

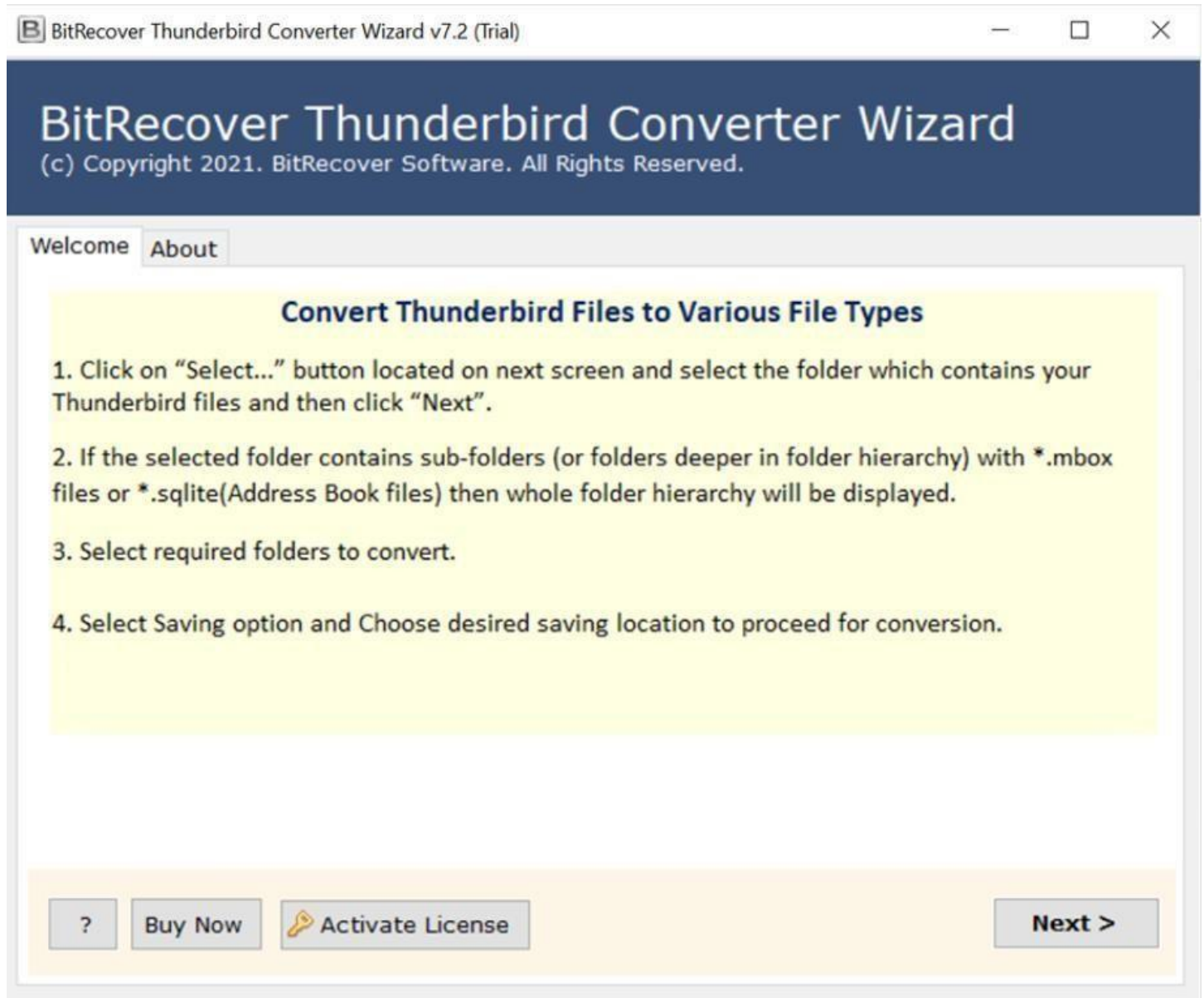

Best Tool to