Primary focus

Why companies benefit from G100be

The problem GLOObe addresses

LLM-assisted attacks change the economics of cyber risk. An attacker can use AI to read public code, suggest exploit paths, adapt payloads, summarize logs, identify weak configurations and move faster across unfamiliar environments. This does not replace human adversaries; it amplifies them.

The core product experience: the dashboard

The dashboard is the command center of Gl00be. Its core flow is intentionally simple: Analyze, Detect + Fuzz, Remediate. The surrounding modules exist to strengthen this cycle with additional intelligence, deeper validation and operational automation.

Remediate	Findings are prioritized and converted into practical remediation paths, reports and improvement evidence.	Security work becomes easier to operationalize, measure and repeat.

Important framing	The Fuzzer, Audits, Autonomous Networks, Defensive Agents, Offensive Agents, The Brain and The Eye are not separate stories. They expand the value of the dashboard by adding context, validation, automation and resilience.
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Analyze: turn scattered exposure into business context

The analysis layer gives organizations a clearer understanding of their software and operational surface. It helps leaders and technical teams see where risk lives across codebases, GitHub repositories, packages, services, cloud-connected targets and AI-facing endpoints.

GitHub and codebase assessment	Highlights risky repositories and projects before vulnerabilities reach production or customers.

Detect + Fuzz: validate what can become exploitable

Detection is stronger when it goes beyond pattern matching. GLOObe combines code and dependency analysis with fuzzing, harness discovery, endpoint validation and offensive reasoning so companies can understand how risk behaves under pressure.

Value of validation

A vulnerability list shows what may be wrong. Validation helps the company understand what could actually matter to the business if an LLM-assisted attacker investigates the environment.

Remediate: move from findings to resilience

Remediation is where cybersecurity becomes measurable business improvement. GLOObe helps organizations move from discovery to action by prioritizing what matters, preserving evidence and supporting faster operational response.

Agents and autonomous operations

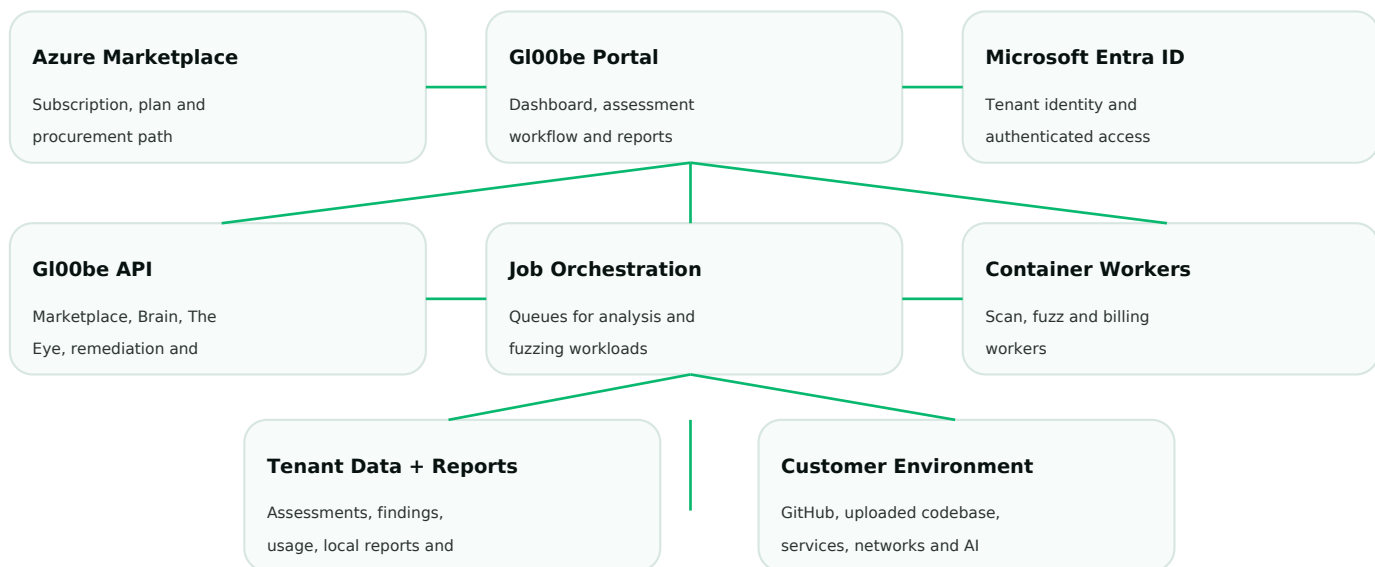
Gl00be uses AI-native agents to support both defensive and offensive security perspectives. This is important because resilience requires two questions at the same time: what is happening in the environment, and how could an adversary take advantage of it?

Defensive Agents	Monitor, investigate, explain service health and support response workflows.	Reduce time to understand incidents and improve day-to-day cyber operations.
Offensive Agents	Explore adversarial paths, validate exposure and reason about exploitability.	Help reveal how a real attacker could connect weaknesses across systems.
Autonomous Networks	Diagnose and remediate routine issues such as ports, services, connectivity and repeated administrative tasks.	Lower escalation cost, reduce downtime pressure and free skilled engineers for higher-value work.
Remediation automation	Connects detection evidence to action-oriented improvement steps.	Shortens the distance between finding and fix.

Operational value	For datacenters and infrastructure-heavy customers, autonomous network operations can translate security intelligence into measurable operational savings, faster service recovery and fewer routine escalations.
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Azure Marketplace, SaaS and customer-controlled containers

GL00be is designed for Microsoft-aligned adoption. Customers can start through Azure Marketplace while still having deployment flexibility for sensitive environments that require stronger control over code, data and operational execution.

Azure Marketplace	Familiar procurement, subscription lifecycle, plan entitlement and usage-based expansion within the Microsoft ecosystem.
Microsoft Entra ID	Tenant-aware identity, authenticated access and enterprise-aligned user management.
SaaS portal	Fast onboarding, dashboard workflow, findings, reports and assessment management.
Container workers	Separate execution for scan, fuzz and billing workloads; suitable for scalable or controlled environments.

Business use cases

Law firms	Confidential client data, contracts, case files and communications create privacy, reputation and regulatory exposure.	G100be audits systems, repositories, configurations and exposed services to detect weak access controls, data exposure and compliance gaps before incidents occur.

The strongest narrative is not technology categories. It is the business question: what would happen if an AI-assisted attacker reviewed this environment, and how quickly can the company reduce the exposure?

The essential message

4	How do we prove that remediation improved our security posture?
