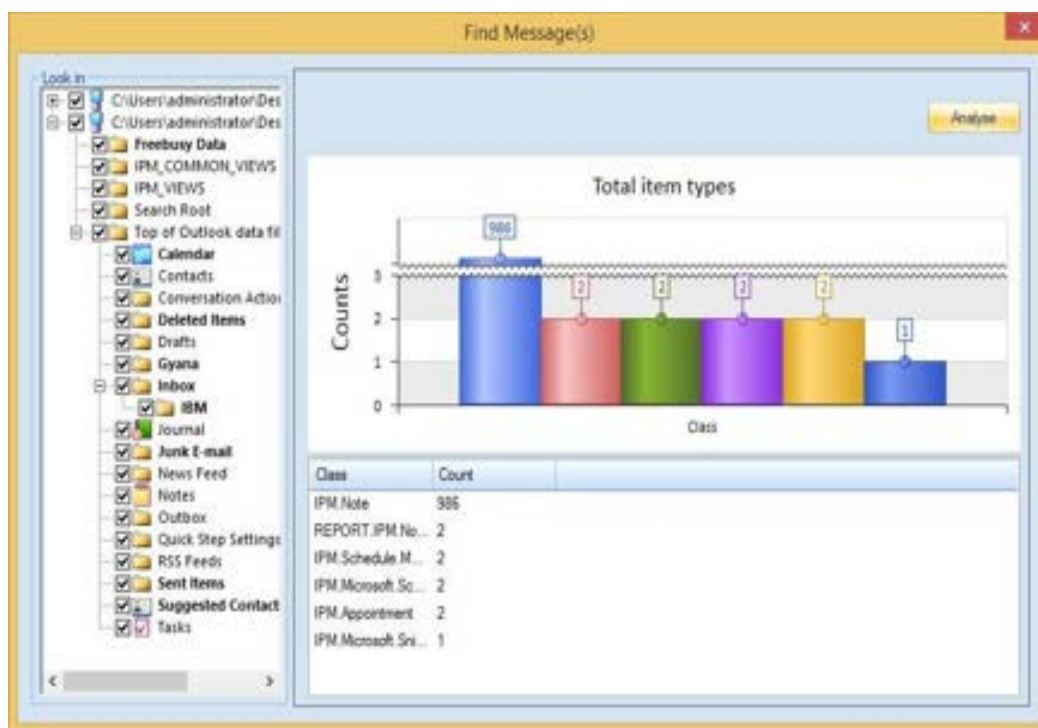


Figure 6.1: Total item types report

6.2 Mail flow density by date

The "Mail flow density by date" graph report shows the mail flow density on a different range of dates. It can also show the number of messages on different dates in the graphical bar-graph format.

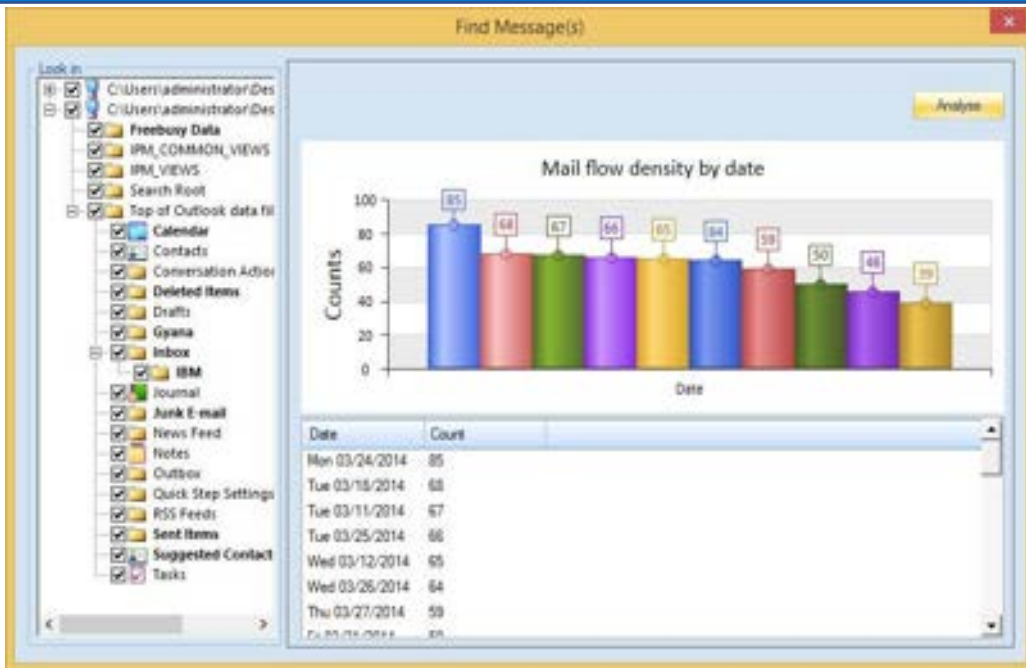


Figure 6.2: Mail flow density by date reports

6.3 Mail flow density by senders

The "Mail flow density by senders" graph report categorizes emails according to its senders. You can view the number of emails sent by senders for analysis purposes.

