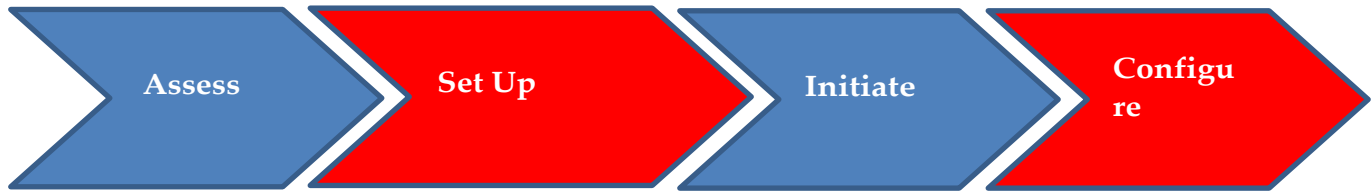

Initiate: Configuring Endpoint Manager and applications requires checking for Windows compliance policies and configuration policies. Windows Autopilot must be initiated for pre-provisioned deployment profiles.

Configure: Configure and set up Microsoft Endpoint applications. Microsoft Intune, Configuration Manager, Desktop Analytics, and (if requested) co-management are included. Intune connector for Active Directory and Intune certificate connector are required for on premises infrastructure.
