Why Upgrade Now?

Microsoft has announced the end-of-support date for Windows 10 will be October 14, 2025.

Organizations must update their Windows 10 client fleet to Windows 11 before this date or face running unsupported operating systems with zero access to critical or security patches to address identified vulnerabilities.

Why Windows 11?

Windows 11 is Microsoft's latest and greatest operating system for Windows endpoints. Developed with the hybrid-worker in mind, the operating system builds upon the familiar Windows experience with enhancements that enable employees to get their job done more efficiently, working smarter, not harder. IT staff will appreciate the consistency in deploying and managing Windows 11 endpoints as many of the same technologies used with Windows 10 continue to work identically with Windows 11.
