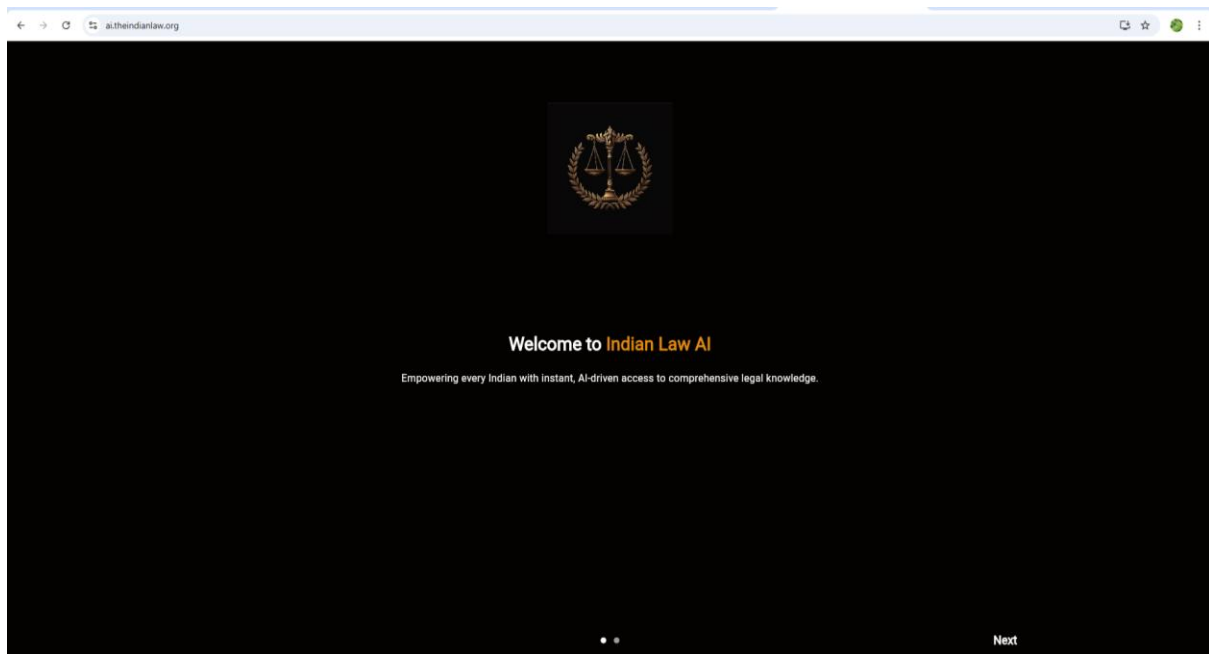

## User Flow

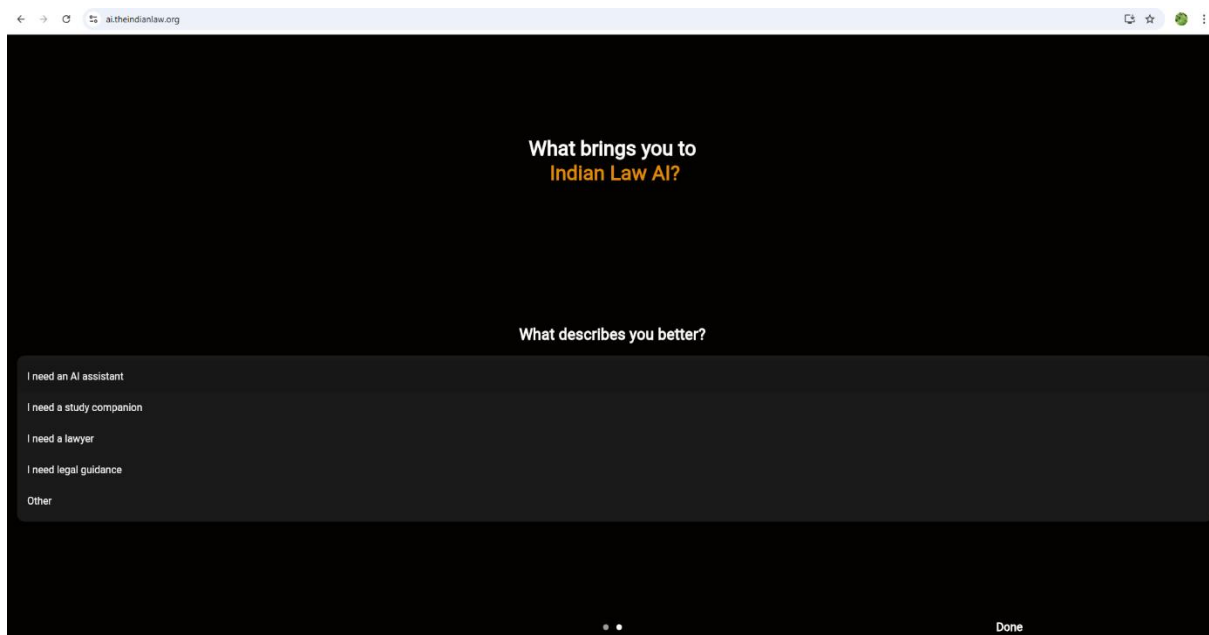
This section explains the complete user journey when accessing the Indian Law AI platform—covering the pre-login onboarding screens and the purpose-selection flow.

