

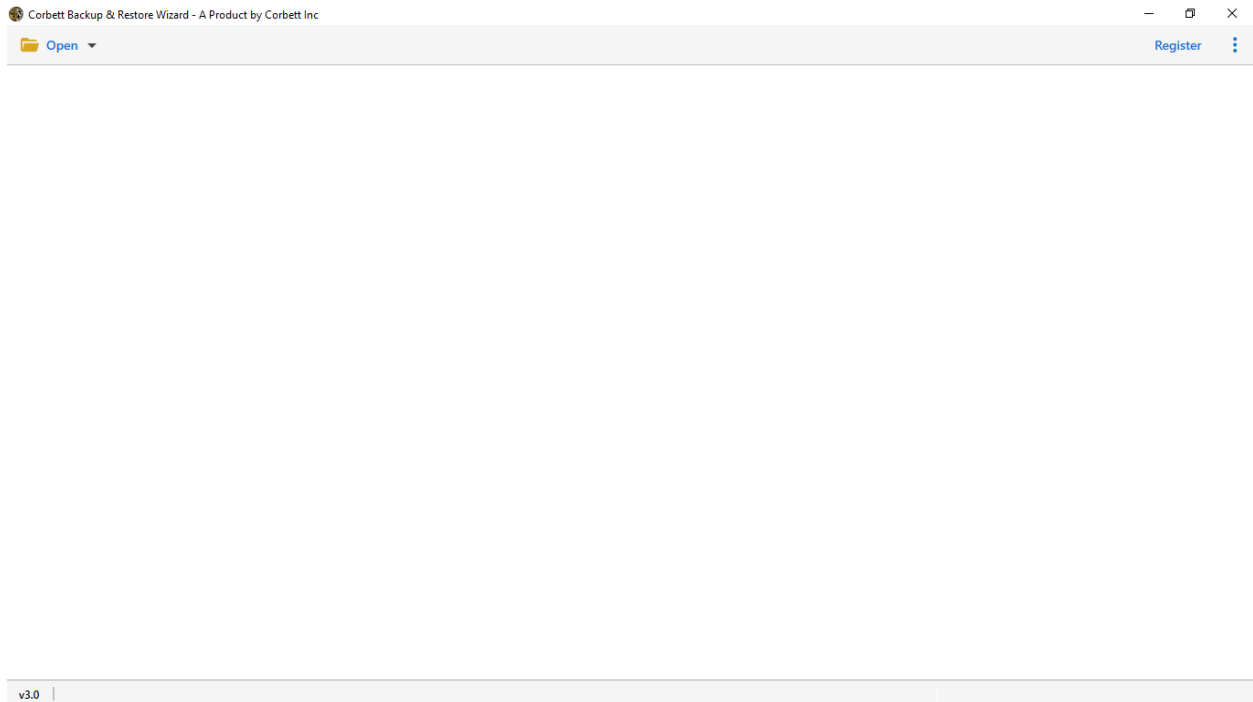
Corbett Zimbra Mail Migration Tool

Expert Tool to Migrate Zimbra to Gmail, Outlook, and other Email Accounts

