Eligibility

✓ Any not-for-profit organisations in the UK, Ireland or Channel Islands, including registered charities, CICs and community groups.

✓ Projects which are helping people to access food and/or projects which are helping to tackle the issues and causes of food poverty

✓ Funds must be spent 3-6 months after receipt

✓ Grant winners must be able to report back on impact of the grant within 3-6 months of receipt
