

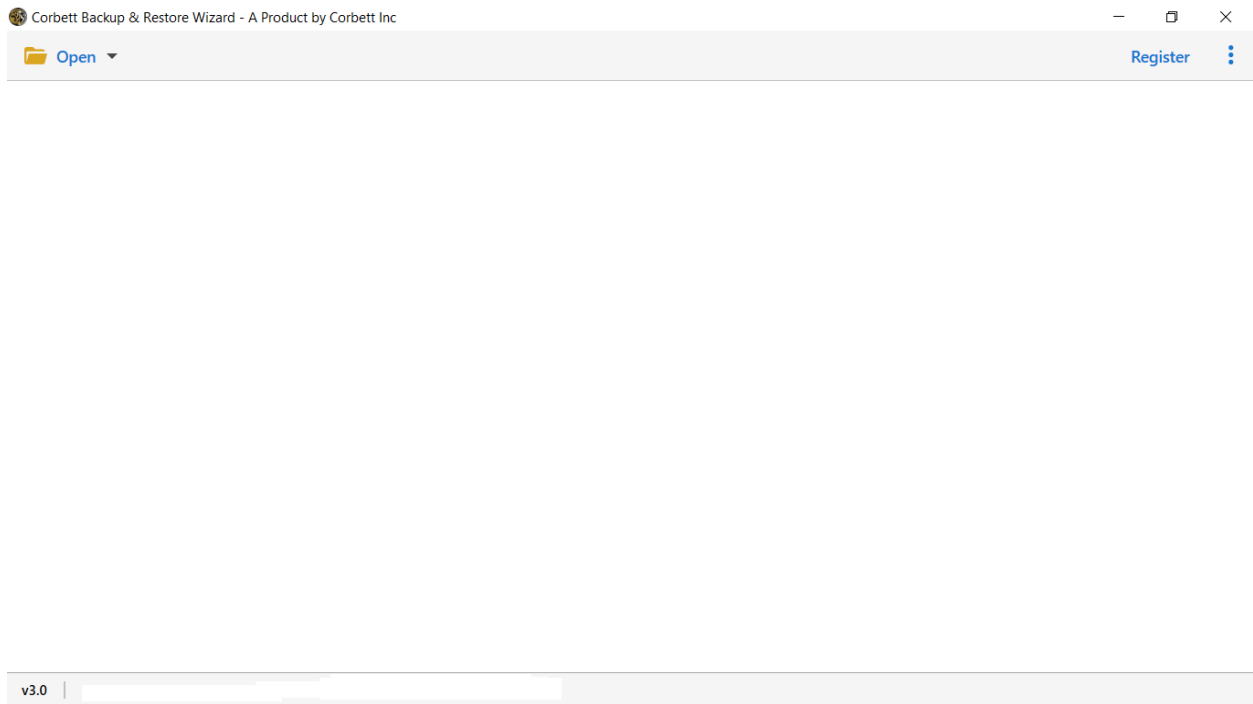

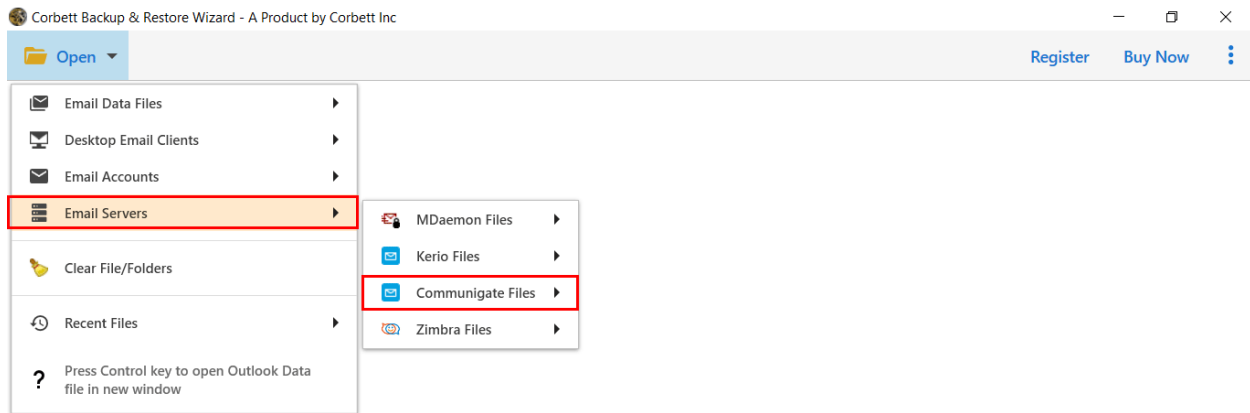

**Step 1: Download and install** the backup tool on your computer.



