Azure Landing Zone QuickStart

Description

This 5-day service enables customers to rapidly exploit the benefits of cloud computing. By configuring a secure connection to an existing datacentre, resources such as virtual machines can be easily deployed and be available on the corporate network.

Features

- Build a virtual network in Azure and connect to a customer's existing datacentre network
- Apply policies to ensure control over resource creation and costs (e.g. sovereignty regulations may require data to reside in UK datacentres)
- Create resources to support logging, diagnostics and encryption
- Use Infrastructure-as-Code (IaC) blueprints to define resources and policies to ensure deployment to a repeatable standard

- Day 1: Workshop to discuss objectives and gather configuration detail
- Day 2: Publish a design and configuration document (DCD)
- Day 3-5: Implement and demonstrate Azure Landing Zone
