

Haldor extends Microsoft Teams in UK schools with Homework app

The Blue Coat School in Oldham is one of the UK schools that are using Haldor Homework to help parents keep track of their child's homework and assignments in Microsoft Teams.

Currently, Microsoft Teams does not offer a solution for parents to log in and view their child's homework, assignments and progress. The only form of communication parents can receive about their child's assignments through Teams is a weekly email digest, but this must be set up manually by the school.

A solution like **<u>Haldor Homework</u>** – which gives parents access to their child's Teams assignments directly from their phone, tablet or computer – has been much anticipated by both parents and teachers.

Many parents like to be involved in their child's education and keep track of homework deadlines, feedback and grades. Meanwhile, schools encourage parental engagement in homework tasks and learning outside of the classroom.

"Since using Haldor Homework, parents have access to a real-time record of their child's homework. Parents have told us that the app has allowed them to have more in-depth discussions with their children about homework and their performance in specific subjects."