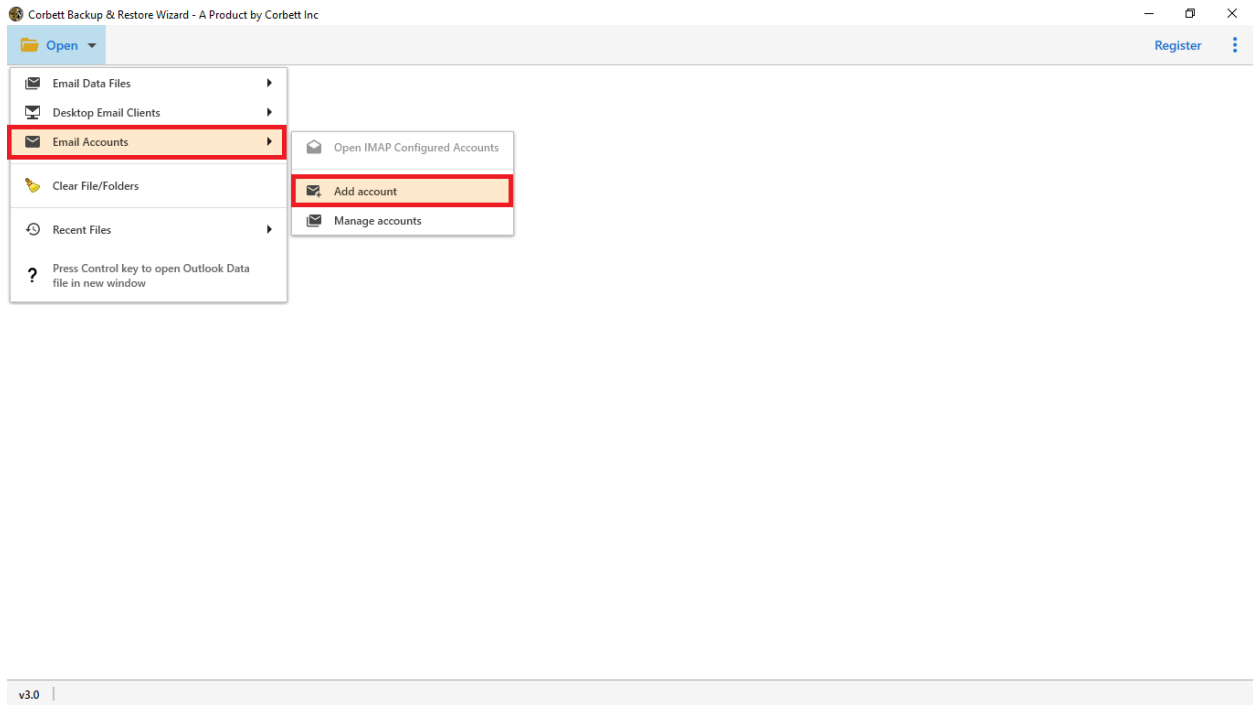

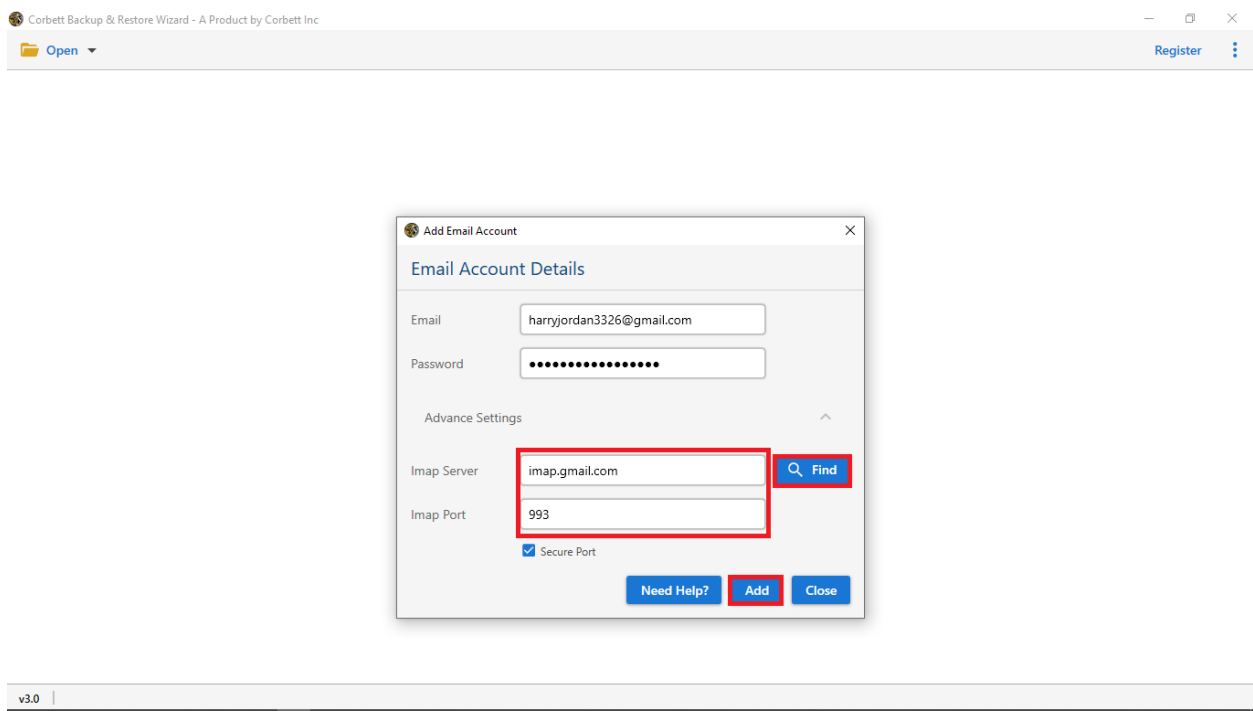
Step 1: To start the process, first **download and launch** the tool on your desktop.



