# Get to know what's in your IBM Connections environment before migration

## ◆ Inventory Assessment / Source Analysis – The most important step of all!

Inventory assessment or the Source analysis is a step in the migration process that helps you determine the volume of content present in your IBM Connections environment. Before migrating the content to SharePoint, it is important for you to know what is in your IBM Connections environment and what you need to migrate to SharePoint.

**AVAMIGRATRON** is the only IBM Connections to SharePoint migration platform that helps you get comprehensive and in-depth details of your IBM Connections environment. You get the details on the number of communities, the date on which they were created, the number of members in each community, how actively they were used, and the complexity of the communities. Along with these, you will also get a detailed inventory report for the following.

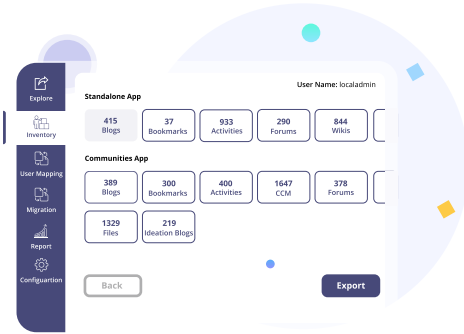
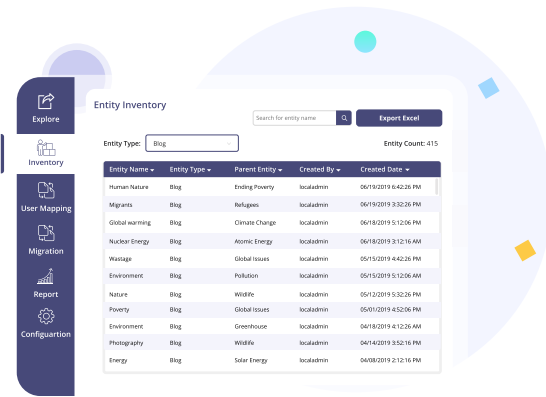
## ✦ Flexible Inventory option to make migration planning easier for you!

Want inventory for the entire communities and public apps that do not belong to any communities in your IBM Connections environment? Get it using this option.

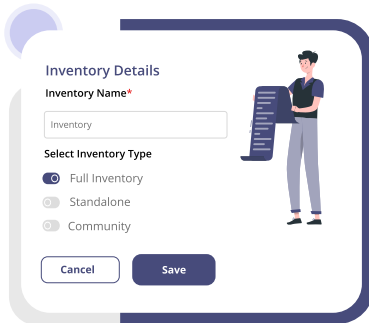
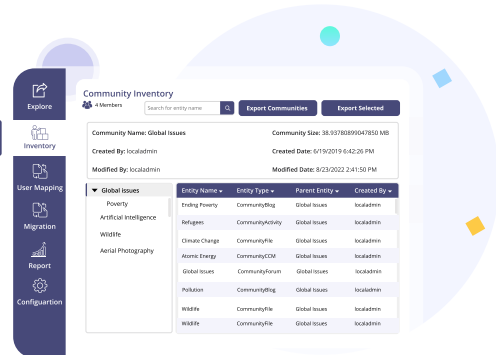


### Standalone Inventory

Get details of all the community apps from the Public Community, Moderated Community, and Restricted Community including Blogs, Activities, Bookmarks, Forums, Wikis, Files, Library, Ideation Blog, and Sub Communities in your IBM Connections environment.

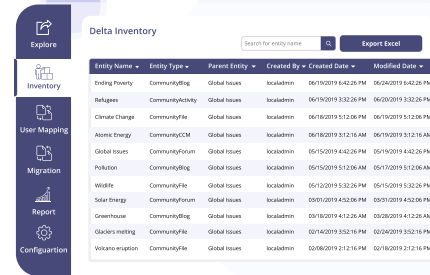


### Custom Inventory

If you want details of only a few communities or a specific community, use this option and fetch the details. You can fetch the details of apps for a specific community including Blogs, Activities, Bookmarks, Forums, Wikis, Files, Library, and Ideation Blogs.

## Delta Inventory

Alright! If you have taken the Inventory and want to get the details of the data growth in the existing inventories of the communities or the public apps that do not belong to any communities, Delta Inventory or Incremental Inventory options will help you get the inventory.

## Determine the complexity and plan for migration using AVAMIGRATRON