### Landing on the Website

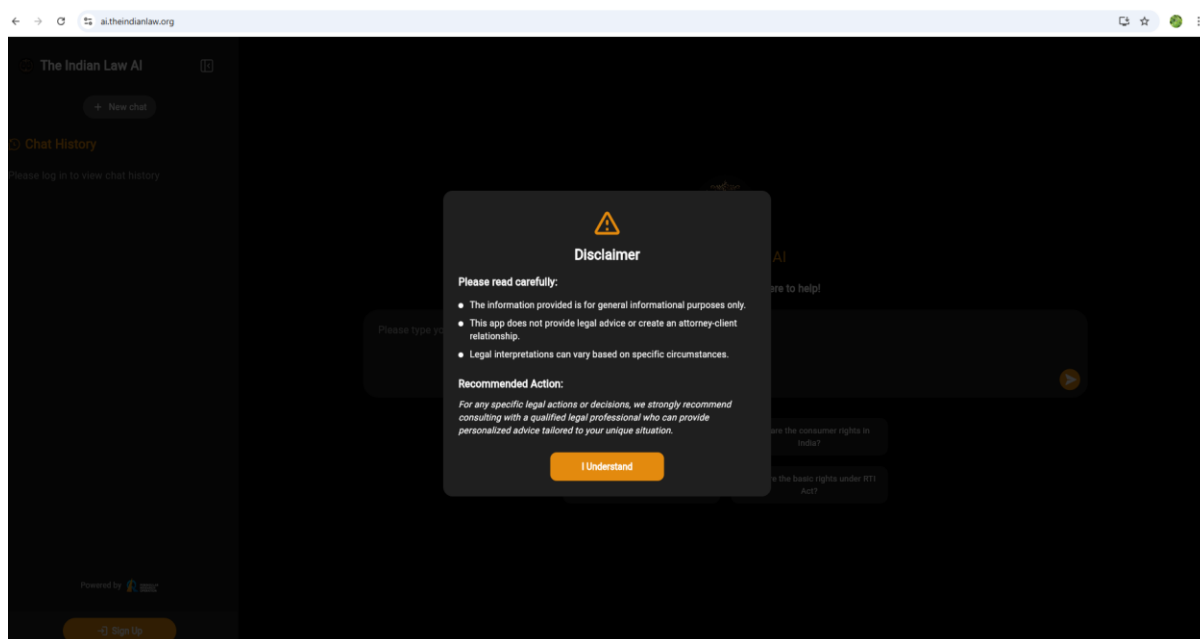
When the user visits <https://ai.theindianlaw.org/>, a **Welcome Screen** will be loaded



