## **Properties:**

#### Date Range Value:

Specify the main field where the date range picker will be bound to, and the display value will be saved. The display value is a string representing the selected start date, separator, and the end date.

Required: Yes

Usage: Bound to field

Field Type: Single line of text

#### Start Date:

Specify a field to store the state date of the selected date range.

Required: No

Usage: Bound to field

Field Type: Date only

#### End Date:

Specify a field to store the end date of the selected date range.



Required: No Usage: Bound to field Field Type: Date only

#### Days:

Specify a field to store the duration in days of the selected date range.

Required: No Usage: Bound to field Field Type: Whole number

#### Separator:

Specify a single character to use in between the start and end date.

Required: No Usage: Input configuration setting Field Type: Single line of text Default Value: -

#### Presets:

Specify a comma separated list of date range presets.

#### Required: No

Usage: Input configuration setting

Field Type: Single line of text (comma separated list)

**Available options:** Last Week, This Week, Next Week, Last Month, This Month, Next Month, Last Year, This Year, Next Year



#### Minimum Days:

Specify the minimum span of days that can be allowed in date range selection.

Field Type: Whole number

#### Maximum Days:

Specify the maximum span of days that can be allowed in date range selection.

Field Type: Whole number