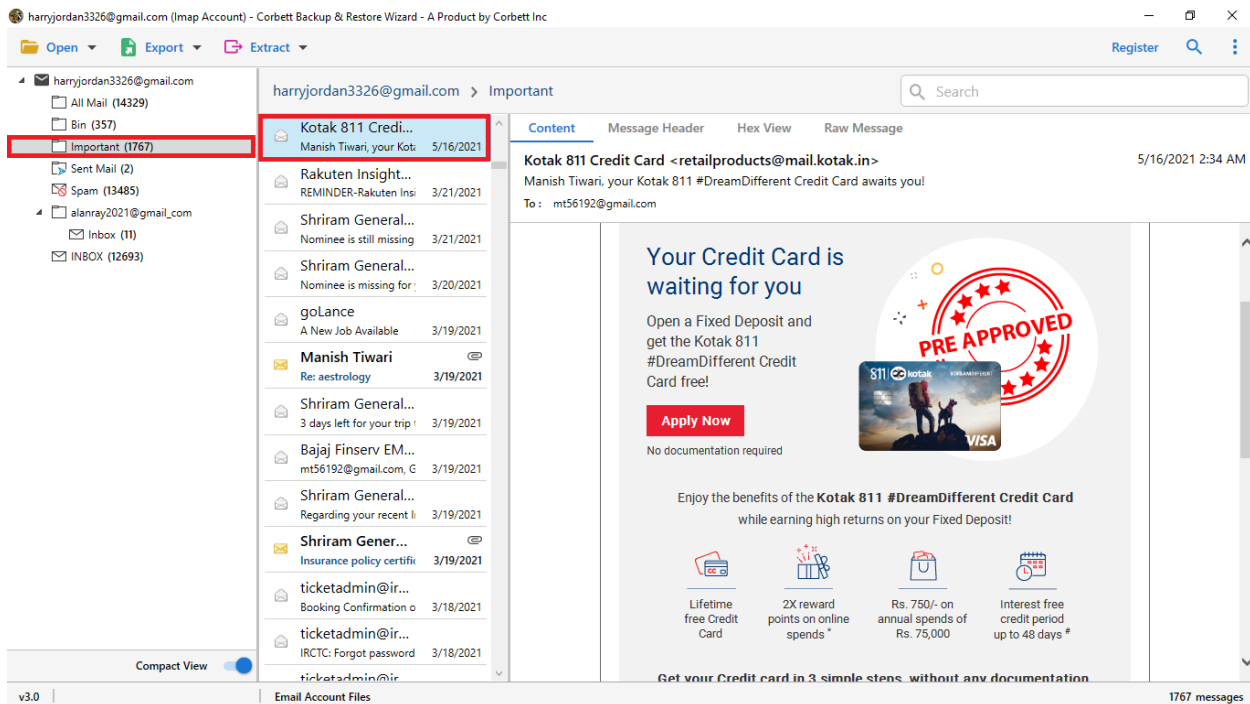
Step 2: Click on the **Open** button, select **Email Accounts**, and **Add Account** options.



