

Responsible Supply Chain 2-hour Discovery Workshop

As organizations around the world join the race to net zero, very few can achieve meaningful impacts without looking beyond its own operations and onto its value chain.

When it comes to greenhouse gas emissions, for instance, Scope 3 (i.e., upstream and downstream indirect emissions) accounts for 75% of a company's total emissions as a cross-sector average. Furthermore, ESG risks are often concentrated amongst the lower-tier suppliers, constituting the part of the network that is typically most opaque.

Apart from its scale and complexity, supply chain emissions and ESG risks are notoriously difficult to manage as a result of the lower visibility and direct control an organization has over its supplier network. And as with most transformational efforts, fostering a responsible supply chain is a journey.
