By improving the speed of everyday tasks, Al rapidly facilitates a more productive workday and enables workers to make better decisions, faster.

It's important to keep in mind that AI in the workplace is an aid, not a substitute, for human potential and oversight. All currently available AI tools have their limitations, and there remains a clear demarcation between tasks AI can correctly complete and those it cannot. It must be consistently reiterated that employees will still need to validate and employ their own "cognitive effort" to ensure their AI-generated outcomes are valuable and accurate (Dell'Acqua et al. 2023). But, knowing where that line lies, and where that line lies in regards to organizational goals and specific tasks, will be crucial for successfully using AI to enhance or speed up decision-making processes. Instead of concentrating on tasks and processes that AI cannot automate, it's often more beneficial for

companies and their staff to concentrate on processes that can be accelerated with AI assistance, such as generating a first draft or summarizing long documents. Only your team will understand all of the intricacies surrounding your goals. Letting AI speed up summarization and surfacing the right content frees up more time for in-depth conversations and tasks that cannot be outsourced to an AI assistant. However, this type of implementation will only improve outcomes if it is paired with clear training and an understanding of where employees need to break from using AI and conduct analysis themselves (Dell'Acqua et al. 2023).

Because many AI-generated answers and suggestions can appear, on a surface level, to be correct, this step in training is necessary to prevent employees from simply "turning off their brains" (Dell'Acqua et al. 2023).

Productivity and Efficiency

A McKinsey study found that knowledge workers spend up to 19% of their week, or nearly 8 hours in a standard 40-hour work week, searching for and gathering information (Chui et al. 2012). A study published by PWC highlights that Al-driven tools like Overview can reduce information retrieval time by up to 40%, directly translating into heightened productivity levels, especially for seasoned knowledge workers (Bernard and Rao 2021).

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By employing AI, employees reduce the time spent searching through information. For instance, Overview identifies which files or meetings are most relevant to employees based on their current projects or the content of their communications, and thus streamlines workflows within Microsoft Teams. A natural language prompt, "Where is Adam's deck?" is now a faster, streamlined way to locate a document amidst cumbersome communications.

The integration of AI in everyday tasks addresses a critical challenge in modern work environments: information overload (Hemp 2009). By intelligently filtering and prioritizing information, AI tools help mitigate the cognitive load placed on employees. A simple question like "What should I prioritize today?" prompts Overview to quickly summarize goals for the day based on the surrounding context. This functionality offers employees the opportunity to see their work from a new perspective before focusing on higher-order tasks that require creative and strategic thinking. Luckily, this tends to be the work that most excites and engages employees at all levels. Revealing another net-new benefit not previously possible at the same scale.

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Solutions for Personalized Workflows

All can alleviate this challenge by analyzing employees' schedules, time zones, and work patterns to suggest optimal times for meetings or working sessions. This not only ensures maximum participation but also respects individual work-life balance by avoiding scheduling meetings during unsociable hours for any employee. Al's capabilities extend to identifying when employees may

require additional support, be it in terms of current projects, or upcoming time off. By analyzing public communication threads and calendars,
