

# API Documentation:

Welcome to our API documentation. Our service provides an API for accessing valuable information about studying colleges in the UK. With our API, you can retrieve various details such as average fees, program offerings, campus facilities, admission requirements, and more. To make use of our API, you need to send a POST request to the endpoint /getjson. The request should include a JSON payload with the following fields:

- query: A string representing the query or question about the data you have trained already.
- option: A string specifying additional options for the api request to answer based on the which dataset you have provided.

Upon receiving the request, our API will process the query and return a JSON response containing the relevant information based on our pre-trained data. The response will be in the format: { "response": "string" } The "response" field will contain the information or answer to your query.
