COMMON MICROSOFT 365 MIGRATION METHODOLOGIES

One of the most common questions we get asked is whether a migration can be completed all at once or in stages. Either approach works, but you need to choose the right approach for your business. Here's a look at the most common Microsoft 365 migration methodologies.

CUTOVER METHODOLOGY

The cutover approach is often the fastest, but it is typically only used by organizations with 150 users or less. In addition, this method should only be employed when you're not going to be operating in a hybrid mode. Finally, two additional advantages of this approach are that it requires no additional servers and no offboarding.

STAGED METHODOLOGY

A staged migration approach is often used when organizations are migrating from on-premises versions of Exchange Server 2003 or 2007. In a staged migration, we'll move mailboxes to Microsoft 365 in phases. Once the migration is complete, all mailboxes will be hosted in Microsoft 365. This approach is ideal for bulk migrations because it allows you to select users with similar profiles (e.g., in the same department) and migrate them together. With a staged migration, users in Microsoft 365 can continue to send and receive emails from on-premise users and vice-versa.

HYBRID METHODOLOGY

The hybrid methodology is a little more complex, but if you're migrating a lot of users or want to use Microsoft in a hybrid mode, it offers the control and flexibility you need. It also allows for a single sign-on between Active Directory and Microsoft 365. When using the hybrid methodology with customers, we often take a phased approach by grouping users into logical migration batches. Some additional tools, such as Azure AD Connect, are required.

INTERNET MESSAGE ACCESS PROTOCOL (IMAP) METHODOLOGY

This migration methodology has a limited use case; however, it is often used by organizations that aren't using Microsoft Exchange Servers. This approach extracts information from your source mailboxes and then pushes it to Microsoft 365. IMAP migrations do not include calendar, contacts, notes, or other items types. There is also a limit of 5,000,000 items and 50,000 total mailboxes.

THE BEST APPROACH

Cutover migration is similar to a single batch move and suitable for small organizations.

Staged migration moves mailboxes in batches and is suitable for medium-sized organizations.

Hybrid migration is featurerich migration that enables you to natively move mailboxes. IMAP migration is ideal for organizations that aren't using Exchange Server.