Export Attachments from Thunderbird

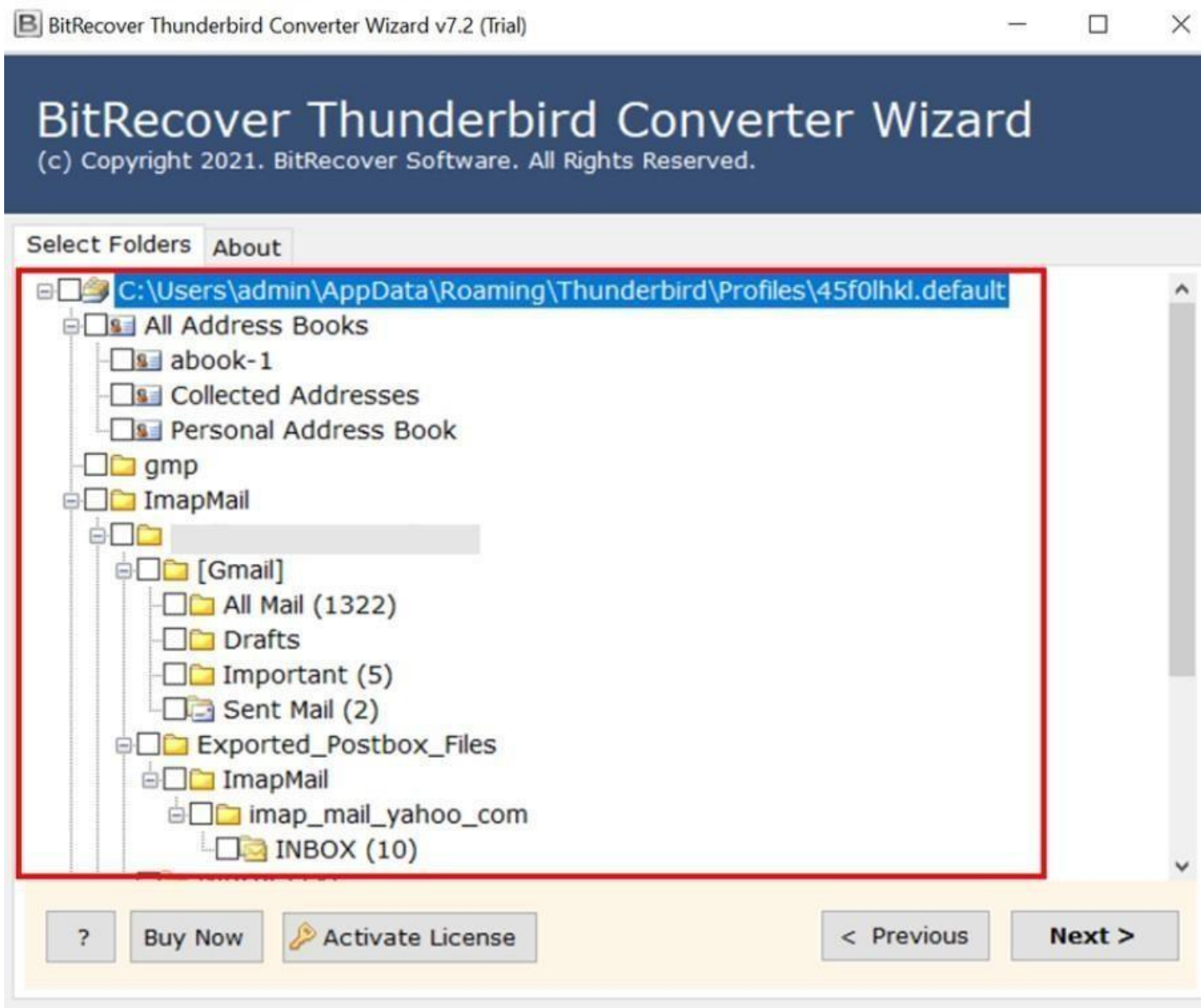