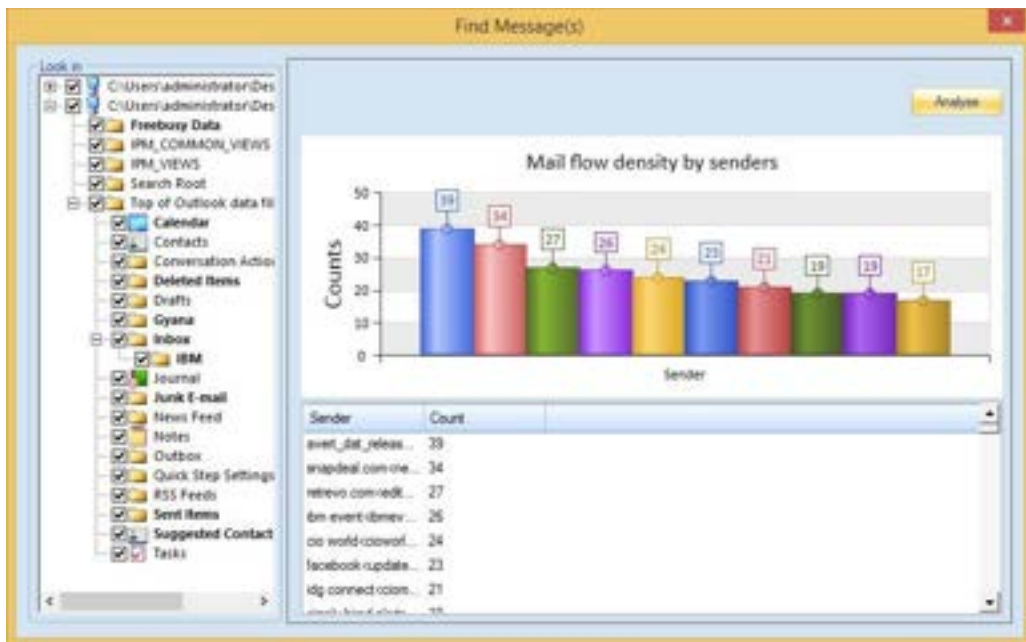


Figure 6.3: Mail flow density by senders report

6.4 Interaction between users

The "Interaction between users" graph shows the number of mail interactions amongst various users. The interaction between a particular sender and receiver can easily be noted from this graph.

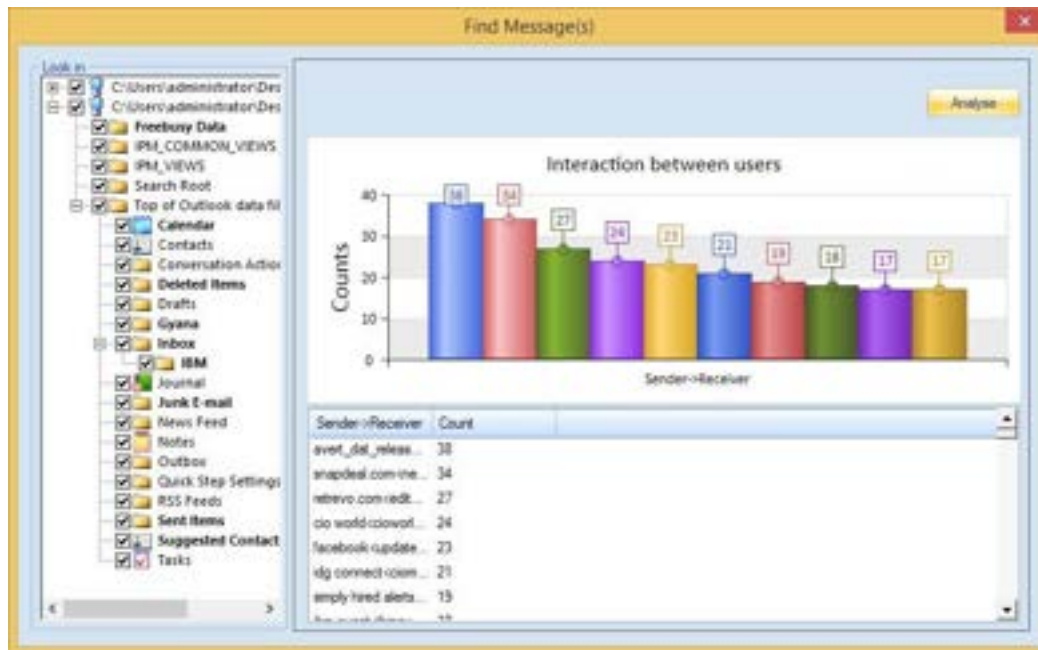


Figure 6.4: Interaction between users report

6.1 Common Issues

Why does Kernel for Outlook PST Repair have limitations in the evaluation copy?

Although you can run Kernel for Outlook PST Repair evaluation version for free, and then experience the capabilities of the software, but there are certain features that are not available in the evaluation version. By using the evaluation version of Kernel for Outlook PST Repair, you can repair corrupt .pst files; however, you cannot save more than 25 email items of each folder.