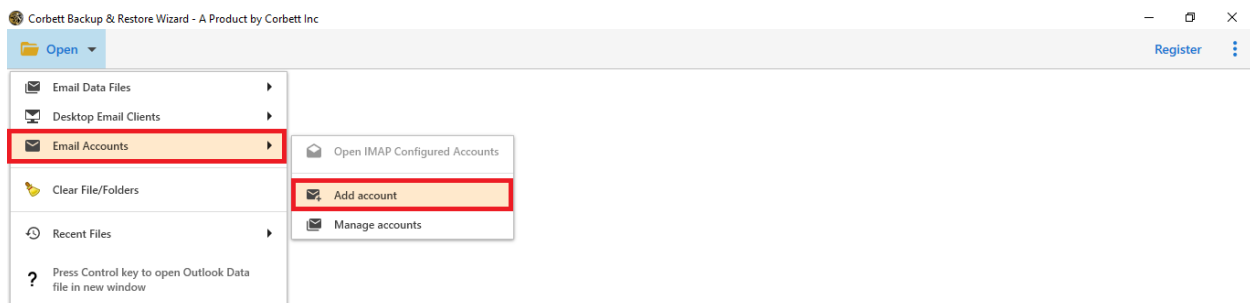

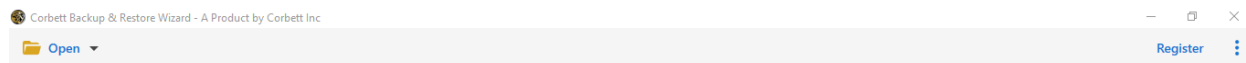
**Step 2.1:** Click either **Choose Files** or **Choose Folders** option. Then, **open** your file.

