

Business Analyst Toolkit – User Story Generator

Overview

The Business Analyst Toolkit – User Story Generator provides a structured solution for transforming captured business requirements into clearly defined, implementation-ready user stories.

This release focuses on improving clarity, consistency, and repeatability in user story development by combining structured input with AI-assisted generation.

Version 1.0.0 is delivered as a focused module within the broader Business Analyst Toolkit and supports business analysts, functional consultants, and project teams in generating standardized user stories and aligned acceptance criteria.

What's Included in Version 1.0.0

Core User Story Generation Capabilities

The User Story Generator delivers foundational functionality across the following areas:

- **Requirement Capture**
Capture structured business requirements and supporting context through defined inputs.
- **User Story Creation**
Generate properly formatted user stories using standard patterns such as: *“As a... I want... so that...”* to ensure clarity and consistency.
- **Business Context Alignment**
Define supporting business context (including goals) to provide structure and relevance to generated user stories.
- **Acceptance Criteria Generation**
Generate structured acceptance criteria aligned with each user story to support validation and downstream development activities.

- **Consistency and Repeatability**

Apply standardized generation patterns to ensure uniform output across user stories and related artifacts.

Structured Data Model

The User Story Generator uses a structured data approach to support consistent and traceable outputs:

- Structured inputs for requirements, business context, and outcomes
 - Linked generation of user stories and acceptance criteria
 - Storage of generated artifacts in Microsoft Dataverse
 - Support for reuse and structured retrieval of generated outputs
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Workflow and Output Generation

The solution supports a simple, repeatable flow from input to generated output:

- Structured data entry for requirement capture
 - AI-assisted generation of user stories and acceptance criteria
 - Consistent formatting of generated outputs
 - Optional delivery of generated outputs via email to the current user
 - Persistent storage of generated results in Dataverse
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Scope and Design Principles

Version 1.0.0 is designed with the following principles:

- Focused, single-module functionality for user story generation
- Structured and repeatable requirement-to-output process
- Clean and simple user interface for ease of use
- Deterministic and consistent AI-assisted generation
- Alignment with Microsoft Power Platform architecture

Current Considerations

The following capabilities are intentionally limited or not included in this release:

- Advanced recommendation or advisory capabilities beyond generated outputs
- Automated linkage to additional modules (e.g., testing, backlog tools)
- Bulk import/export functionality
- Advanced collaboration or workflow orchestration features
- Direct integration with external development platforms

What's Next

Future enhancements may include:

- Expanded AI-assisted generation capabilities
- Improved linkage between requirements and downstream artifacts
- Integration with additional Business Analyst Toolkit modules
- Extended export and sharing options
- Enhanced workflow support
