


Time management is an individual challenge






Below is an actual network optimization for a major FinTech company (9/20/21)

The Problem

As part of their Team Anywhere approach to distributed work, Atlassian needed to preserve time for deep work by minimizing both the amount of meetings, and time spent scheduling meetings.

Solution & Impact
