What is Microsoft Priva?



Privacy Risk Management

- Provides visibility into your organisation's data
- Policy templates for reducing risks



Subject Rights requests

- Automation and workflow tools for fulfilling data requests.

Why is it important?

- To find and visualise personal data in your organisation and understand the conditions under which it's managed
- To comply with industry regulations such as GDPR
- To manage privacy risks at scale and respond in a timely manner to subject rights requests
- To ensure data is not over exposed and that data minimisation is in place

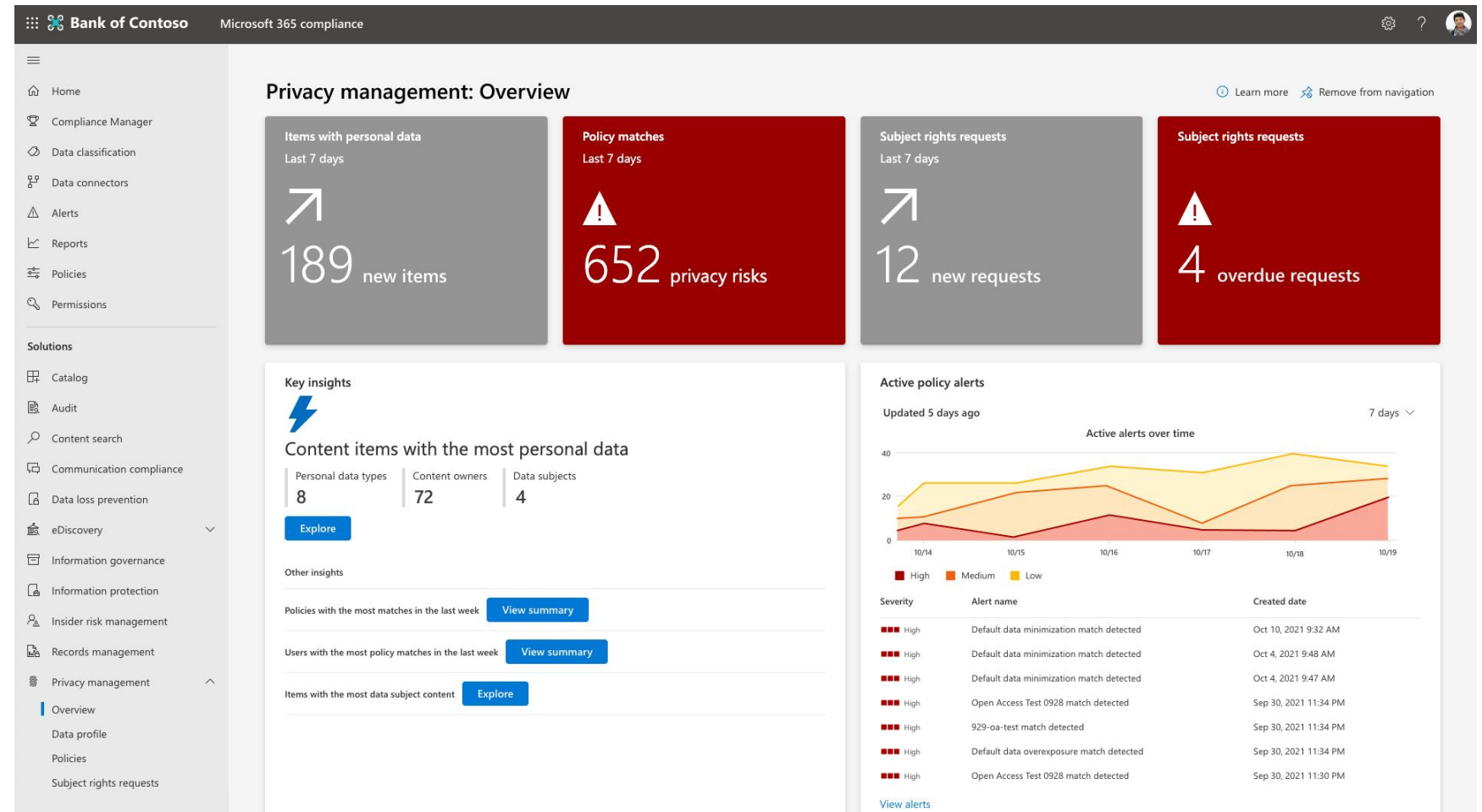

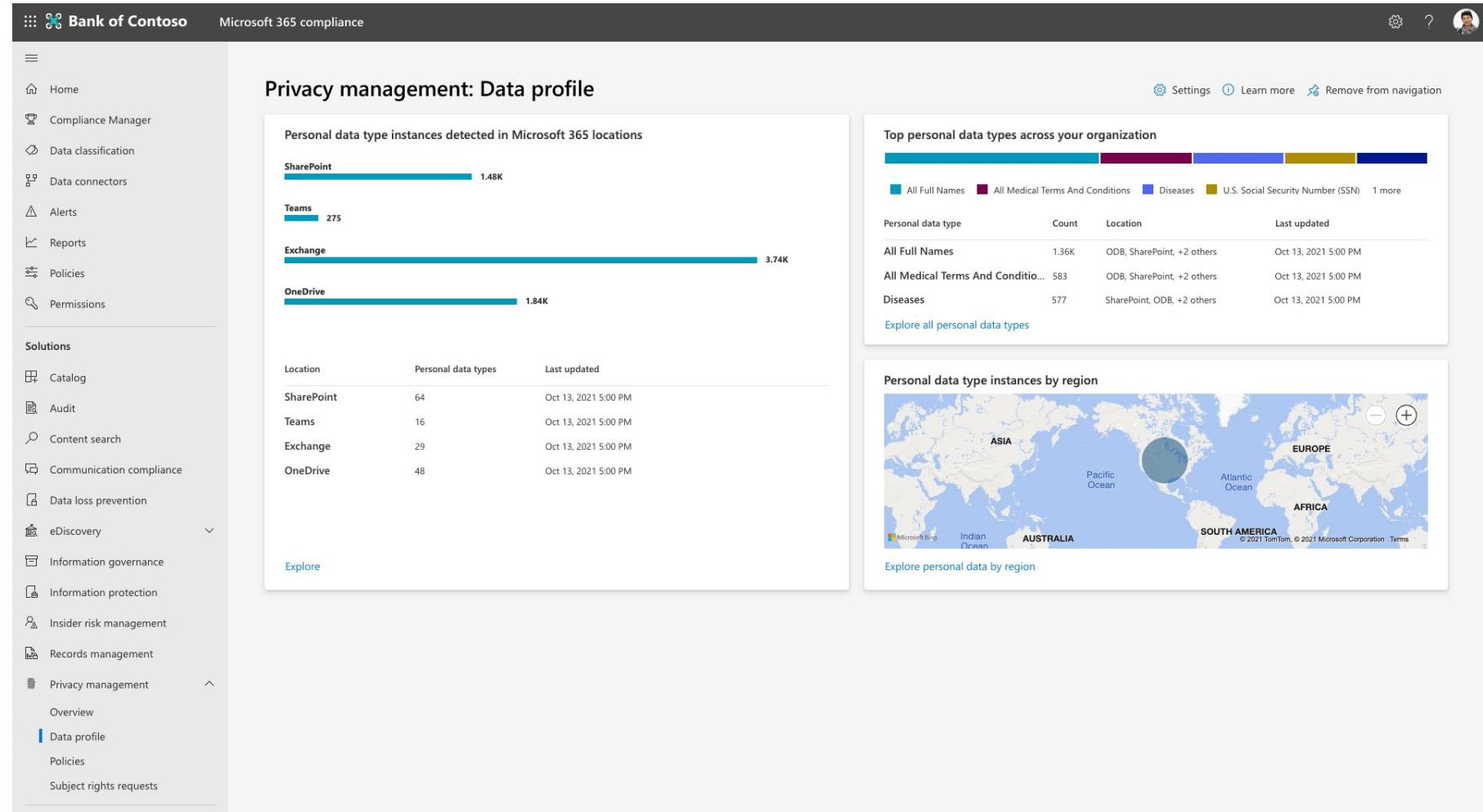

2. Provides insight into the types of data you store.

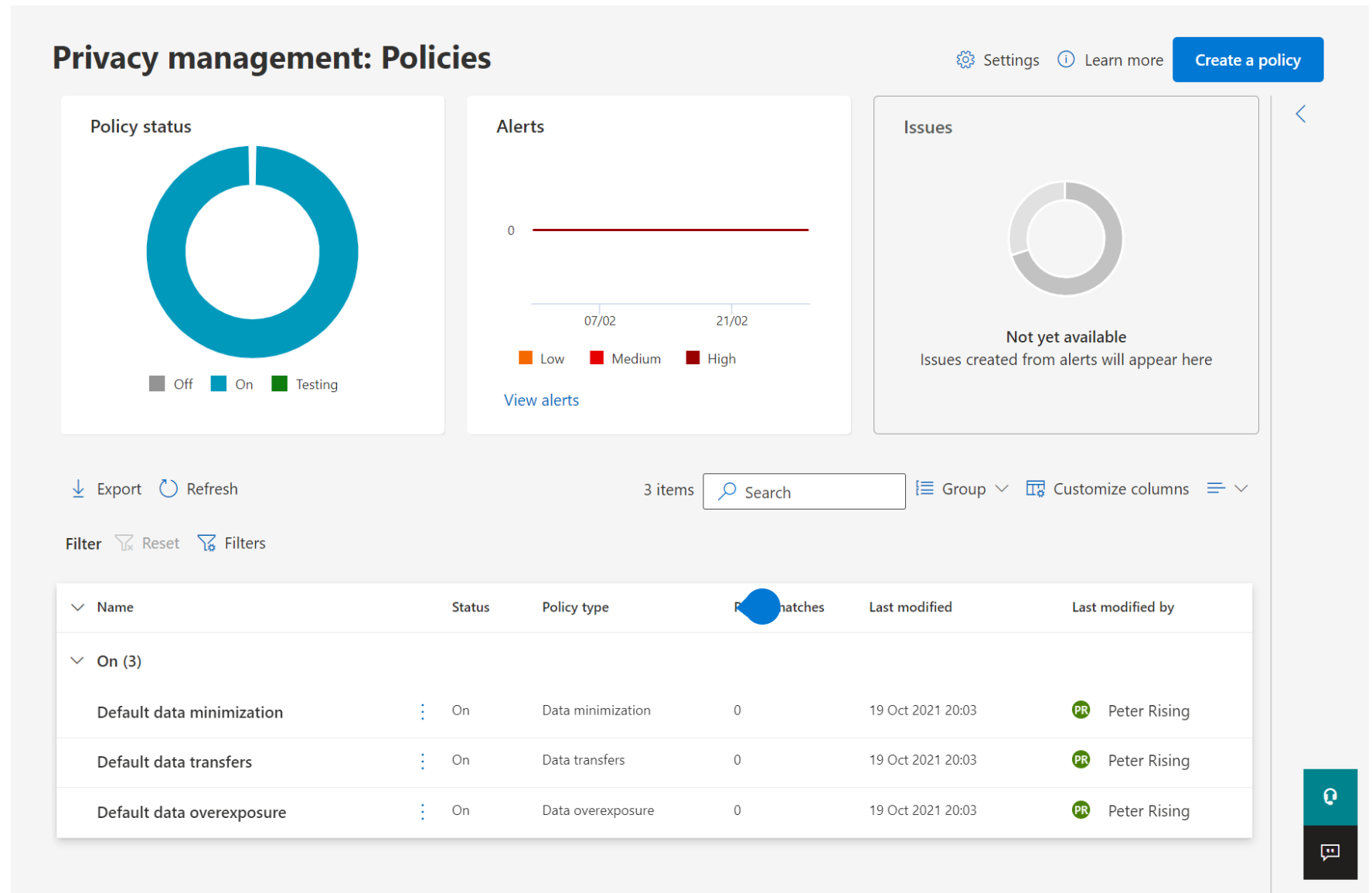

Policies Page

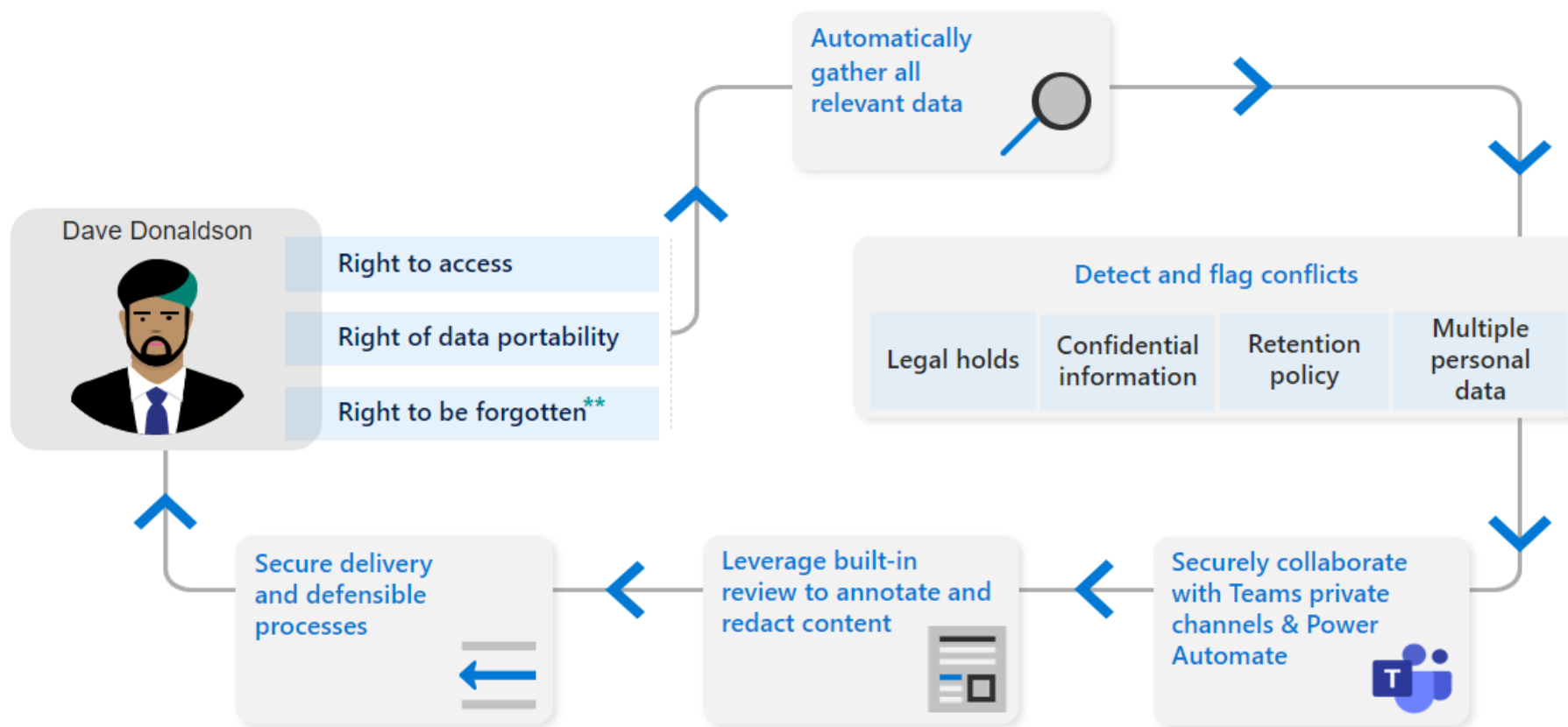
1. Displays shows policy status graphs, alerts, and issues.

Success factors for deployment

The following factors need to be addressed for Microsoft Priva: Privacy Management

- Buy-in from Leadership team
- Identify key stakeholders (can include IT department, Information Officers, Data Protection Officers, Legal teams)
- Understand that Privacy Management, and Compliance as a whole is a business responsibility, not an IT responsibility
- Understand regulatory obligations





Microsoft Priva Licensing

Microsoft Priva: Privacy Management

Addon licensing options for Microsoft Priva

Organizations with E3 and E5 licenses in Microsoft 365 and E1, E3, and E5 licenses in Office 365 are eligible to start the Priva trial.

Your trial license lasts for 90 days, during which you have unlimited access to risk management features and up to 50 subject rights requests.

If you've already purchased a subscription to one module, you can start a trial of the other.



Privacy Management – Risk
From £3.80 licenses/month



Privacy Management – Subjects Rights Requests (1)
From £12.50 add-on licenses/month

Privacy Management – Subjects Rights Requests (10)
From £125.70 add-on licenses/month

Privacy Management – Subjects Rights Requests (100)
From £1,256.80 add-on licenses/month

Who is this relevant to?

Compliance is often perceived as an IT responsibility – however, Compliance is a team sport and affects multiple disciplines within an organisation.
