

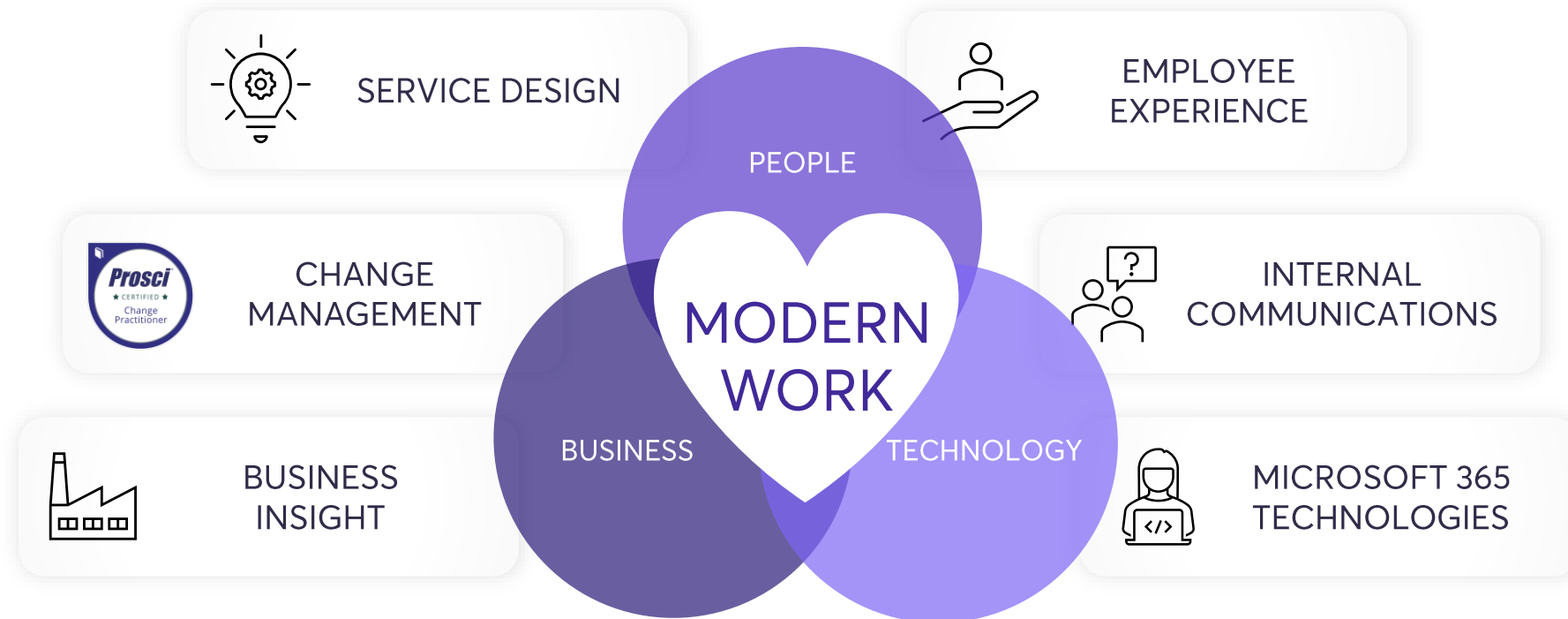

What
