



# Analytics for Enterprise

## overview

- A single, governed platform for enterprise data warehousing and analytics, built on Microsoft Fabric.
- Consolidates data from across the organization into one platform for consistent, reliable reporting and decision making.
- Structured on the medallion architecture, with a dedicated landing zone that receives incoming data before it enters the governed layers.
- Designed to scale from a single business unit to a full enterprise data estate.

## Functional Capabilities

- End-to-end data pipeline, from ingestion through to business-ready reporting.
- Automated transformation and orchestration across all layers.
- Centralized governance, data lineage, and traceability across the enterprise.
- Scalable storage and compute that grows with data volume and organizational demand.
- Self-service reporting and analytics for business users, built on governed data.

## Architectural Layers

- **Landing Zone:** dedicated workspace for receiving incoming data from source systems. No data is persisted here, keeping raw external sources fully separated from governed data.
- **Bronze Layer:** raw data retained in its original form for traceability and reprocessing.
- **Silver Layer:** cleaned, validated, and conformed data ready for integration.
- **Gold Layer:** business-ready, aggregated data curated for reporting and analytics.
- Each layer is a dedicated Fabric workspace with its own Lakehouse for storage, supported by notebooks for transformation, pipelines for orchestration, dataflows for integration, and shortcuts for cross-workspace access without data duplication.

## Deployment & Security

- Workspace-level isolation between the landing zone and the bronze, silver, and gold layers.
- Role-based access control through Azure Active Directory.
- Row-level security applied at report and dataset level.
- Secure, governed movement of data between layers using native Fabric capabilities.



## Benefits

- A single source of truth across the enterprise.
- Faster and more reliable reporting through automated, repeatable pipelines.
- Reduced duplication of data and effort across business units.
- A scalable foundation that supports future analytics and AI initiatives.

## Requirements

The items below support a smooth deployment. Not all are required at the outset; gaps can be addressed during the discovery phase of engagement.

- Active Azure subscription with Microsoft Fabric enabled.
- Fabric capacity sized to data volume; enterprise-scale deployments typically start at F8 or higher.
- Azure Active Directory for identity and access management.
- Identified source systems and their respective data owners.
- Defined reporting and business requirements, which may be finalized during discovery.
- Nominated technical and business stakeholders to support the engagement.

## Roadmap Enhancements

- Integration of AI and Copilot-driven insights for business users.
- Real-time and near real-time data ingestion.
- Expanded connectors to additional enterprise source systems.
- Advanced data quality monitoring and alerting.
