


Nous App Modernization Bootcamp: 4-Week Proof of Concept

Migration Phases

01 Prepare

- ▶ Application discovery
- ▶ Identify business functions that are independent
- ▶ Target architecture
- ▶ Incremental implementation plan

02 Design

- ▶ Infrastructure roadmap
- ▶ External communication
- ▶ Inter context communication
- ▶ Packaging & deployment model

03 Build

- ▶ Develop function
- ▶ Setup CI/CD pipeline
- ▶ Release management workflow
- ▶ Blue-green deployment strategy

04 Operate

- ▶ Log aggregation and endpoint health
- ▶ Declarative resource management
- ▶ Auto-scaling

Azure functions help in breaking down large applications into smaller discreet functional code units

As microservices architecture, provides excellent capability to auto-scale up/down on-demand


