How Do You Get Started?

Setup and configuration of Office365Mon is done entirely in the cloud – there's **nothing to download and nothing to install**. We have a simple one-page configuration on our web site that can have you up and running in two minutes.

How Does It Work?

Office365Mon issues probes against your Office 365 resources to check their availability. A probe can do things like check a mailbox or a SharePoint Online site. When a health probes fails to connect to a resource that means there's an outage. **We track it, report it, and notify you** via email and text messages to as many people as you want.

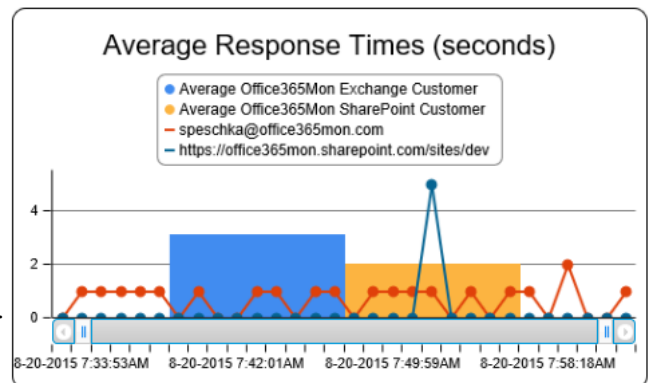
How Is It Secured?

Office365Mon uses the security services provided by Azure Active Directory. When you configure a mailbox or site for us to monitor, you log into Azure Active Directory and give us permission to monitor. **You can limit what content can be monitored**, and you can turn off access both in Azure AD and on the Office365Mon site.

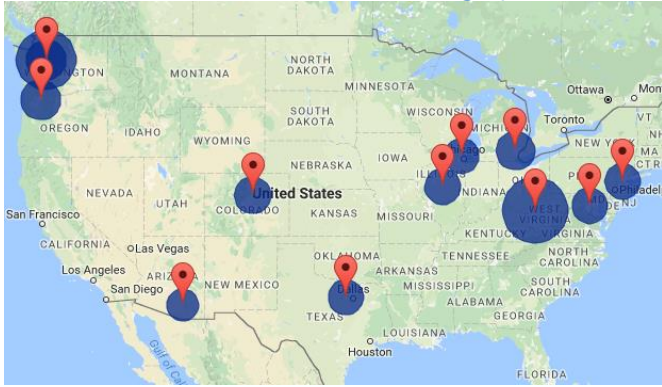
How Can I Review the Monitoring Results?

We provide **several reports for free** that you can use to see things like outages that have occurred, recent probes and their performance, etc. We also have a number of advanced reports that give you statistics like your uptime percentage, amount of down time, reasons for your outages, etc.

If you don't find a report that's exactly to your liking, no problem! We also have a premium feature that allows you to download the raw report data as a CSV file so you can **create your own reports**. We also have an API that you can use to retrieve your report data. If that's not enough, you can also use our Power BI Content Pack.



What if we Have Users in Different Geographies?



That's no problem, we offer our Distributed Probes and Diagnostics feature. You can **monitor performance and availability from as many locations as you want**. You can get notifications when there's an outage at any location, or when performance drops below a threshold you define. You also get nearly a dozen reports to help you analyze the performance across all the locations where you have users. If there's an issue we'll even run a set of network diagnostics to help you pinpoint the problem.

What About Monitoring Features Within the Service?

One of the most common issues we see is when the service is up, but it's not necessarily working. What we mean by that is in SharePoint Online, the service can be up. But the Search service in SharePoint Online provides a significant part of the functionality. It can provide content in the pages you see, in the navigation in the site, and is used in many, many custom applications. So **if it's not working right, then you may be missing out on important data in your site**. Our Search Monitoring feature allows you to stay informed if queries are running slowly, which a user may see as a page that's just not rendering right. We also monitor how frequently content is being crawled, so if you add documents to your site you'll be able to tell whether they should show up in search results, or if not, how long it's taking to crawl your site.
