Why Project Online is no longer enough

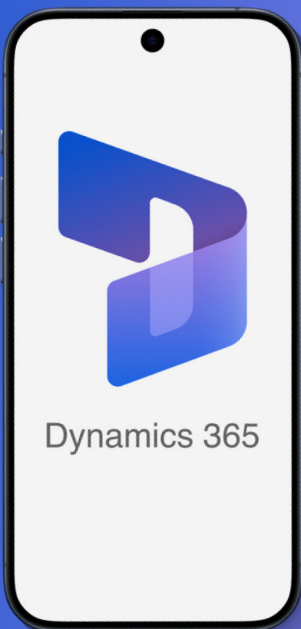

Dynamics 365 Project Operations provides an end-to-end Project-to-Profit platform that unifies opportunity and quote management, project planning and resourcing, time and expense capture, invoicing, and revenue recognition in a single Dataverse-based system. It delivers real-time visibility into project and portfolio profitability while remaining scalable, secure, and analytics-ready, with native integration across Teams, Power BI, and Power Automate.

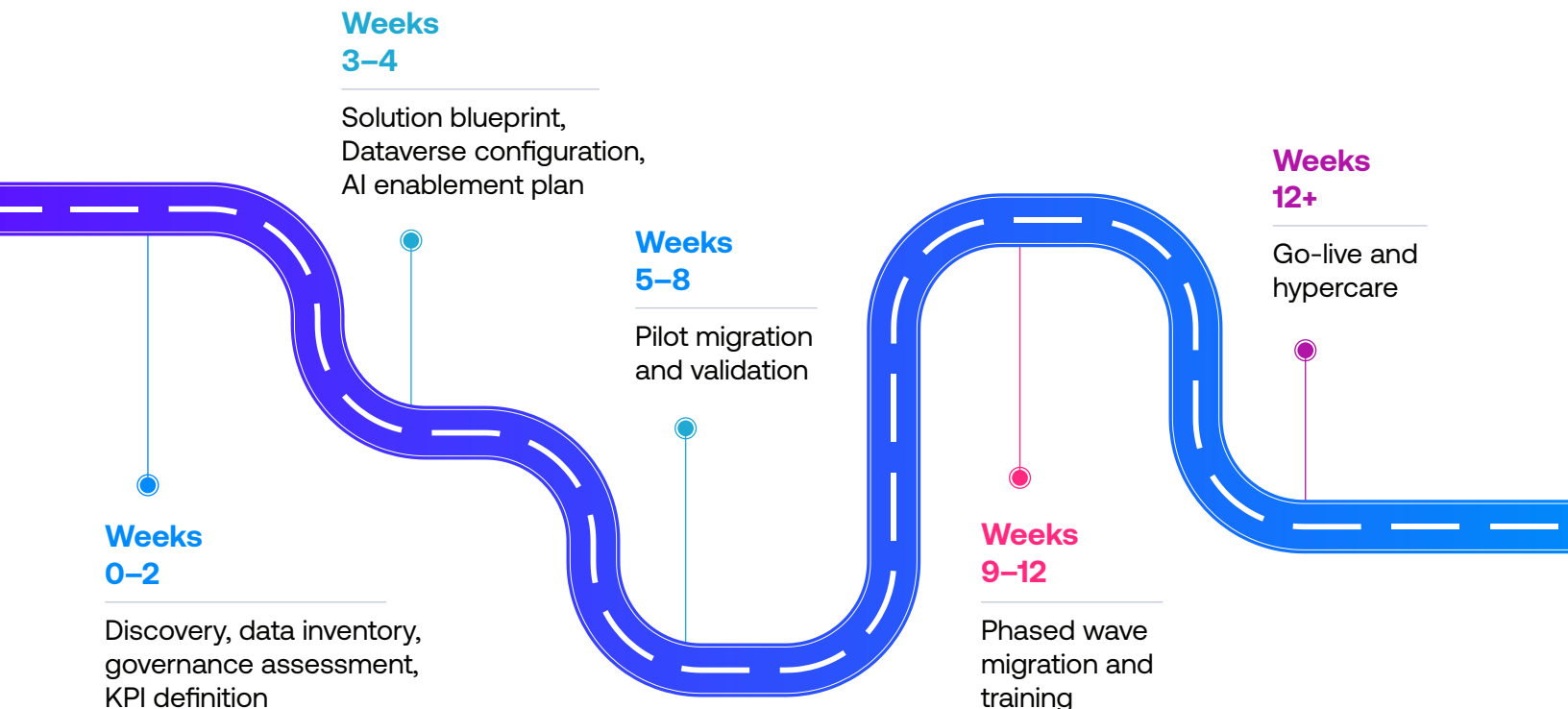

Migration timeline

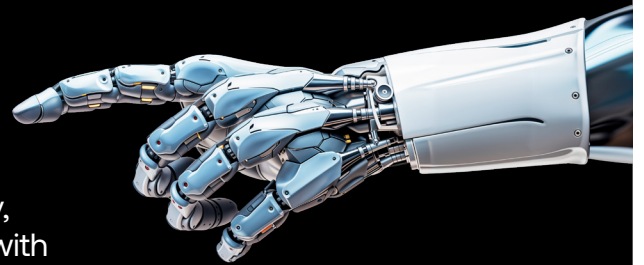


AI value add: Copilot & Agents
