



- Connectors (Sequence Flows, Message Flows) show the flow of control or data.
- Associations link artifacts or annotations to elements.
- Gateways (Exclusive, Parallel, Inclusive, Event-Based) control process flow based on conditions
- Artifacts like Data Objects provide additional information, and IT systems can be represented to show interactions with business processes. Understanding these elements helps in creating and interpreting BPMN diagrams to visualize and improve business processes.