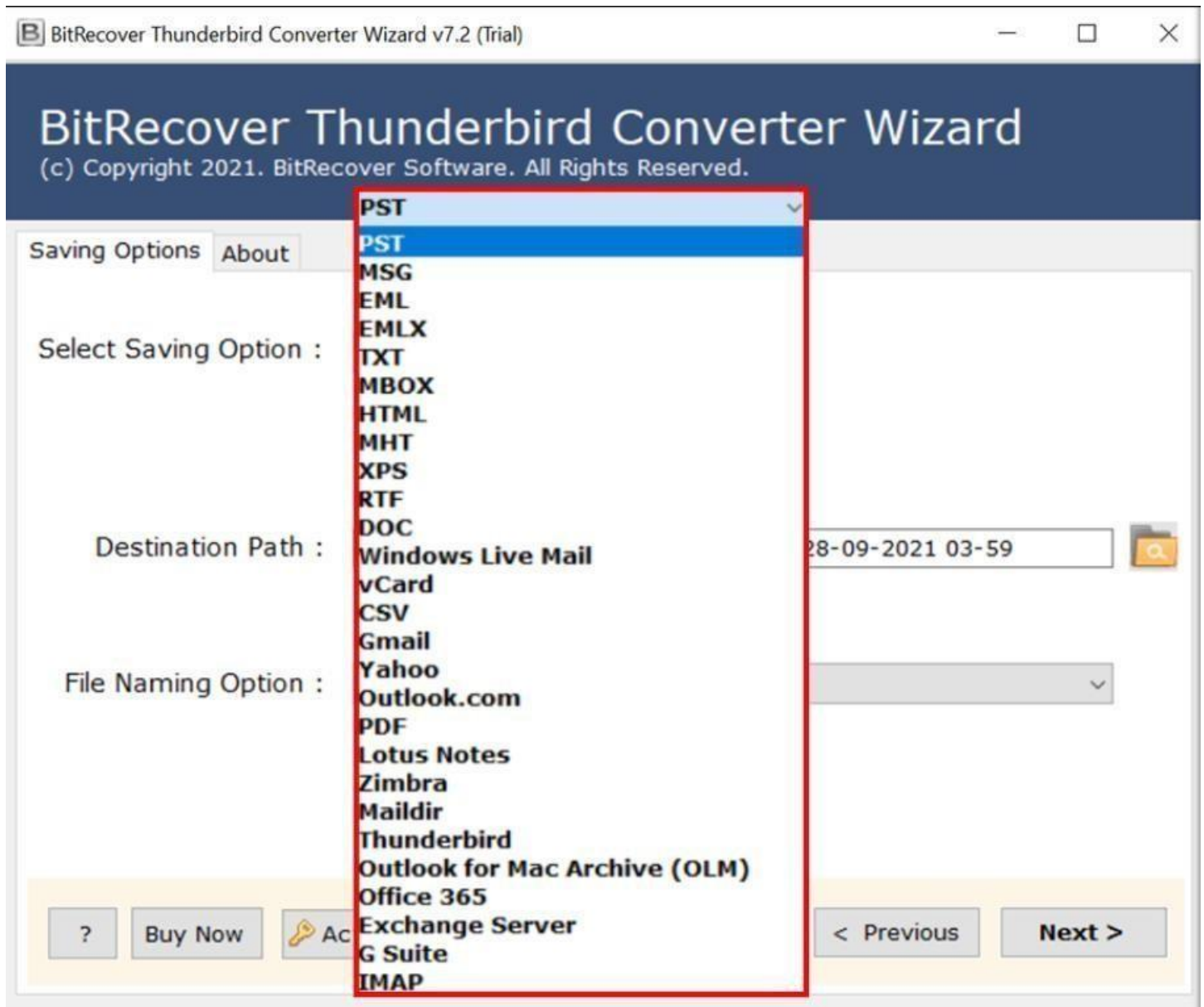