**Step 2.2:** If you don't have the file, click the **Email Accounts** button. Select the **Add Account**.

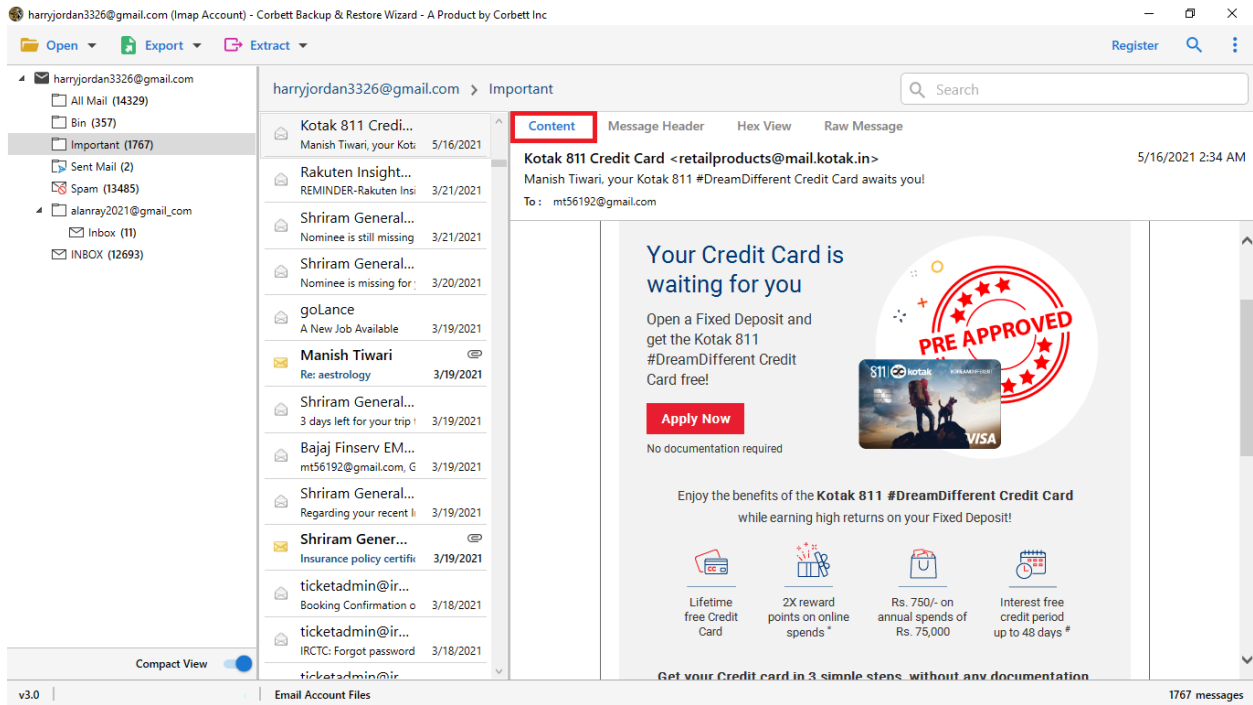

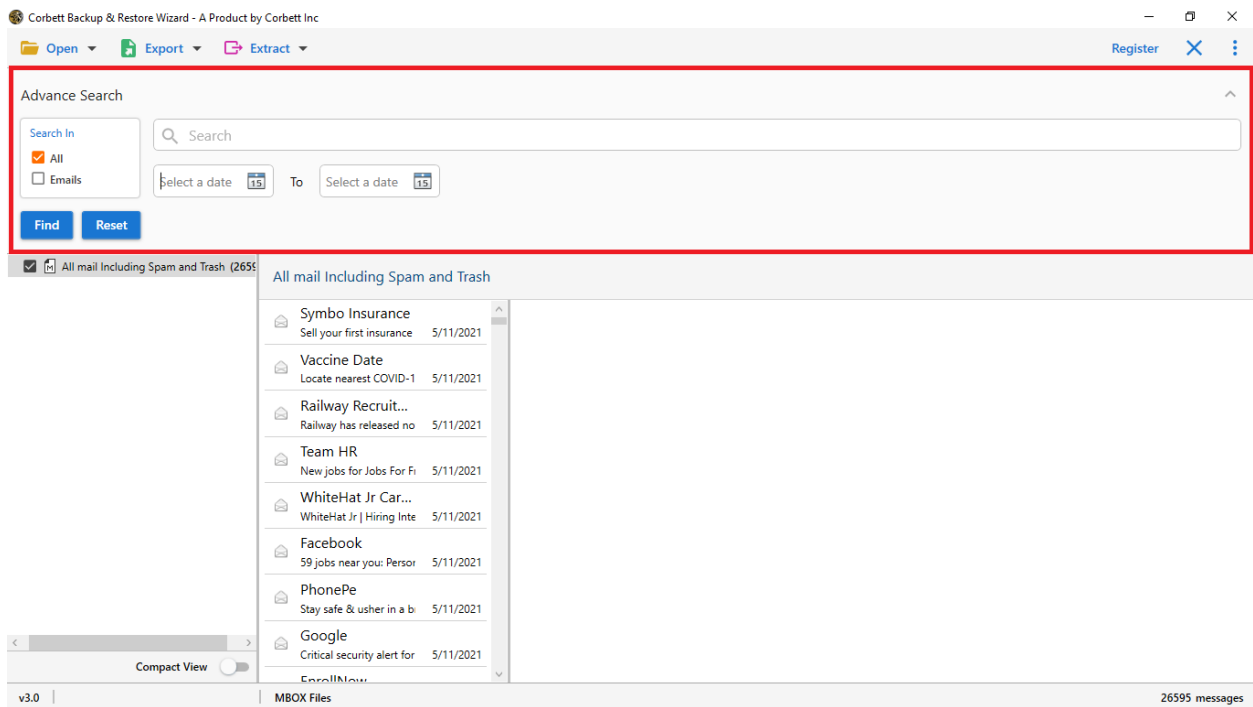
**Step 2.2.1:** Enter your **CommuniGate** email details and press the **Add** button.