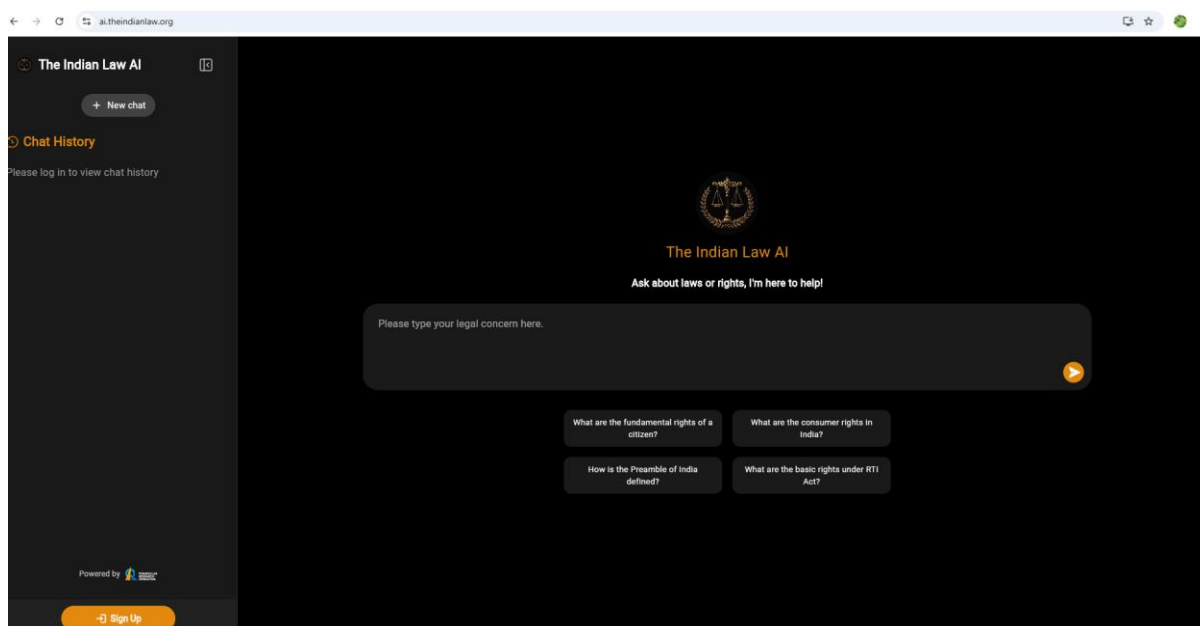
After clicking **Next**, the user is taken to the second onboarding screen which asks the user to define their intent.



Upon entering the main screen, the user will be shown a disclaimer pop-up, where the user needs to accept the respective policy.

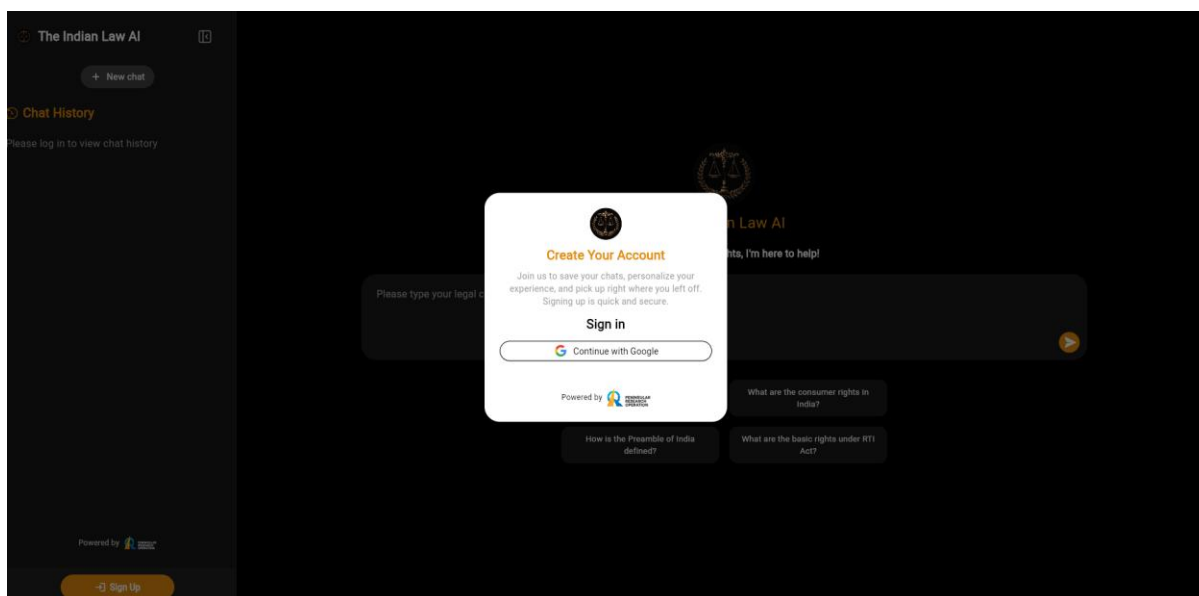


Once the user clicks on “I Understand”, the system will redirect them to the main dashboard. This dashboard serves as the central interface where users can search and ask legal questions to receive AI-driven clarifications. Before logging in, users are allowed to submit up to 5 queries. However, during this pre-login usage, chat history will not be saved, and users will not be able to revisit previous questions unless they create an account and log in.