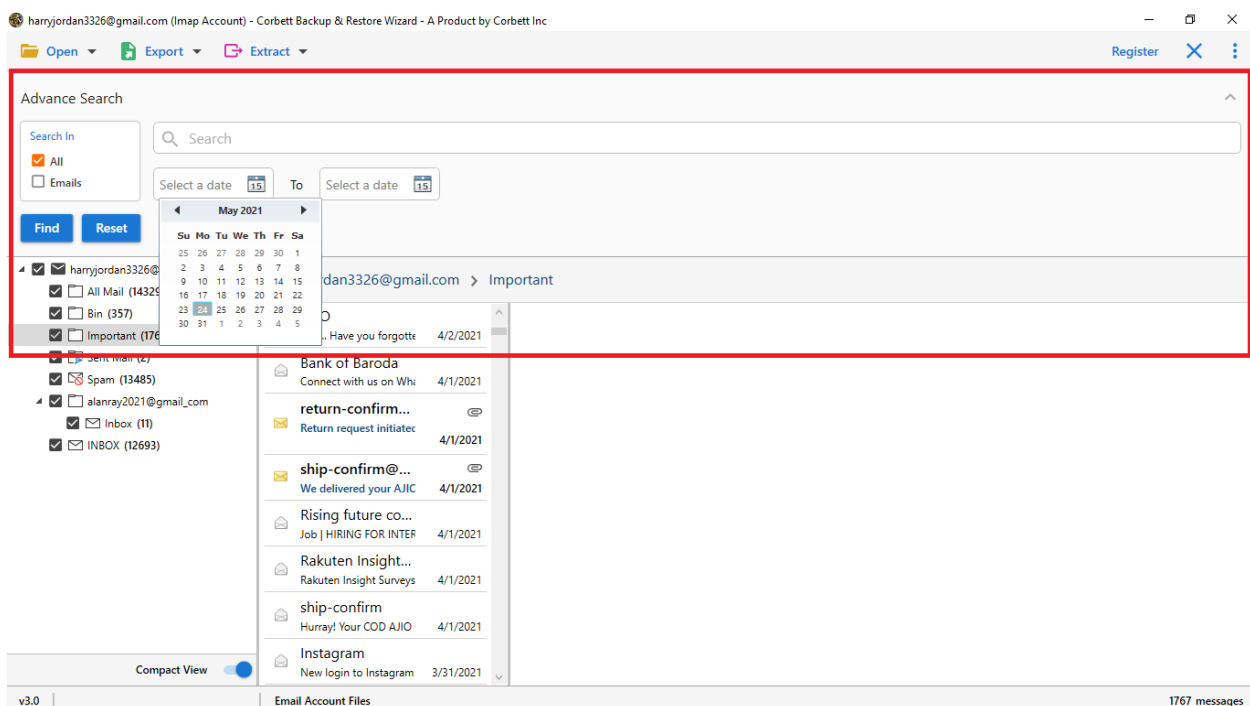

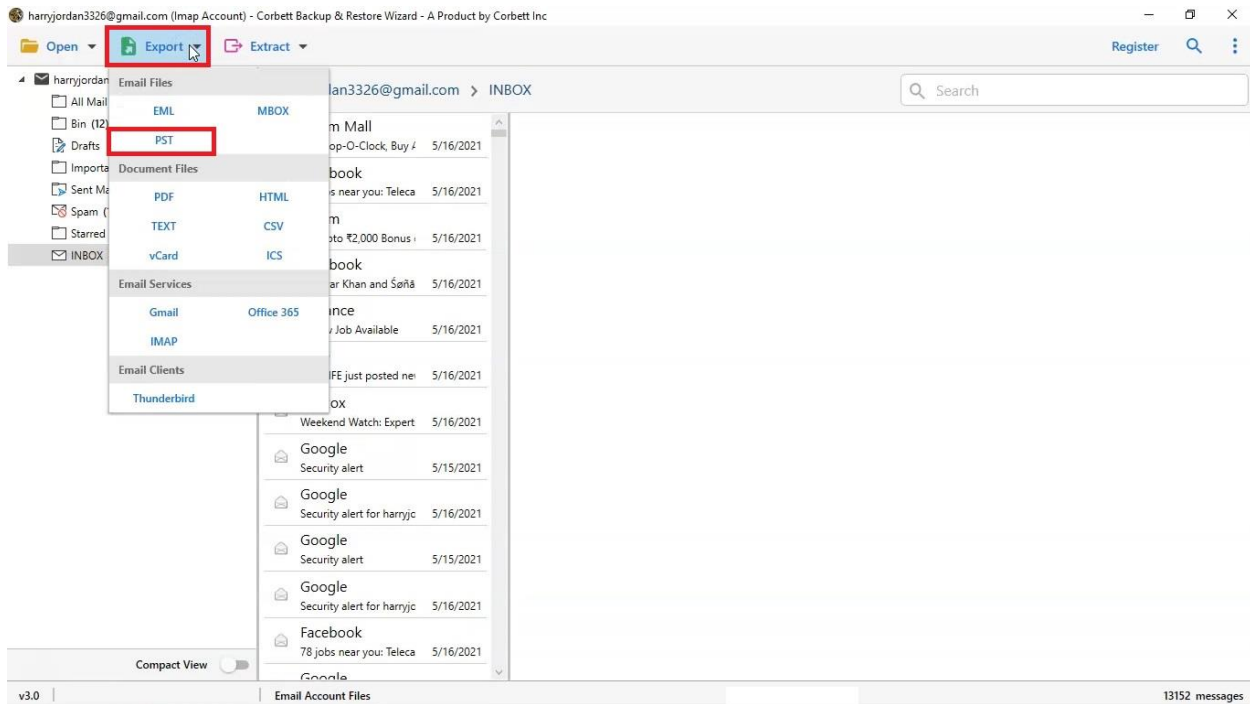
Step 4: Now, the software **fetches** your data from the configured account. **Preview** the emails.



