
D365 Business Central at a glance



Dynamics 365 Business Central is the enhanced version of Microsoft's NAV ERP solution, with greater functionality and a streamlined user experience.

Below are some of its capabilities:

- Readily integrated with Microsoft Teams, the most used collaborative tool used today.
- Most of the Business Central Sales & Purchase activities can be managed from within Microsoft Outlook.
- Seamless integration with applications like Power BI and PowerApps.




Further capabilities of Business Central



There are numerous beneficial capabilities of Business Central:

- You can access Business Central from anywhere in the world over the internet, from any operating system [Windows, Mac or Chrome / Android].
- Business Central, is offered both as On-premise and Cloud solution and is compliant with most major cross industry and government standards, including GDPR and Making Tax Digital.
- But the most important change is the modern development capability and concept of Extensions. Extensions enable your Business Central Instance to be upgraded in future without any conflict with the base application, letting you save time and money.



Is now the right time to upgrade?






Is now the right time to upgrade from NAV to D365 Business Central?

The numerous useful features show why the answer is yes, however, there are more critical reasons below:

- License Incentives. Microsoft are providing more licenses when upgrading.
- Upgrading sooner reduces cost. Delaying your upgrade increases the gap will be between your version of NAV and Business Central, making it a more complex and expensive upgrade for you in future.
- **Stay supported by Microsoft.** The support for most earlier versions of NAV is either already discontinued or will be discontinued soon by Microsoft.
- Once you upgrade, you stay upgraded. The great thing is, once you upgrade to Business Central, future upgrades happen automatically to your instance.

- BREP is Paid
- You Purchased the Licenses before 1st October' 2018

What you need to know first - License Migration



The license model has moved from Concurrent to Named Users, however, here is the good news:

Microsoft will compensate for this by providing you with the following incentives based on the upgrade path:

- **Remaining On-Premise** You will get 3 times the number of Named user licenses of your concurrent user count. On top of that the BREP calculation of your license remains the same as the old calculations. Which means now you have, say for example, 30 users instead of your original 10 users and you pay the same old BREP amount.
- Moving to the Cloud You do need to procure a new license, but you will enjoy a 40% discount.
 - You will also do away with the yearly BREP payments.
 - The infrastructure is taken care of by Microsoft and is included in the license price itself.
- These incentives are available to you provided:
 - Your current BREP payment to Microsoft is not lapsed and
 - You procured your NAV license prior to October 2018.





Migrating Existing Developments



When it comes to the operational aspects of the upgrade, a question you might have right now is:

"Will we be able to migrate the existing developments we have made in our version of NAV?"

The answer is yes, you can carry forward all developments to the upgraded Business Central instance.

We analyse your developments and convert them to a new concept called 'Extensions'. The Extension is the concept which makes your development a Plug-n-Play component of Business Central. This also makes your instance compatible with automatic upgrades in the future.

Based on the upgrade path you chose; we port your extension either to a Business Central On-Premise instance or a Cloud instance.

Should you want to remain On-Premise but do not want to incur the overheads associated with it, we can provide Azure hosting facilities.

Migrating Existing Data



Besides existing developments, you can also carry forward your existing data if you wish to.

Behind the scenes, there are several steps we go through to migrate your data from Navision to Business Central.

This process follows couple of simple rules:

- 1. If your database instance is on NAV 2015 or on subsequent versions, we first need to migrate it to an earlier On-Prem version of Business Central and subsequently to the latest version.
- 2. If you are using a version prior to NAV 2015, we need to go through an additional step and migrate it to NAV 2015 or NAV 2018 first, then follow the remaining steps in the process of migrating the data to the latest version of Business Central.

But the bottom line is that all these steps are taken care off by us, and you don't need to be bothered by it.



- 4. Sample data migration for newly created extension



Cloud or On-Premise?



Staying On-Premise and moving to the Cloud both have positives. We empower you with all the relevant information so that you can make an informed decision.

Some key points to consider are below:

If you remain On-Premise:


- You will get 3 times the number named users of your existing concurrent user count. But you need to manage your infrastructure either by self-hosted, Azure hosted, or third party hosted.
- You need to keep paying your annual BREP.

Whereas, If you move to Cloud:

- You can enjoy a 40% discount on the license procurement.
- Your infrastructure will be taken care of by Microsoft with more than 99.9% of SLA. This also removes your risk of having obsolete infrastructure in future.
- Plus, you no longer pay any BREP.

How Expensive the Upgrade can be



The cost of an upgrade depends on 2 factors:

- The first one is the License cost:
 - This is a straightforward calculation no matter whether you go for On-Prem or Cloud.
- The second factor is the conversion of your existing developments and Data:
 - More developments means converting them to Business Central Extensions will cost more and be more complex.
 - Similarly, the bigger the gap between your existing version of Nav and Business Central, the greater number of steps we need to go through for migrating your data.
