More than 50,000 companies to report climate impact in EU after pushback fails

Rightwing attempt to block the adoption of new sustainability rules is voted down



Initially more than 11,000 listed companies that will have to comply from the start of 2024 but the scope will expand to large non-listed companies and listed small and medium enterprises in 2025 and 2026, totalling around 50,000 entities.*

The attempt by a cross-party group of 44 rightwing and liberal MEPs to block the adoption of new sustainability reporting standards was rejected by more than half of the European parliament. © REUTERS

The Problem

On 5 January 2023, the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) entered into force.

Companies subject to the CSRD will have to report according to European Sustainability Reporting Standards (ESRS) from 1 Jan 2024.

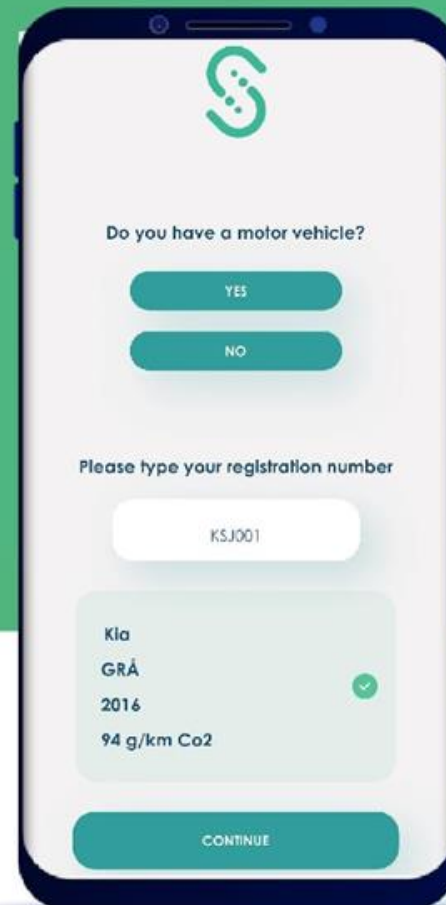

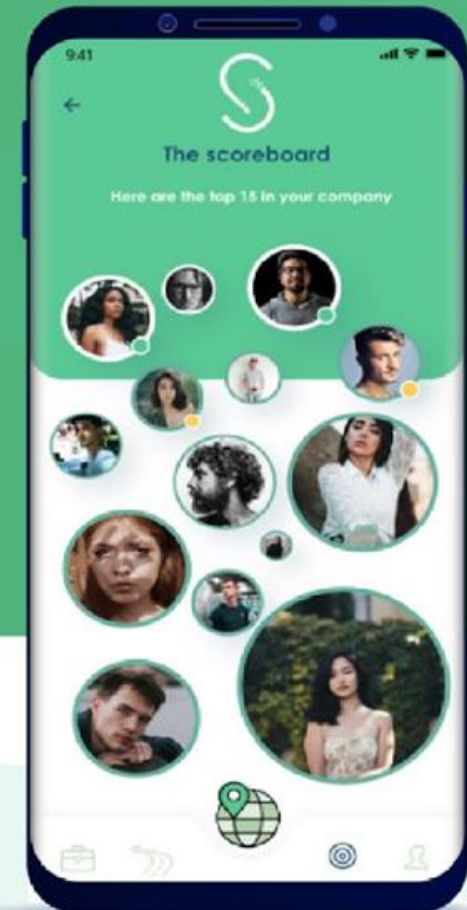
Calendar view of transport modes used this month



