
## Thunderbird Email Archive Tool


**Step 2:** Now, select the option of **Convert configured Thunderbird mailbox data** and then click **Next**.




**Step 3:** After this, **check or uncheck the folders** that you want to archive or not, respectively in your local desktop, then click on the Next button to archive Thunderbird email files.




**Step 4:** At this step, click on the **Select Saving Option** and explore the 30+ export options and select the one in which you want to archive the Thunderbird emails on the device.




**Step 5:** Then, navigate and choose the **saving location path as well as naming option** to archive Thunderbird email.
