Enable specific users to make data changes to records within their dashboards and save these changes to the source database.



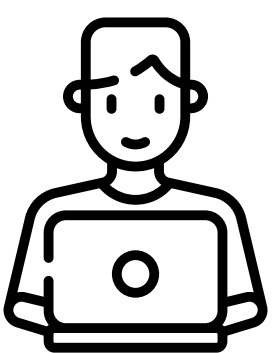
The Write-Back Tool allows Power BI users to update source systems while staying within the context of the Power BI Dashboard.
