

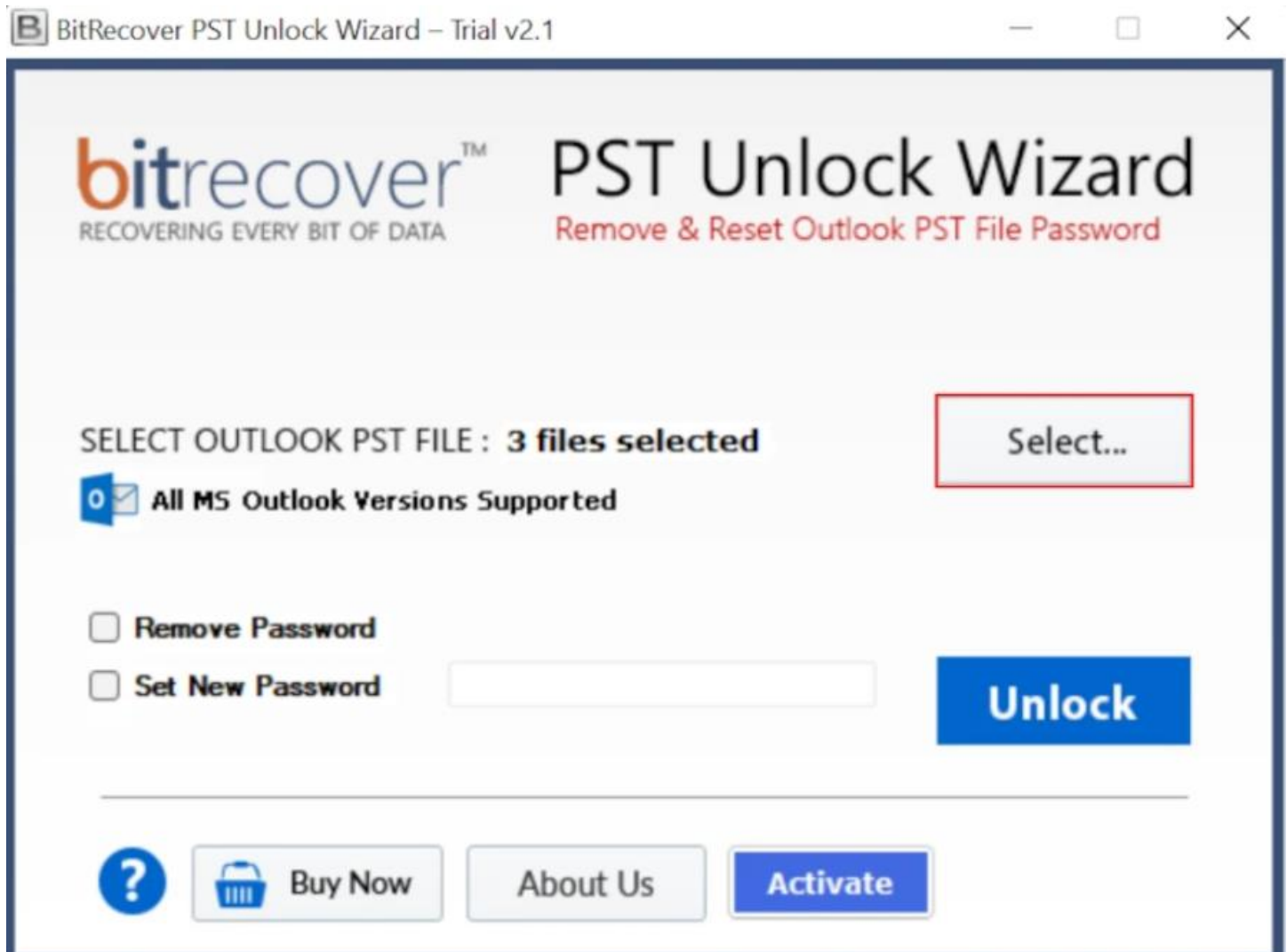
## BitRecover for PST Unlock Tool



**Step 2:** Tick the **Remove