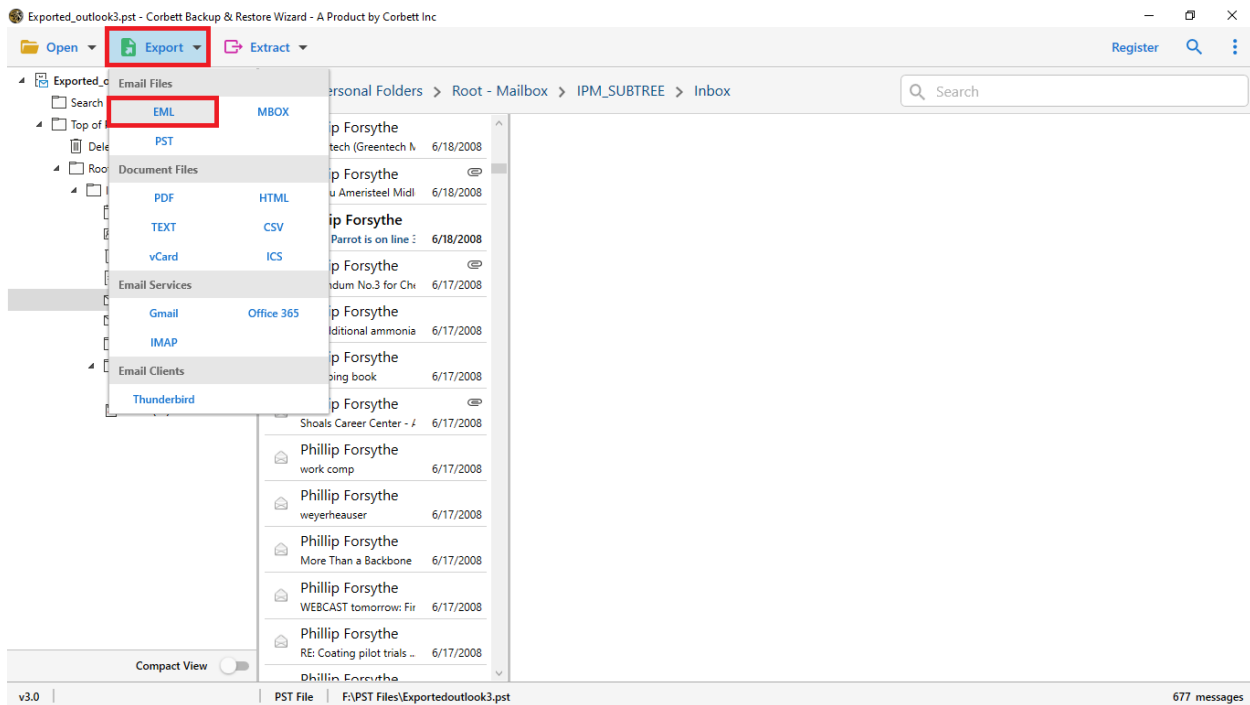
**Step 3:** Once you have uploaded your emails, **preview** your data in different locations.



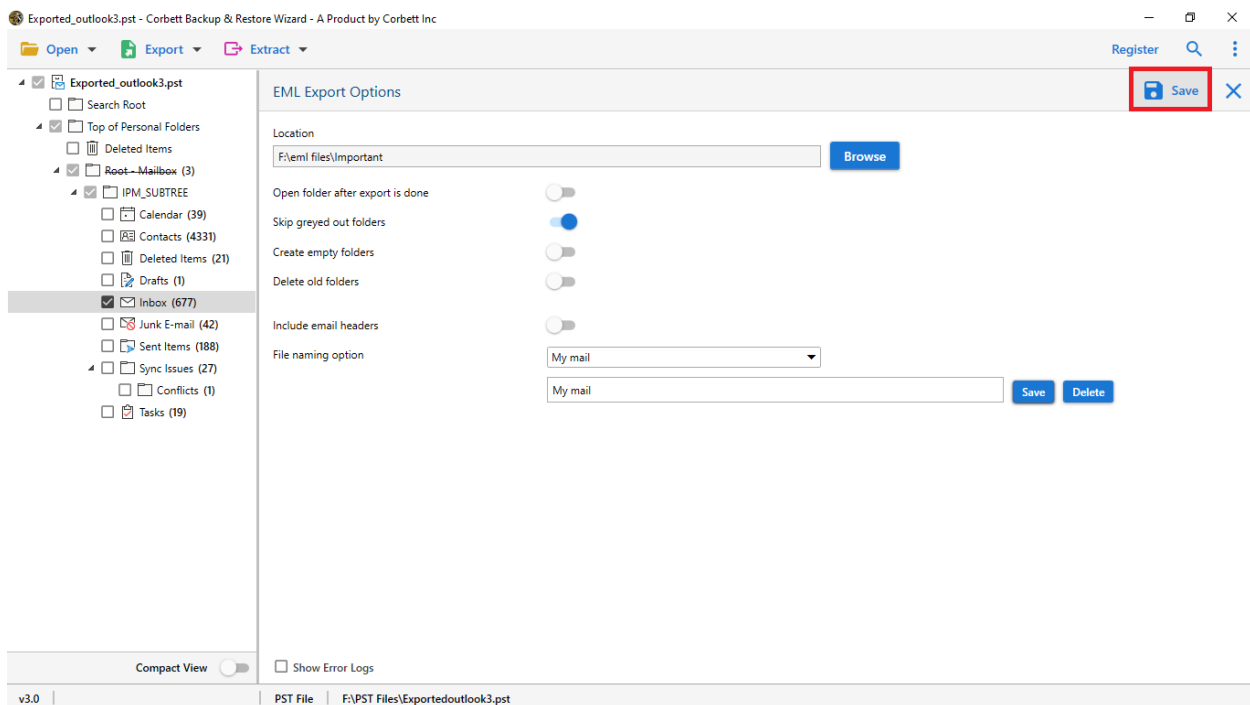
**Step 7:** Click on the **Search** icon and sort out your emails using the **email filters**.
