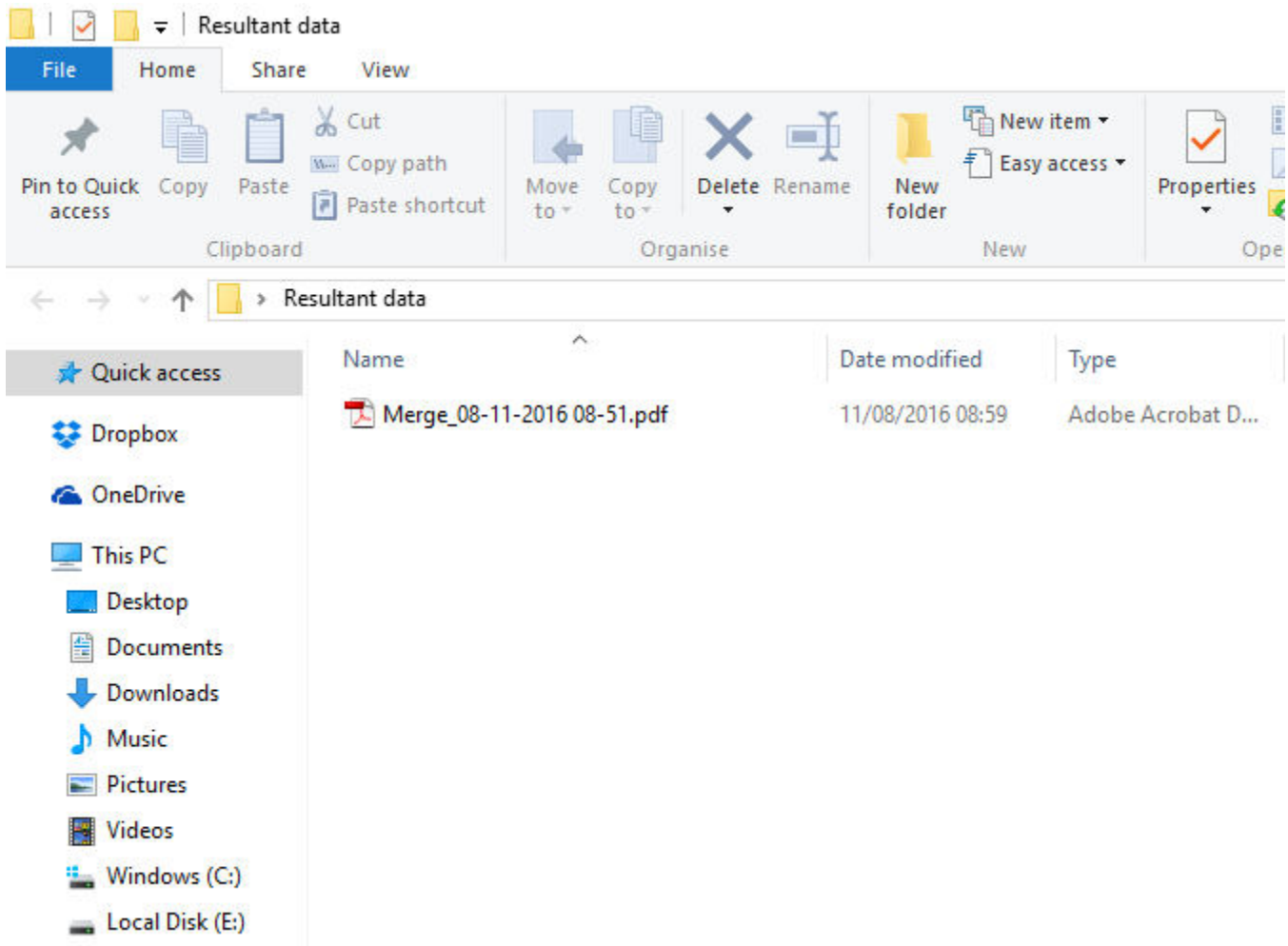
Step 2: The software panel will display the number of files/folders selected in the software panel itself. Once you are done selecting, click on the **Merge** option.
