

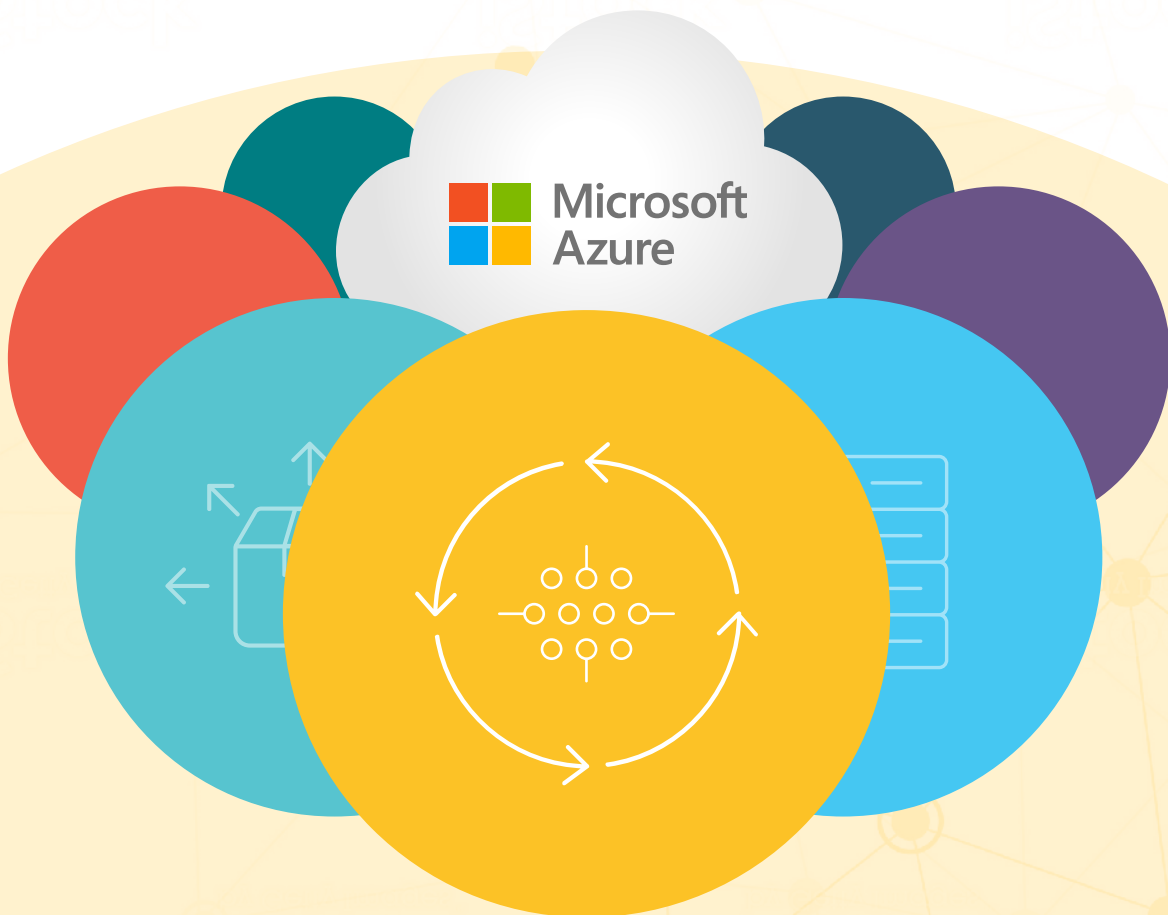

Infrastructure-as-a-Service – Lift, Shift and Optimise

The November 2018 CIF (Cloud Industry Forum) paper, [Cloud – The Next Generation](#), defines cloud computing as relating to “the IT infrastructure and environment required to develop/host/run IT services and applications on demand, with consumption-based pricing, as a resilient service”.

The same paper reports that the last seven years have seen “the levels of cloud usage accelerate dramatically. We have reached a point where almost all organisations are consciously using cloud-based services to some extent and are realising significant benefits in terms of flexibility, agility and cost as a result.”

At Cobweb, we are seeing increasing numbers of customers turn to the cloud to meet business strategy and growth goals, and in particular, a rise in the number of businesses moving on-premise IT infrastructure to the cloud.



Why move on-premise IT infrastructure to the cloud?

There are various potential triggers that can prompt organisations to move on-premise IT Infrastructure and applications to the cloud, and which include:

- Rising on-premise IT infrastructure costs
- An aging or out-of-support legacy IT infrastructure
- Security threats
- Storage capacity limitations
- Increased agility required to deliver business growth
- Complex availability and disaster recovery needs
- New compliance regulations.

Benefits of moving to the cloud include:

- Increased agility
- Enhanced security
- Lower costs – for example, through the ability to take advantage of unique cloud offerings, such as paying up front for resources for 1 or 3 years.

Assess

Migrate

- Rehost: a simple and cost-effective 'Lift and Shift' of your existing IT infrastructure to the Microsoft Azure cloud
- Refactor: where possible, we will move appropriate elements of the IT infrastructure to Platform-as-a-Service (PaaS) solutions, to drive scalability and cost efficiency gains – for example, by moving existing SQL databases to SQL Azure
- Replace: with this option, there's transition from an infrastructure-based model to a Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) solution – for example, by moving an on-premise legacy accounting application to Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central.



Optimise

The optimise phase comprises:

- Analysis and monitoring to manage cloud spend and use, to allocate and trim costs to build towards your next cloud investment
- Use of security and management tools to govern, secure and monitor your cloud investment.



Manage

Cobweb's optional managed services include

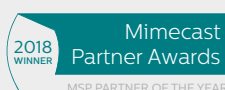
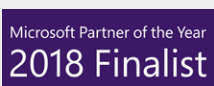
