How we do it?

In analyzing your Azure environment, we apply the proven process methods of Microsoft's Cloud Adoption Framework (CAF).

Analysis

- Assessment of your Azure maturity level based on Microsoft's Cloud Adoption Framework.
- Review of existing Azure architecture and documentation.
- Assessment of governance, security and cost efficiency aspects.

Inventory

- Identification and documentation of Azure resources using specialized inventory tools, and mapping of network, infrastructure, and workloads.
- Visualization of key components such as service usage, configurations, and dependencies.

Recommendations

- Comparison of findings with best practices from Microsoft Azure and Campana & Schott, with recommendations for governance, security, and cost savings.
- Presentation of a roadmap with prioritized next steps for Azure optimization.

Assessing your Azure architecture is an important first step in gaining valuable insights and recommendations that will help you build an Azure environment that scales with your business.

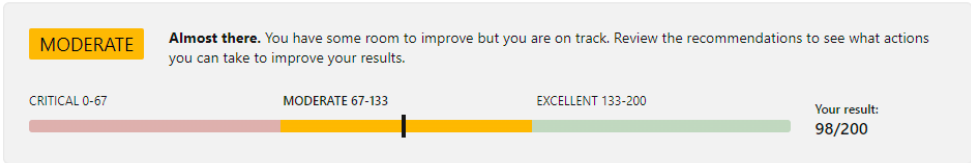

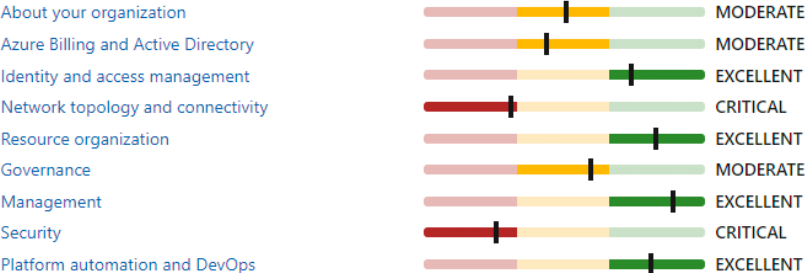

How is the inventory carried out?

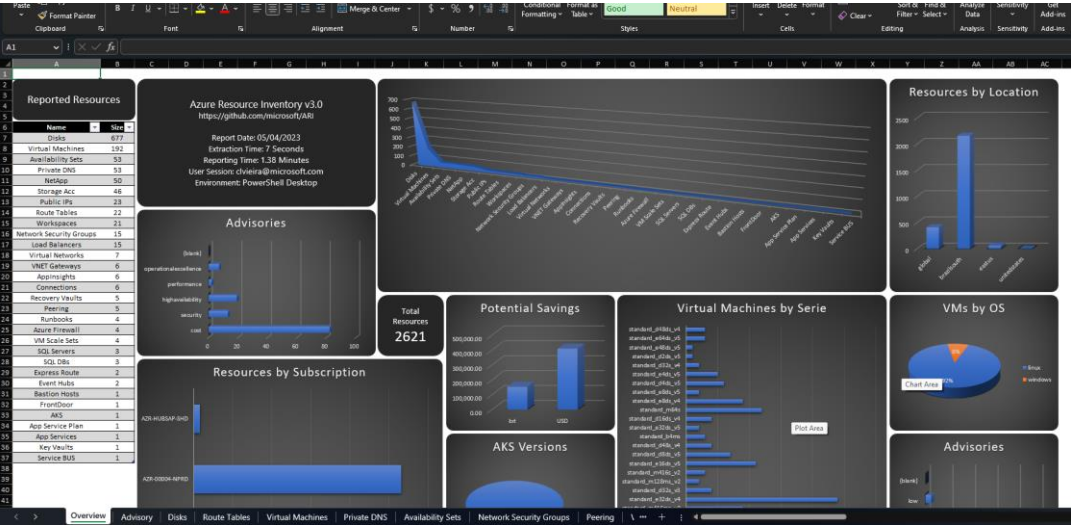
Inventory