Password** option to remove the existing password from the selected PST file.

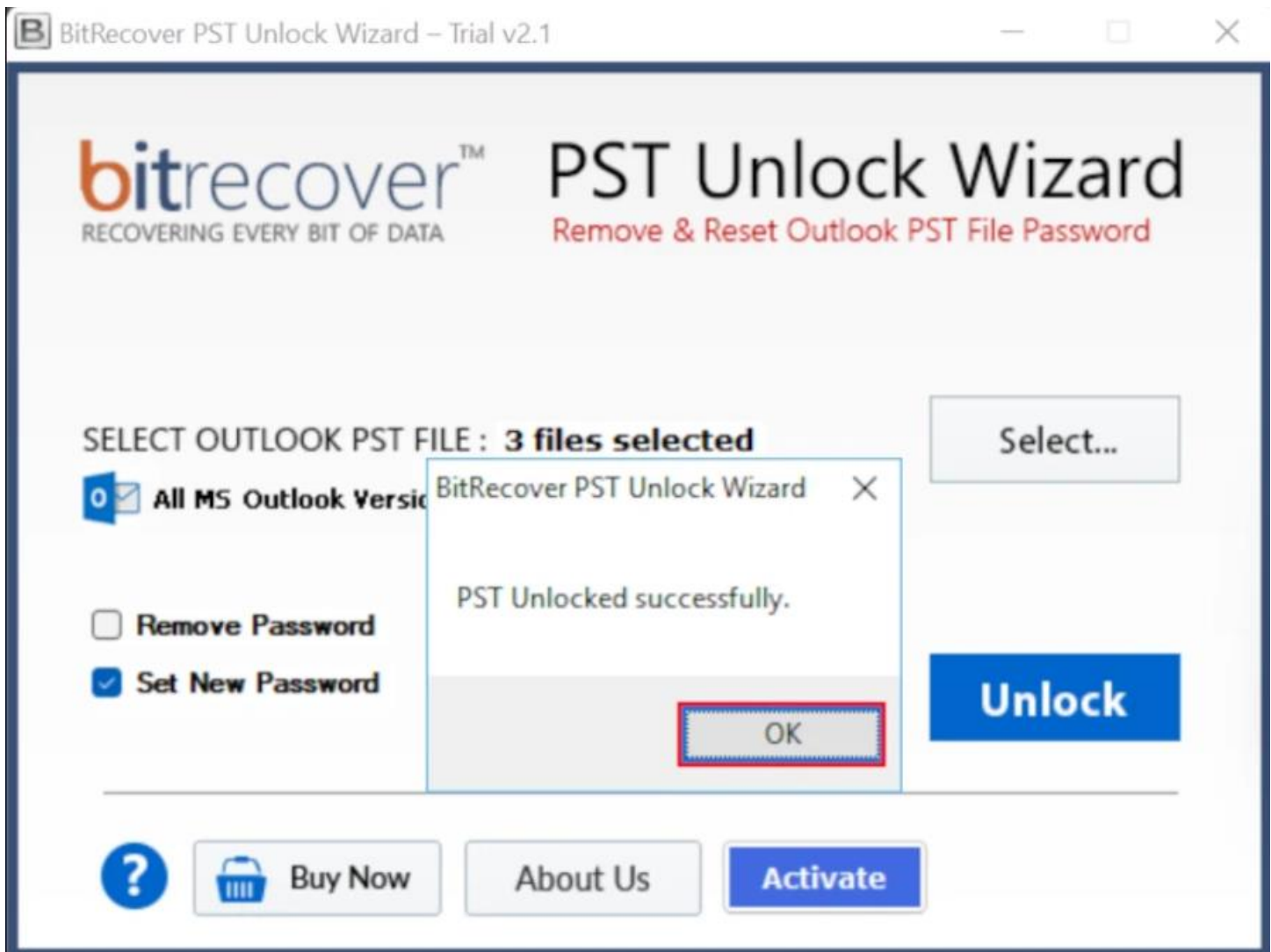