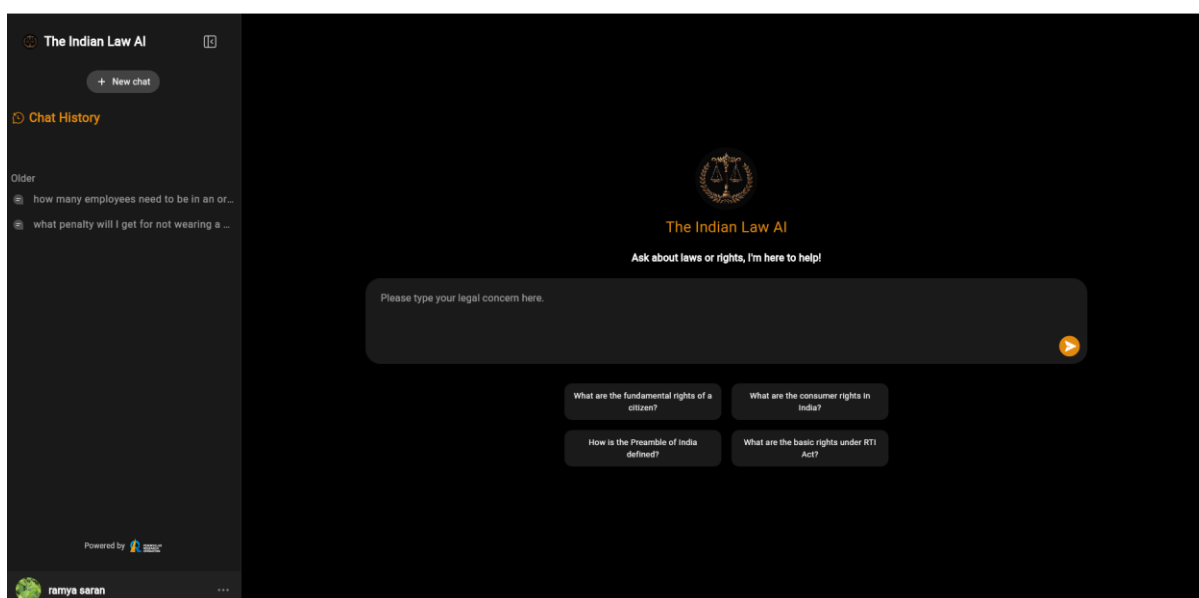


## User Sign-up/ Account creation:

Users can create an account by clicking on the “Sign Up” button available on the interface. Upon selecting this option, the system will redirect the user to a pop-up window that enables account creation through Google Sign-In. The user must authenticate using their Google account credentials to complete the sign-up process.



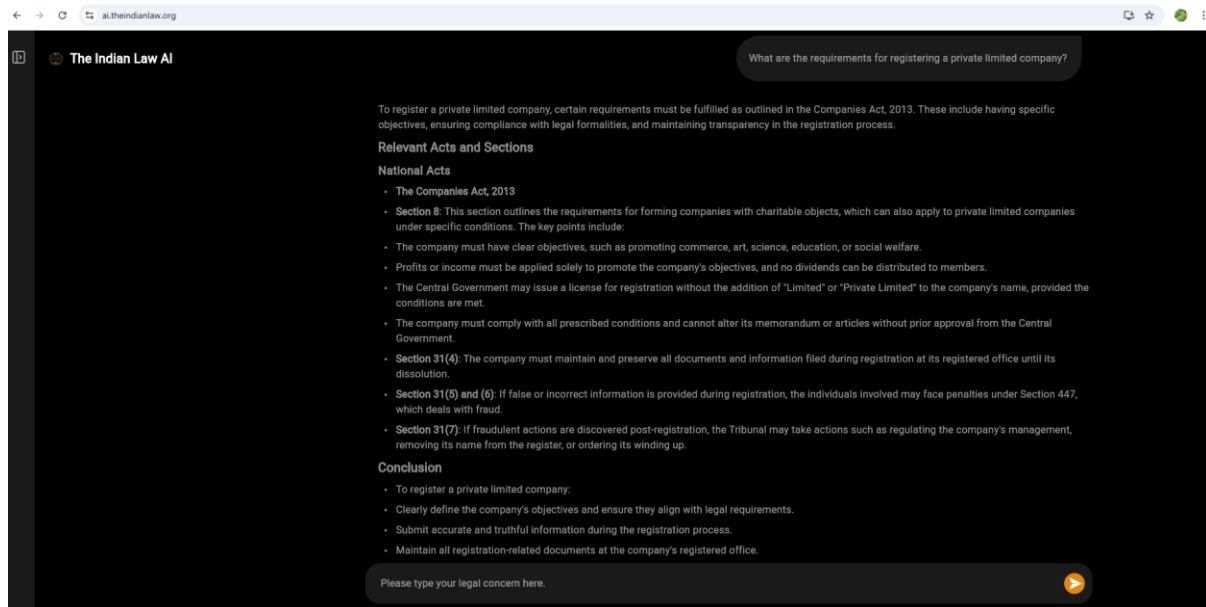
Once successfully authenticated, the user’s account will be created, and they will be granted access to additional platform features, including saved chat history and extended query limits.