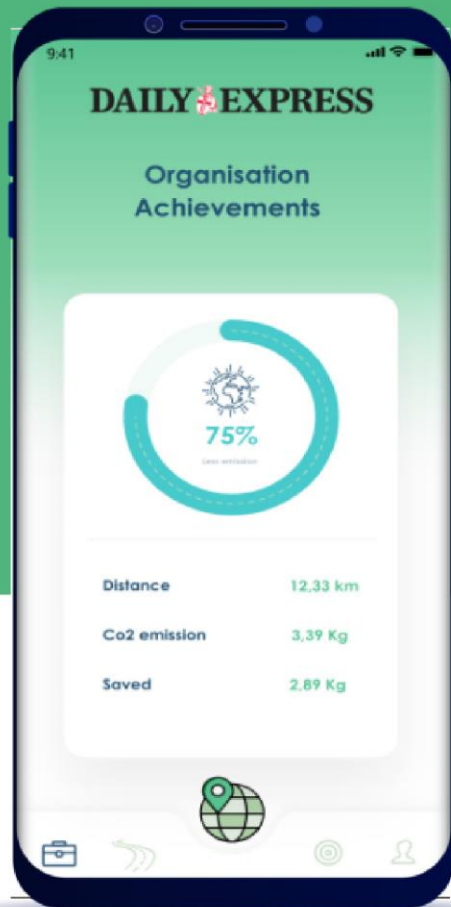

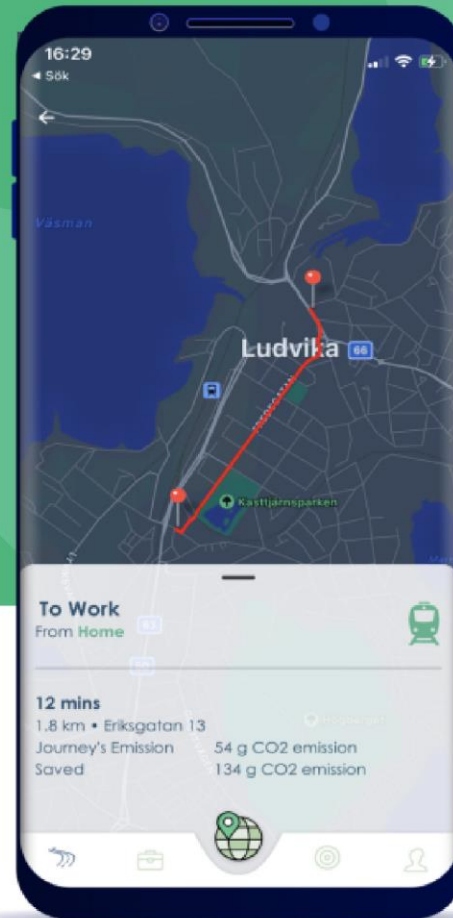

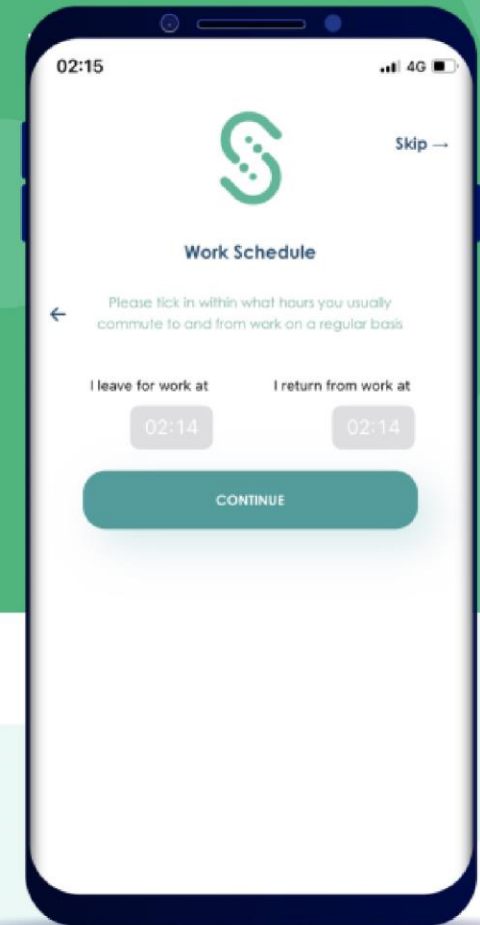
