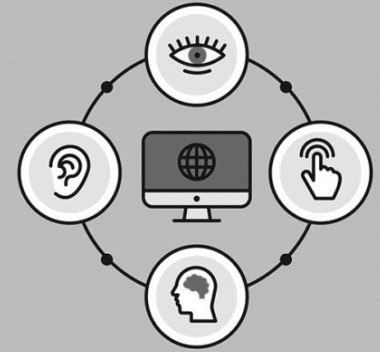

M365 test & learn pilot for a CAC 40 company



We conducted a pilot approach over 1 month to ensure that M365 tools could be used by people with specific disabilities: **cognitive, auditory, motor and visual**.

An approach in 3 phases

Observation and interviews

We spent time with users in order to discover their work environment, understand their everyday uses and how they work with office tools (use of specific materials, time spending for a specific task, ...)

Workshops

Along with Microsoft Accessibility Leader (Ph. Trotin), we organized sessions with users to let them discover and test accessibility features of M365 tools. Workshops were structured with demonstrations and practical exercises well oriented for each disability.

Summary and recommendations

To conclude this pilot, we created personae tailored to each particular case with the appropriate recommendations regarding M365 solutions use. Our user interviews enriched the final synthesis.

We shared the pilot approach to the Mission Handicap and it will enrich guidelines to address future workplace needs and M365 tools adoption for people with disabilities.

New inclusive way of working and new M365 accessibility adoption program

CAC 40 company



We support a Change team during 6 months to transform its way of working into a more inclusive approach: create accessible templates, inclusive communication and adapt all their M365 training courses.

Action plan

Transform content into accessibility standards

Audit and create templates to transform all presentation supports: practical sheets, Yammer tips, PPT slideshow, masterclasses trainings ...

Awareness

- Organize specific sessions to raise awareness with the disability mission on digital accessibility by topics: meetings, communication, time-saving, collaboration ...
- Work with Microsoft Accessibility Leader (Ph. Trotin) to promote accessibility through talks and meetings with all users, sponsors, managers ...

Coaching program

Include accessibility features in existing training sessions and create new dedicated M365 training programs for various disabilities: use of subtitles, traduction, immersive reader, dictation, shortcuts ...
