

HoloBuilder has a wide range of uses. The following are the most common use cases according to customer feedback and can serve as a guideline for implementing HoloBuilder on new projects.

Regularly Documented (weekly or bi-weekly)	Value
Visuals for Recurring Owner, Architect, Contractor (OAC) meetings to review status and resolve issues	Improve communication Eliminate confusion
Documentation for effective progress payments	Accelerate payments
Comprehensive legal record of all activities with images time stamped and organized by location	Eliminate photo processing Increase productivity Lower risk
Unified communication with all remote stakeholders and subs by sharing the project. Avoid sending additional emails or phone calls, or creating weekly reports	Improve communication Increase productivity Reduce travel
Side by side comparisons of designed BIM rendering to the field conditions	Eliminate errors

Document existing conditions before construction starts	Reduce risk
Provide the HoloBuilder project in an RFP to all bidders to create a more accurate estimate	Increase earnings Reduce errors
Pre-Pour documentation - essential for quality control and allows company to duplicate successes, analyze failures, and prove compliance	Improve quality control Reduce costs
In-wall and above ceiling documentation - avoid rework by documenting all enclosures	Save money

Downloading HoloBuilder projects allows you to keep all project documentation in an offline view-only file to use after the project close out. The file can be provided to the Owner as as-built documentation.