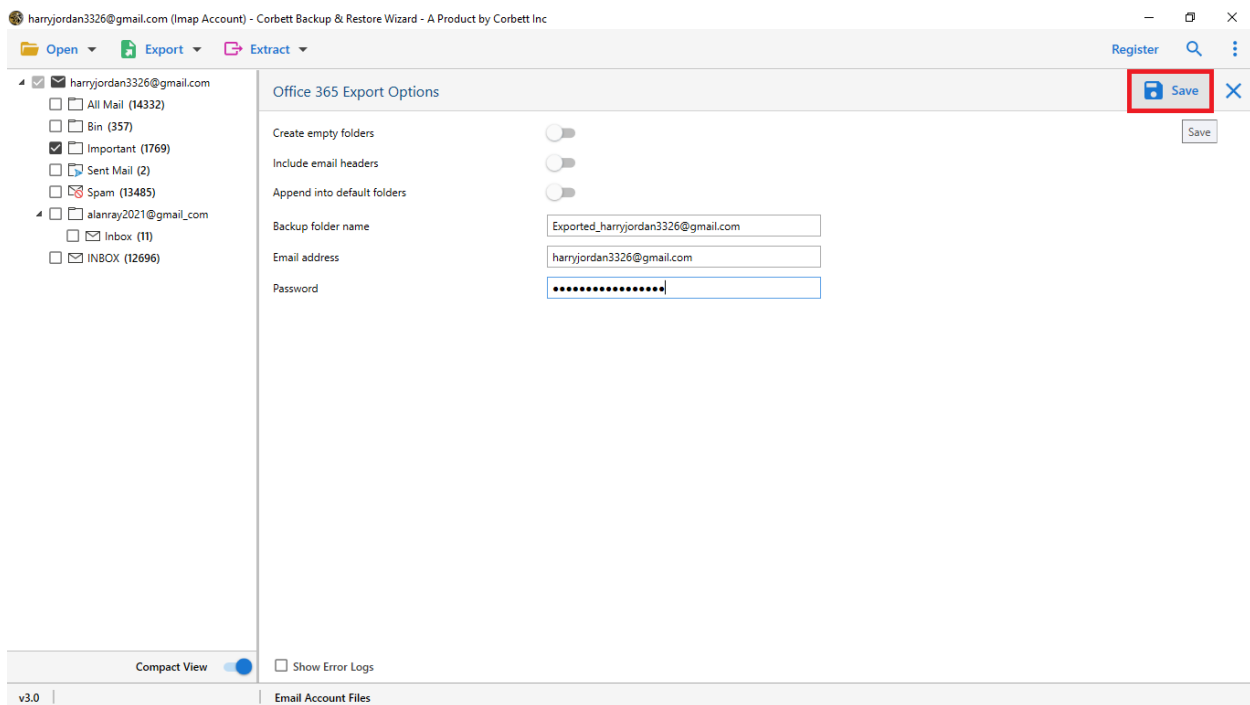
Step 5: If you want a specific email, click on the **Search** icon. Use the **Date Filter** to sort out your data.



Step 6: Then, click on the **Export** options and choose any options you like.



Step 7: Click on the **Browse** button to locate a desired location. Apply the **Advanced options** and then click the **Save** button.
