2. Activate the Microsoft Office 365 Usage APIs by making report data available to Power BI. Configure CQD Data Setup

Note:

It can take several days for Microsoft to activate your Teanant's Microsoft Office 365 Usage API. We recommend scheduling the installation or self-installing the app seven days after activation.

The back-end Microsoft 365 service will refresh data on a daily basis and provides data that is between 5-8 days latent from the current date, click link for more details. Microsoft Data Refresh

During Installation

- 1. Make sure the Power BI Admin Enables Template App Installations
- **2.** Open the installation link. Make sure the user installing the app is one of the following:
 - a. Global admins
 - b. Teams Administrator
 - c. Reports Reader
 - d. Teams Communication Administrator
- **3.** Connect to Azure SQL Server Database Using the Credentials Provided by Metropolis
- **4.** Connect to the Microsoft Office 365 Usage and CQD APIs using OAUTH (e.g. your company email).
 - Estimated Time for Power BI to Process your Data (5 Minutes)



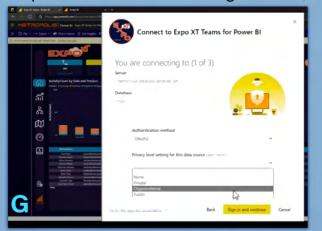

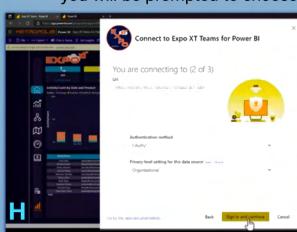
Step 1. Select OAuth2 and Organization; G.

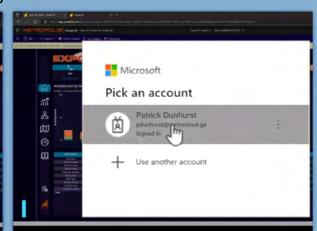


Step 3. Sign In; J.



Step 2. Select your email address; **H** once you click Sign in and continue you will be prompted to choose your email account **I**.

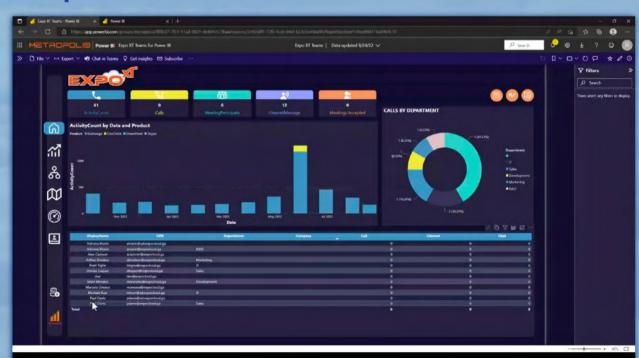

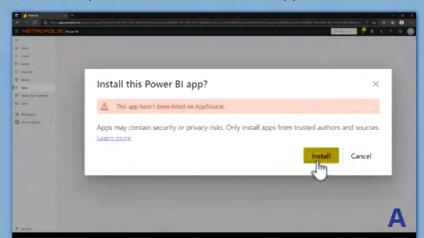

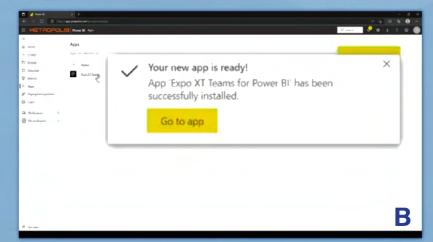


Installation of Expo XT Teams for Power BI

Installation

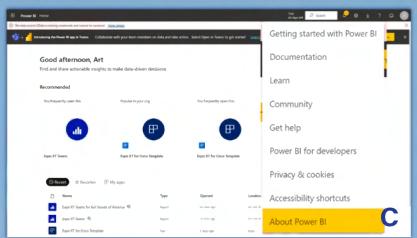
Once you receive the Link from Metropolis, paste it in your web brower. If you are a registered user of Power BI* you will be asked to install the Expo XT Teams for Power BI App. Next, click install; **A**. Once logged into the platform load your Expo XT App; **B**.

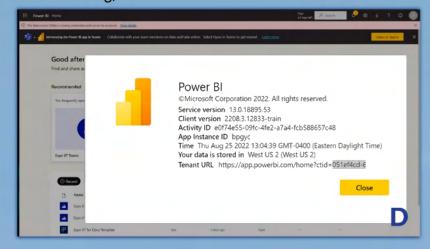




Activating Your Tenant

Once loaded, connect to your **TenantID**; **C**. Click on **?** in upper right corner and select **About Power BI**. Copy the last 36 digits after ctid=051uu9bm-6da5-4307-b31a-5b4a96ad7d20 under **Tenant URL** in the dialog; **D**.





Paste the **TenantID** into Connect to Expo XT Teams for Power BI dialog; when you click **Connect your data**; **E**. To configure the CQD in your Tenant click link for instructions; CQD Instructions connect.