## Searching a query:

Users can type their legal query in natural language (for example: *“What are the requirements for registering a private limited company?”*). Once the prompt is entered, the system processes

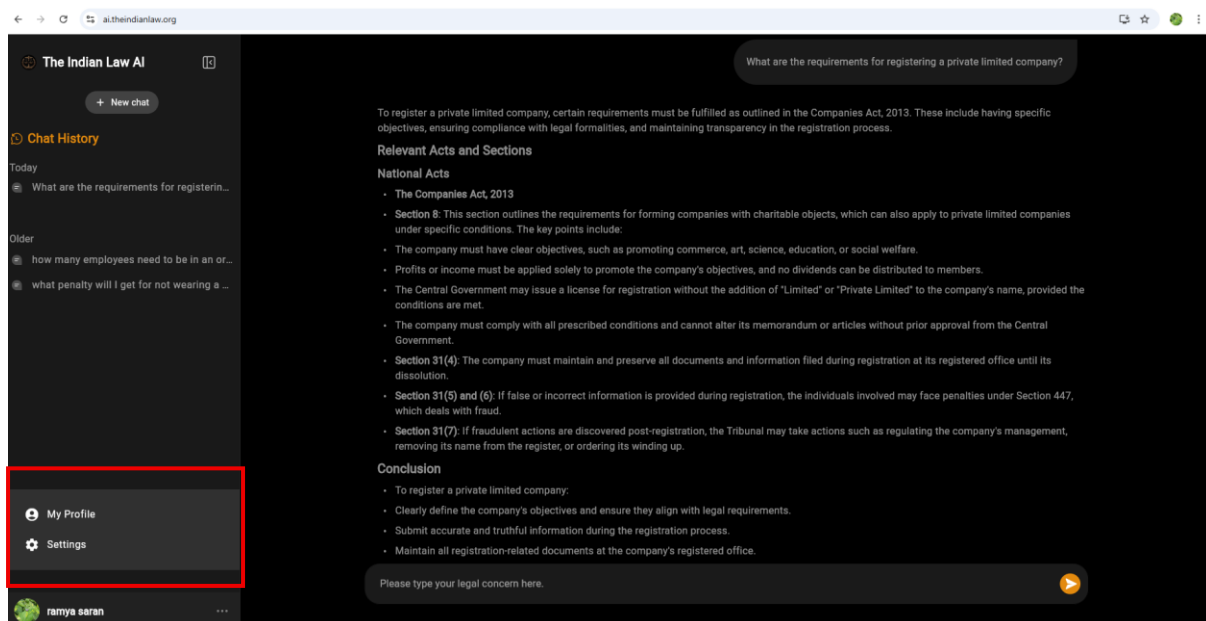
the query through its AI engine and displays a well-structured, legally aligned response as shown below:



## Viewing “My Profile” and Logout

To view personal account information, the user can click on the “**My Profile**” option available in the main menu. This section displays essential details such as the user’s **name** and **registered email address**, as retrieved from their Google sign-in.

From the “My Profile” screen, the user can also choose to **log out** of the application using the “**Logout**” option, which securely ends the session and returns the user to the pre-login interface.



## Account Deletion:

To delete their account, the user can navigate to the **Settings** section from the main menu. Upon clicking **Settings**, the user will be redirected to the account management screen, which includes a clearly marked “**Danger Zone**” area for critical actions.

Within this section, the user will find the “**Delete Account**” option. When selected, the app will prompt the user to confirm the deletion. Once confirmed:

- The user’s account will be permanently removed from the system.
- All associated profile information (name, email, and stored chat history) will be deleted.
- The user will be automatically logged out and returned to the initial landing screen.

**Note:** This action is irreversible. If the user wishes to use the platform again, they must create a new account using Google Sign-In.
